Scheme of Examination for B.A. Honours Course in the Subject of Sanskrit according to Semester System w.e.f. 2010-2011

- Total number of Subjects in B.A. Honours : 3 (1 main + 1 Subsidiary + 1 qualifying)
- Total number of Papers in B.A. Honours : 24 (16 main + 6 Subsidiary + 2 Qualifying)
- Total Marks : 2400 (1600 + 600 + 200)

Distribution of Papers

- Main Subject (only one): 16 papers of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks each
- Subsidiary Subject (English Compulsory) : 6 papers of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks each
- Qualifying Subject (Hindi Compulsory) :2 papers of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks each

These 24 papers will be distributed over three years (six semesters) of the course as under:

B.A. Honours Part-I (First Year) First Semester

- Main Subject (only one): 2 papers (Paper- I & Paper-II) of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks each
- Subsidiary Subject (English Compulsory): 1 paper of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks
- Qualifying Subject (Hindi Compulsory): 1 paper of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks

Second Semester

- Main Subject (only one): 2 papers (Paper-III & Paper-IV) of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks each
- Subsidiary Subject (English Compulsory): 1 paper of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks
- Qualifying Subject (Hindi Compulsory): 1 paper of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks

B.A. Honours Part-II (Second Year)

Third Semester

- Main Subject (only one): 3 papers (Paper-V, Paper-VI & Paper-VII) of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks each
- Subsidiary Subject
(English Compulsory): 1 paper of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks

Fourth Semester

- Main Subject (only one): 3 papers (Paper-VIII, Paper-IX & Paper-X) of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks each
- Subsidiary Subject
(English Compulsory): 1 paper of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks

B.A. Honours Part-III (Third Year)

Fifth Semester

- Main Subject (only one) : 3 papers (Paper-XI, Paper-XII & Paper-XIII) of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks each
- Subsidiary Subject
(English Compulsory) : 1 paper of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks

Sixth Semester

- Main Subject (only one) : 3 papers (Paper-XIV, Paper-XV & Paper-XVI) of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks each
- Subsidiary Subject
(English Compulsory) : 1 paper of 100 (90+10 Int. Ass.) marks

Scheme of B.A. Honours in Sanskrit

1. B.A. Honours in Sanskrit is a three year degree course divided into **six Semesters**. The total number of main papers prescribed for this course is **16** (Sixteen). There will be **4** (four) papers in the first year (**2** papers in the First Semester and **2** papers in the Second Semester) and **6** (six) papers in the second year (**3** papers in the Third Semester and **3** papers in the Fourth Semester) and **6** (six) papers in the third year (**3** papers in the Fifth Semester and **3** papers in the Sixth Semester).

2. The maximum marks for each paper will be **100** (One Hundred). The question paper will carry **90** (Ninety) marks. There will be internal assessment of **10** (Ten) marks in each paper.
3. The student of B.A. Honours in Sanskrit shall study only one main subject, i.e., **Sanskrit** in all **six** semesters. **English Compulsory** will be the subsidiary subject for all **three** years (**six** semesters). **Hindi Compulsory** will be the qualifying subject only in B.A. Honours, Part I (First year : Semester-I and Semester-II).
4. The syllabus of the subsidiary and qualifying subjects will be the same as the syllabi of B.A. General pass course in these (compulsory) subjects.
5. The minimum number of marks required to pass shall be as under :
 - (a) Main subject – **40%** marks in aggregate and **35%** marks in each paper.
 - (b) Subsidiary and qualifying subjects – **35%** marks in each paper.
6. For promotion from B.A. Honours Part-I to Part-II and from Part-II to Part-III, a candidate shall be required to clear at least **50%** of theory papers of the main subject as well as other subjects.
7. Eligibility condition is as follows :

A person who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2) of Board of School Education Haryana or an equivalent examination with five subjects having **English** as one of the subjects and has obtained **50%** marks in the aggregate or **50%** marks in the subject offered for the Honours course, shall be eligible to join the B.A. Honours Part-I (First year).

Special instructions:-

1. Every question paper will carry 90 marks. There will be internal assessment of 10 marks in each paper.
2. Maximum time for attempting a question paper will be 3 hours.
3. Minimum 6 periods per week will be allotted for teaching of each paper (elective /compulsory) in B.A./B.Sc. pass course and Honours course.

B.A. Sanskrit Honours is a three year course divided into six Semesters. The total number of papers prescribed for this course is sixteen (16). There will be four (4) papers in the First Year and six (6) papers in the Second year as well as in the Third Year. The maximum marks for each paper will be one hundred (90+10).
