**Brief particulars of the agenda items for the Academic Council meeting to be held on 16.11.2016**

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**KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY KURUKSHETRA**  
**(Established by the State Legislature Act XII of 1956)**

Agenda for the 118<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council of the Kurukshetra University to be held on Wednesday, the 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2016 at 3.00 p.m. in the Senate Hall, Bhagvadgita Sadan, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

1. To confirm the minutes of the last meeting of the Academic Council held on 10.12.2015; and to note the follow up action as per **Annexure pages 1(1-2)**.

2. To consider the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council in approving the following proposals regarding award of degrees of examination held in April/May, 2015 as required under Clause (1) & (2) of the Ordinance XIX(a) Admission to degrees and Academical Costumes appearing at page 254 of the University Calendar Volume-I, 2009.

1. “All such students who will pass their UG/PG examination held in April/May, 2015 for the various Degrees of the University and have become qualified for admission to such degrees be admitted to these degrees.”
2. The date for admission of such persons to these degrees will be shown as various examinations.
3. The degrees of all the person who will pass their various examination in April/May, 2015 from the various Departments/Colleges recognized by the Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and Directorate of Distance Education, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and will become qualified for admission to such degrees will be sent by post to their respective institution.
4. The degrees of all the person who will pass various examinations in 2015 as private candidates and become qualified for award of such Degrees be sent by post to them.

3. To consider the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in allowing relaxation in the eligibility condition for admission to Certificate Course on Bhagvad Gita, w.e.f. the Academic Session 2016-17 **as per Annexure Pages 3(1)**.

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

The President Youth Affairs Organisation (Regd.) Karnal requested through the office of the Hon'ble Chief Minister and His Excellency the Governor of Haryana, Chandigarh to withdraw the condition of Sanskrit subject at matric level for admission to certificate course on Bhagvad Gita.

The Vice-Chancellor constituted a committee headed by Dean Academic Affairs to consider the issue. The Committee resolved the issue in its meeting held on 28.12.2015 **as per Annexure Pages 3(1)**.

4. To consider the request of Mrs. Afzal Hussain S/o Sh. Tayub Hussain for allowing him admission in BIM-III in the Directorate of Distance Education during the Academic session 2015-16 and appear in BIM-III year exam to be held in May/June, 2016 to complete his BIM Degree, as a special case, with extra fee in addition to normal fee+Usual late fee etc. to be imposed by the Academic Council for permitting him extension of one year period beyond six years which is the stipulated period for passing BIM course.

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

As per Clause 6.2 of the Ordinance for BIM Examination appearing at page 153 of K.U. Cal. Vol.II, 2014, a candidate who fails to pass the whole examination (Part-I,II,III) within six years of his/her admission to the course, he/she will be required to repeat the course *de-novo*.

The above candidate took admission in BIM-I as a regular candidate during the session 2008-09. He was required to pass the course within six years i.e. upto 2013-14. Now he has requested to allow him to take admission in BIM-III in the Directorate of Distance Education to complete his BIM-III Degree course during the session 2015-16 as a special case.

The Academic Council has already allowed admission to various candidates to complete their Degree course as a special case on one or the other ground with the penalty of Rs.5,000/- in addition to normal fee/late fee etc. for permitting them extension of one year beyond the stipulated period.

5. To consider the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council in allowing admission to Ms. Shaveta Taneja in M.Com. (Final) in the Directorate of Distance Education and appear in M.Com. (Final) examination to be held in May/June, 2016 to complete her M.Com. Degree as a special case with extra fee to be imposed by the Academic Council, in addition to normal fee/late fee etc. for permitting her extension of **one year** beyond 4 years which is the stipulated period for passing M.Com. Degree course.

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

As per Clause 6.2 of the Ordinance for M.Com. Examination, appearing at page 356 of K.U. Cal. Vol.II (Part-B), 2014, a candidate who fails to pass M.Com. examination within a period of four years of his/her admission to the course shall be deemed to be unfit for the course.

In the instant case Ms. Shaveta Taneja took admission in M.Com. (Previous) first time during the session 2004-05 but could not complete the course within stipulated period. Now she has requested to allow her to take admission in M.Com. (F) in the Directorate to complete her M.Com. Degree course during the session 2015-16. The Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council allowed admission to her in M.Com.(F) through DDE as a special case with extra fee in addition to normal fee/late fee etc. to be imposed by the Academic Council.

The Academic Council has already allowed admission to some candidates also to complete their Degree course as a special case on one or the other ground with the penalty of Rs.5,000/- in addition to normal fee/dues for permitting them extension of **one year** beyond four years which is the stipulated period for passing M.A./M.Com. Degree Course.

6. To consider the revised Ordinance for Master of Business Administration (MBA) Examination (Semester System), **as per Annexure Pages 6(1-4).**

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

Due to discontinuation of MBA (Hons.) and MBA (Service Management) Programmes, some of the provisions containing in the existing common Ordinance for MBA/MBA (Hons.)/MBA (Service Management) Examination (Semester System), appearing at pages 525-532 of K.U. Vol.II, 2014 have become redundant/obsolete. Now MBA programme is running under Budgeted and Self-financing Schemes in the University School of Management and some of the affiliated Colleges.

In view of this, the above mentioned draft Ordinance (**as per Annexure Pages 6(1-4)**) as recommended by the Staff Council of the University School of Management dated 04.12.2015 has been considered and examined by the standing Ordinance Committee, already approved by the Vice-Chancellor, consisting of (i) Dean, Faculty of Commerce and Mgt., (ii) Chairperson, University School of Management, (iii) Controller of Exams.-II and (iv) Deputy Registrar (Academic), in its meeting held on 25.02.2016.

Hence the above for consideration.

**STATEMENT OF THE CASE:**

P.G. Diploma in Counselling, Psychotherapy and Rehabilitation course has been allowed to be introduced in the Department of Psychology, under Self-financing Scheme, w.e.f. the current session 2015-16. Instead of preparing and getting approved a separate Ordinance for this course, draft amendments/additions to Clauses 1 and 3 of the existing Ordinance for P.G. Diploma in Yoga Examination (Annual System) by adding the name of the P.G. Diploma in Counselling, Psychotherapy and Rehabilitation course and its minimum eligibility conditions, have been prepared so as to make it common for both the courses, **as per Annexure Pages 8(1)**. These have been got checked from the Chairperson, Department of Psychology, Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences and Dean Academic Affairs.

Since meeting of the Academic Council was not being held shortly and above amendments/additions were to be implemented w.e.f. the current session 2015-16, the Vice-Chancellor took the above action.

15. Every student shall submit his/her thesis within a period of four years, but not before two years from the date of recommendations of the Board of Studies. If a student fails to submit his/her Thesis within a period of four years, he may apply for the extension to the concerned Chairperson/Director, citing the proper reason(s) for non-submission of the thesis before the expiry of his/her period, failing which his/her registration will stand automatically cancelled.

However, the candidate may apply for restoration, to the concerned Chairperson/Director, citing the proper reason(s) for not seeking extension in time limit and non-submission of thesis after passing of 4 years, of his/her registration for Ph.D. with a restoration fee of Rs. 1,000/- within a period of 3 months, Rs. 2000/- within a period of 6 months, Rs.5,000/-within a period of 1 year provided that his/her application is recommended by the Supervisor, the Departmental Ph.D. Committee and allowed by the Vice-Chancellor.

The period of four years for submission of Ph.D. Thesis may be extended in exceptional cases, by a maximum of two years, on yearly extension basis by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendations of the Supervisor (s) and the Departmental Ph.D. Committee with extra fee of Rs. 10,000/- for 5 year and Rs. 20,000/- for 6 year. No extension in any case shall be allowed thereafter.

Ph.D. Registration dated 14.3.2011 of Ms. Gurpreet Kaur, Research Scholar in Physical Education cancelled on 13.3.2015 as per rule quoted above as she had not applied for extension in time limit for submission of thesis after 4 years. #### **STATEMENT OF THE CASE :**

The Academic Council vide its Res. No. 39 of 21.04.2014 and the Executive Council Res. No. 3(17) of 24.06.2014 have approved the following addition in the relevant clause of the various Ordinances to be made effective on the students taking admission in 1<sup>st</sup> Semester in the session 2014-15 and onwards keeping in view the recommendation made in the meeting of the Vice-Chancellors held on 17.04.2014 in the KUK under the Chairmanship of Sh. S.S. Prasad, IAS, Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Higher Education Department:-

“Provided that a candidate shall not be allowed to attend 5<sup>th</sup> Semester Class unless he/she has passed 1<sup>st</sup> Semester (all papers) of the course.”

Since then the University is receiving representations from various Principals/ Directors of the various affiliated Colleges/Institutes as well as the students of various courses for withdrawal of above mentioned provision on the plea that result of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester examination held in December, 2014 have been declared late and they could not get two admissible chances. In case a student fails to clear 1<sup>st</sup> Semester “Reappear” in 2<sup>nd</sup> available chance, he/she

will get no chance for promotion in 5<sup>th</sup> Semester resultantly has to leave the studies in the mid-stream thereby gradually reducing the number of students in every Engg. Institute/College which ultimately may cause the closure of such Institutes.

While considering the various representations, the Committee, constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, in its meeting held on 11.07.2016 (**Annexure Pages 33(1-2)**) noted that according to the Rule containing in various Ordinances for Under-graduate examinations, a candidate in order to pass an examination, is allowed two chances, in addition to normal chance, to clear re-appear paper(s) as an ex-student. Further, the candidate is required to pass the whole examination (I, II, III, IV, V and VI) within a period of six years of his/her admission to the course and in case of B.Tech. the period is eight years for passing all the eight semester examinations.

In view of the above, after detailed deliberations, the Committee unanimously recommended that the students of UG courses including B.Tech./B.Arch. may be promoted to 5<sup>th</sup> Semester class in the academic interest of the students as they could not avail two admissible chances to clear their re-appear paper(s) of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester and the matter may be reported to the Academic Council/Executive Council.

Keeping in view the above recommendation, the Vice-Chancellor has allowed promotion to 5<sup>th</sup> Semester Class to above mentioned students **for the current session (2016-17) only and has ordered to report the matter to the Academic Council.**

Keeping in view D.O. letters No. F.1-1/2014 (Secy) dated 12<sup>th</sup> /18<sup>th</sup> November 2014 and Even No dated 21.01.2015 received from the Secretary, UGC, New Delhi and the recommendations of a Committee thereupon, constituted by the Vice-Chancellor regarding adoption of uniform Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and Credit Framework for Skill Development (CFSD), the Academic Council vide its Res. No. 36 dated 15.04.2015 and the Executive Council vide its Res. No.7(16) dated 14.09.2015 approved in principle to introduce Credit Based System in all PG courses running in various University Teaching Departments as well as affiliated/maintained Colleges/Institutes in the first instance, w.e.f. the ensuing session 2015-16 and adopt the existing rules/guidelines with suitable amendments for implementation of Credit System of Study and award of Grades in various University Examinations.

In the meantime, vide letter No. KW 18/234-2014 UNP(3) dated 16.09.2015, received from Additional Chief Secretary Higher Education, Haryana, Panchkula, the State Government constituted a Committee of the Vice-Chancellors of all the Seven State Universities under the convenership of Vice-Chancellor of Kurushetra University to suggest modalities for the implementation of Choice Based Credit System. The meeting of the Vice-Chancellors of all the seven Universities was held on 24.05.2016 which among others decided that Choice Based Credit System may be introduced w.e.f. the session 2016-17 in phased manner in the first instance only in the Post-graduate courses being governed by the UGC rules and running in the University Teaching Departments at the campus. The above Committee also decided that a meeting of the following sub-Committee be got held on 03.06.2016 at 2.30 p.m. in the Committee Room under the Convenership of Dean Academic Affairs, K.U. Kurukshetra to suggest grading system to be implemented uniformly and successfully in all the seven State Universities:

- (i) Dean Academic Affairs or Registrars of all the Seven Universities.
- (ii) Incharge looking after the work of implementation of CBCS in all the Seven State Universities.

The recommendations of the above sub-Committee dated 03.06.2016, **as per Annexure Pages 38(1-10)**, duly approved by the Vice-Chancellor have been forwarded to the Additional Chief Secretary Higher Education, Haryana
