

## **Syllabus for Certificate Course in Panjabi w.e.f. 2013-14**

### **Objective:**

This Course is meant for foreigners and those Indians who wish to acquire reading and speaking proficiency in Punjabi.

1. Every candidate seeking admission to the one-year Certificate Course in Panjabi must have passed the Senior School Certificate Examination of any recognized board by India or possesses such qualifications, if any, as may be prescribed by regulations.
2. The Examination for the Certificate Course shall be written and Oral according to the following scheme.

### **Written Examination:**

#### **Paper-I Functional Panjabi & Translation**

Time: Three Hours

### **Oral Examination:**

(The students will be examined by external examiner. The students are expected to read and write simple text and express themselves in simple Panjabi on general questions).

Note: The minimum marks to pass the examination shall be as under:

- a) 35% marks in each paper i.e. paper-I & II

**b)** 40% marks in aggregate.
