DEAN STUDENTS' WELFARE

Dean

Dr. Pawan Kumar Sharma

The office of Dean Students' Welfare facilitates student empowerment, leadership, and advocacy by strengthening student participation in the life, governance and success of the University. The office provides resources and support to help students turn their ideas into reality. The office works for engaging the students to let them harness their energy for constructive creativity and to further empower themselves by sharpening their skills as well as inculcating leadership capabilities transforming themselves into positive catalysts for personal and National growth. The office looks after students' welfare in different ways and promotes various cultural, sports and academic activities.

1. **Bus/Railway Passes Facility to the Students**

One of the major activities of the office is to facilitate students to travel to the University and back. The office as such arranged 4214 bus passes and 750 railway passes for the students of University Teaching Departments (UTD) in 2017. The work involves various processes, such as online data entry of students on the Haryana Roadways website, cash collection, deposit, preparation and distribution of passes. In case of railway concessions, the office of D.S.W disbursed the concession forms supplied by DRM, New Delhi, to the eligible students. The facility of providing bus and railway passes has been made very smooth and time bound in the last years.

2. **Earn While You Learn Scheme**

This novel scheme provides financial assistance upto 50 UTD students in the form of their engagement for Department related work upto 20 hours a week @ Rs. 45/- per hour. The meritorious students, not possessing financial resources to fund their education are selected on the recommendations of the Chairperson of respective departments. The spirit of the scheme is based on the idea of enabling needy students to meet their educational expenses with dignity. In 2017, all the eligible applicants were allowed to work under this scheme.

3. **Financial Aid to Differently Abled Students**

The office of the D.S.W disburses financial aid to the needy and physically challenged students every year. This year an amount of Rs. 1,52,000/- has been disbursed to 38 students @Rs. 4,000/- per student. Most of the buildings entrance has been provided with ramp engaging hassle free entrance to differently abled persons.

4. **Funding of Educational/Cultural Tours**

Students are encouraged to undertake trips and tours to places of educational and historical importance. In addition to their academic relevance, these trips develop leadership qualities, promote team work and develop an attitude of cooperation among students. The trips are also expected to sensitize the students to appreciate other cultures, societies and languages. This year, 44 tours by students of different departments of their interest were funded by the O/o Dean Students' Welfare.

5. **Inter-disciplinary and Guest Lectures**

The office of D.S.W. provides financial assistance for arranging guest lectures, extension lectures and other inter-disciplinary lectures of outside experts in different University Teaching Departments for the sake of exposing our students to multitude of ideas. This year more than Rs. 50,000/- were spent on honorarium and TA/DA of outside experts for such lectures which were organized in various departments.

6. **Rostrum Competitions**

The office of the Dean Students' Welfare has been organizing Rostrum, Annual Public Speaking Competition, since 2005. Over the years, these competitions have generated lot of interest amongst the students and faculty. These public speaking competitions are conducted at the department, faculty and University level. The prizes are distributed to the winners by the Vice-Chancellor in a function organized in the Senate Hall of the University every year. Last year 3279 students attended the Rostrum-2016, 686 students spoke on the dais in this competition and 293 students were declared as winners at various levels. Ms. Nupur Gupta (LLB-III), Ms. Meenakshi Walia (BFA-VII) and Mr. Sheetal (M.A. (P) Psychology) begged

the 1st, 2nd and 3rd positions, respectively, in the final round of Rostrum-2016. An amount of Rs. 3,04,941/- was disbursed to the winners of Round-I, II and III alongwith the certificates.

7. **National Youth Parliament Competition**

The University has been participating in National Youth Parliament Competition, organized under the aegis of Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Government of India for the last two years. First time in 2016, the University participated in the 13th National Youth Parliament and it is a matter of pride that the University bagged second position at group level competition. The University has participated in the 14th Youth Parliament competition also and the results of the competition are awaited.

8. **Swarna Jayanti Lecture Series**

Swarna Jayanti Lecture Series was an academic initiative of the University in which acclaimed and learned people from diverse disciplines were invited to share their experiences and thoughts with the academic fraternity. This lecture series was one amongst the bouquet of programmes to celebrate the Swarna Jayanti Year of establishment of Haryana.

9. **Common Rooms**

Separate Common Rooms for boys and girls are maintained at several places on the campus. In these rooms, 14 newspapers, 5 magazines and other equipments are provided and Rs. 65,000/- approximately were spent on this account in the year 2017.

10. **Subhash Sadan**

The Subhash Sadan (Students' Home) is maintained for providing a venue for get-together and other programmes of students. Students' Home was provided to the students for such diverse programmes of discussions and other cultural events etc. Community Centre & R. K. Sadan are also provided to the students, if need arises.

11. **Group Insurance Scheme for the Students**

The Kurukshetra University is running Group Insurance Scheme for students of the University whereby all the regular students are insured for Rs. 2,00,000/- for a token premium @Rs. 27.60/- per student. An amount of Rs. 2,62,200/- was spent as insurance premium for the students during the session 2017-18.

12. **Financial help for Various Functions Arranged by the Departments**

This office extended financial help in conducting various functions arranged by the different University Teaching Departments. Total 20 programmes were organized under the support of DSW office by different departments and an amount of Rs. 1,03,553/- was spent on such activities. The office spent Rs. 23,331/- for the purchase of Jerseys/Jackets for SC/ST students admitted in the University Teaching Departments in the Session 2016-17. Such Jerseys/Jackets are given free of cost to SC/ST students in winter.

13. **Answer Books for Internal Tests**

This office provides answer books to all the Teaching Departments for internal tests of the students after getting printed from the University Press. In the last session 1,50,000 answer books of 8 pages were got printed from the University Press and distributed to UTD for use. An amount of Rs. 2,37,783/- was incurred on this account.

14. **Cultural activities**

The DSW office manages the participation of students of University Teaching Departments' teams in various activities of the University. Teams of students are selected to participate in these functions. The Dean Students' Welfare as Vice-Chairman of the Kurukshetra University Cultural Council also monitors the smooth functioning of the University's cultural activities. The following activities were held in the year 2017:-

- i) **Ratnawali Haryana Day Festival:** - Ratnawali 2017 (National Level Youth Festival) was celebrated at Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra from 10th October to 14th October 2017 with a team of 88 students. UTD students participated in 31 different cultural events i.e. (music, dance & theater etc.) and scored 1st position in 4 events viz Haryanvi Skit, (Best actress in skit), on the spot

painting competition, Short Movie, Haryanvi Folk Instrumental solo; got 2nd position in 4 events viz Exhibition of painting, best actor, Solo dance male, Folk costume male & several 3rd and 4th positions.

- ii) **Inter-Zonal Youth Festival:** - Inter-Zonal Youth Festival 2017 was held at DAV College Sadhora (Yamunanagar) from 10th to 12th November, 2017. UTD students participated with a team of 103 students in 45 different events. Our students secured 1st position in 5 events (classical instrumental solo-percussion, Western vocal solo, Collage, clay modeling & on the Spot painting competition) and got 2nd position in Haryanavi skit, Group song general, Classical dance, Folk song Haryanavi, Folk instrumental solo, Cartooning and on the spot photography.
- iii) **Haryana State Festival:** - Haryana State Festival 2017 was held at Kaithal from 24th to 26th December, 2017 with a team of 3 students who got 1st position in Classical Dance, Sitar, Tabla and participated in Ragni and One Act Play.
- iv) **Geeta Jayanti:** - Two teams from UTD participated in Haryanavi Skit and Folk Song events organized by Geeta Jayanti festival-2017 on 25th and 26th November, 2017.
- v) **Presentation Before the Visiting NAAC Team:** - Three teams from UTD presented Choreography, Skit and Group Dance during the visit of NAAC Team to Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra on 4th September, 2017.

15. N.S.S. Activities

- i) The NSS UTD Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra works very actively under the office of the Dean Students' Welfare. It has four different Units with strength of approximately five hundred volunteers, working under the supervision of their respective Programme Officers namely Dr. Neeraj Batish, Dr. Archana Chaudhry, Dr. Raj Kamal and Dr. Jitender Kumar. A number of activities were performed by the volunteers throughout the year. The participation by the youth in various social service activities is a matter of pride for the university. The NSS UTD volunteer, Ms. Harsha Verma participated in the Republic day parade at New Delhi on January 26, 2017 and again two volunteer Ms. Kriti Dheer and Mr. Rohit Pannu have been selected for the Republic Day Parade at New Delhi on January 26, 2018.
- ii) The NSS UTD organized a One Day Camp on the occasion of the Voters Day i.e. January 25, 2017 whereby the volunteers spread the idea of the importance of each vote. A Special Seven Days Camp was organized on the theme "DIGITAL INDIA" at village Mirzapur from March 02-08, 2017. More than hundred units of blood were donated by the PO's and the volunteers during Mega Blood Donation Camp organized by KUK. Vice Chancellor was the Chief Guest at the valedictory function of Special Seven Days Camp, where in his address he applauded the efforts of the volunteers and laid emphasis on the importance of making India a digital savvy society. A one day camp on Personality Development was organized on March 28, 2017 marking the tag end of the academic session.
- iii) A One Day Orientation Programme for the volunteers of the NSS was organized on August 31, 2017. The newly enrolled volunteers were told about the importance of joining NSS and the activities carried by it. Old volunteers shared their experiences. One day camp on National Unity and Harmony was organized on 15 November, 2017. The units also observed 'Communal Harmony Week' from November 19-25, 2017 and on the last day the Flag Day was celebrated.
- iv) Besides this the NSS UTD volunteers very actively participated in various activities including Ratnawali, Inter-Zonal Youth Festival and other activities of the University.
- v) In addition to this the NSS UTD KU Kurukshetra regularly organizes "Swachhta Abhiyaan" on 26th of every month and observes "Vehicle Free Day" on second Tuesday of every month.

16. Sports facilities

- i) 48 players of University Teaching Departments have participated in the North Zone/All India Inter University tournaments as members of Kurukshetra University Teams.

- ii) 27 players of University Teaching Departments were members of University teams who have won Medals/Position in North Zone/All India Inter-University tournaments. Several University Teaching Departments Students were Honoured/Cash Awarded by K.U.S.C. and Dean Students' Welfare as per details given below:-

17. Youth Red Cross Unit Activities

- i) The Youth Red Cross Unit (UTD) organized a Swarn Jayanti Health Awareness Camp for Girls titled as “ ” from 18-20 Jan, 2017 in the Girls Hostel complex of Kurukshetra University. Total 600 girls got examined in the camp.
- ii) In collaboration with District Red Cross Society, Five Days camp for First Aid Training was organized at Multi Art Cultural Centre, Kurukshetra. From 27th Feb. to 3rd March, 2017. More than 50 Volunteers from UTD and nearby affiliated colleges participated.
- iii) A one day Orientation Programme for Counsellors of YRC was organized on April 18, 2017. 40 Counsellors of Youth Red Cross from different colleges affiliated to Kurukshetra University participated in the Programme.
- iv) A five days Workshop on Self Defence was organized by Youth Red Cross in Girls Hostel Campus in collaboration with Chief Warden (Girls) from 20th to 25th August, 2017 where Sh. Rajesh Sharma, Shri Krishna Marshal Art Centre, Kurukshetra gave self defence training to more than 200 girls.
- v) The volunteers of Youth Red Cross Unit (UTD) participated in State level Camp at Varindavan from 20th to 25th September, 2017. 19 girl volunteers participated in the camp.
- vi) A First Aid Post was also setup in the Ratnawali Festival in the University held from 10th to 14th October, 2017. During festival about 275 people including participants and other public availed the benefits in terms of First Aid Services through this post.
- vii) A blood Donation Camp was organized by YRC, UTD on 25th October, 2017 in collaboration with the Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences, KUK. More than 135 volunteers got registered for the blood donation. 106 donors donated blood which included teaching and non-teaching staff of the university

18. Legal Literacy Club (UTD, KUK) Activities

A Legal Literacy Club is functioning under the supervision of Dean Students' Welfare. The students associated with this club attend Rural Lok Adalats, Legal Literary and awareness camps in the nearby rural areas. Besides it, the students of University Teaching Departments create awareness among the rural people relating to the burning issues like Female Feticide, Dowry System, Drug Addiction, Legal Literacy, Rights of Women, Child and Old age parents.

The volunteers of the club launched a campaign to aware the people regarding cleanliness and about the disease of Dengue in the nearby areas of the University campus. The students of the university used to attend the Lok Adalats /Rural Lok Adalats held by the District Court, Kurukshetra from time to time. On the occasion of World AIDS Day (1.12.2017) and National Voters Day (25.1.2017), volunteers visited the nearby rural areas and created awareness amongst the residents.
