As notified by the UGC vide Gazette of India No. Regd. No. DL 33004/99 dated July 18, 2018, all Faculty Induction Programmes for teachers/faculty being conducted by Faculty Development Centre (FDCs), under the PMMMNMTT scheme shall be taken into consideration for fulfillment of the requirements as laid down in Career Advancement Scheme of these Regulations. The relevant portion of the notifications is reproduced below:-

“All short-term and long-duration capacity-building programmes/Faculty Induction Programmes for teachers/faculty ranging from one week to one month as well as seminars, workshops in different pedagogic and discipline-specific areas being conducted by centres such as Schools of Education (SOEs), Teaching Learning Centres (TLCs), Faculty Development Centres (FDCs), Centres for Excellence in Science and Mathematics (CESMEs), Centres for Academic Leadership and Education Management (CALEMs) under the PMMMNMTT scheme shall be taken into consideration for fulfillment of the requirements as laid down in Career Advancement Scheme of these Regulations.”

Faculty Development Centres (FDCs) are mandated to organize Faculty Induction Program for newly recruited faculty to undergo a mandatory Induction training Programme after their appointment in HE institutions.

Faculty Induction Programme

The main objective of Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) is to provide an opportunity for interaction among experts in the field and newly inducted faculty member to share best practices around 'teaching-Learning' process and getting acquainted with new

development in different disciplines for enhancing. The Faculty Induction Programme (FIP) will include interaction around sharing of best practices and updating the new developments in their discipline for enhancing personal, instructional, organizational and professional developments of the teachers.

Objectives of the Programme

- To help the participants understand the structure, functioning, governance, rules and regulations in Institutions of Higher Education and to orient them to become potential partners in institute building.
- To sensitize and motivate the faculty to adopt learner-centric approaches of teaching and classroom management.
- To enable the faculty to get acquainted with and adopt ICT integrated learning and new pedagogic approaches to teaching- learning.
- To enable the faculty develop understanding of various methods of evaluation and assessment and use different assessment tools in diversified settings.
- To sensitize and acquaint faculty with practical knowledge in emotional balance of self and student-counseling and mentoring.

The programme is scheduled from November 19 to December 20, 2019. Each day, duration of the Sessions will be 9.00am to 5.00 pm with a lunch break from 1.00 pm to 2.00 pm.
