Articles/Research papers must be original and must not be published or submitted for publication elsewhere. Any plagiarized work will be out-rightly rejected.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The Kurukshetra Law Journal (A Refereed Journal with ISSN 2231-5519) request that the contributors comply with the following guidelines otherwise it will not be accepted for publication. -

1. Word Limit, Fonts and Headings

The manuscript shall be in Microsoft word format and the length of manuscript should average between-

Articles : 4000-6000 words.

Case comment and Book Review: 2000-3000 words.

Articles should be in Times New Roman 12 point font and 1.5 space.

Main Title should be in Capitals, bold and in 16 point font.

Author's names should be in small capitals.

Footnotes should be in Times New Roman 10 point font.

All pages shall be numbered.

All manuscripts should include an introduction and conclusion

2. Rules of Footnoting

The Kurukshetra Law Journal has formulated a set pattern of footnoting, which is being followed since its inception. Contributors are required to follow this pattern.

(a) Mode of citation for Books

Name of the author, title of the book, page no. Publisher, Place of publication, edition and year of publication.

(b) Mode of citation for Articles

Name of author of article, title of article with in inverted commas, volume number of journal, name of journal in abbreviation and page no with year.

(c) Mode of citation of case laws

All India Reporter (AIR)

If the name and citation are to be written in the footnotes itself-

Sunil Batra v. Delhi Administration, AIR 1980 SC 1579.

Where the case title is written in the body of article then only the name of the case shall be in the text e.g.

Sunil Batra v. Delhi Administration and the citation is to be written in the footnote as
AIR 1980 SC 1579.

Supreme Court Cases (SCC)

If the name and citation are to be written in the footnotes itself-

Jassa Singh v. State of Haryana (2002) 2 SCC 481.

Where the case title is written in the body of article then only the name of the case shall be in the text e.g.

Jassa Singh v. State of Haryana and the citation is to be written in the footnote as
(2002) 2 SCC 481.

Criminal Law Journal (Cr.L.J.)

If the name and citation are to be written in the footnotes itself-

Moti v. State of Uttar Pardesh, 2003 Cr LJ 1694(SC).

Where the case title is written in the body of article then only the name of the case shall be in the text e.g.

Moti v. State of Uttar Pardesh and the citation is to be written in the footnote as 2003 Cr LJ 1694(SC).

(d) Mode of citation of Reports

Government of India, Report: Committee on Reforms of Criminal Justice system (Ministry of Home Affairs, and the Year).

(e) Mode of citation of Acts

The Limitation Act, 1963 (Act 36 of 1963)

(f) Mode of citation of Websites

If the websites gives information regarding when it was last modified than it must be cited and if not than one must cite the date of visiting the website.

4. **Covering Letter**


All submission must be accompanied with covering letter, indicating the name of the author, title of article/research paper and a contact address including mail address.
