- Identify changing trends of Human Rights during the process of evolution.
- Establish linkages between Human Rights and International Instruments.
- Comprehend emerging threats to Human Rights in 21st Century and ways of addressing the same.
- Articulate contemporary challenges during transitional phase.
- Evaluate the impact of contemporary challenges to human rights on the society.
- Demonstrate respect for human rights in teaching-learning environment as well as day to day behaviour.

Duration:-

The programme is scheduled from October 10-16, 2019. Each day, duration of the Sessions will be 09:00 am to 05:00 pm with a lunch break from 01:00 pm to 02:00 pm.

Target Group:-

Applications are invited from faculty members of Universities/ Colleges/ Institutes of Higher Education to enroll for the programme. Preference will be given to those teachers working in Universities or Colleges under Sections 2(f) and 12 B of the UGC Act, 1956.
