Sir/Madam,

I am desired to inform you that the following teacher(s) of your Department/Institute/College has/have been allowed to participate in the 4-week Orientation Programme to be organized under the UGC scheme from 24.05.2018 to 20.06.2018.

You are requested kindly to depute the concerned teacher(s) to report for participation in the course by **9.30 AM** on **24.05.2018** in the Seminar Room of UGC-Human Resource Development Centre of this University where the course is proposed to be conducted. The participant shall pay admission fee (non-refundable) of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) in the shape of Bank Draft **payable at Kurukshetra in the name of the Registrar, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra**. The outstation participants will be paid Rs 300/- per day for boarding & lodging. Local participants will be paid Rs.300/- per working day. Outstation participants will also be paid A/C III railway fare (all trains) or A/C deluxe bus fare on production of tickets.. The payment will, however, be released to them only on the last day if they have submitted their bills well in time. The teachers of colleges that do not yet come within the purview of Section 12(B), but have been affiliated to a university for at least two years, will be permitted to participate in the programmes/courses. However, they won't be paid TA/DA and other allowances for attending these courses.

Outstation participants will be provided accommodation in the Faculty House of the University, **if available**, on payment of usual charges by them. They may, however, like to bring their own beddings, locks, bulb, etc. with them for their convenience.

As per directions of UGC, performance of the participants in the course will be assessed. Those teachers who get 'D' grade are required to repeat the programme after a gap of one year without financial commitment to the UGC-HRDC. The grades will be indicated on the certificate to be given to the participants.

**Only those teachers should be deputed whose applications have been forwarded by the Competent Authority failing which the teachers will not be allowed to join the course in the Human Resource Development Centre.**

**Kindly confirm their participation in the course along with a Bank draft of Rs. 1000/- (Rs. One Thousand only) latest by 15.05.2018 failing which it will be presumed that the teacher(s) is/are not interested in attending the course.**
