

The UGC-Human Resource Development Centre formerly known as UGC-Academic Staff College, is the oldest of the HRDC Centers in the state of Haryana. Since its inception in 1987, it has successfully organized 208 Refresher Courses and 80 Orientation Programmes for the teaching faculty, besides holding 07 seminars for College Principals. In the last five years, the Centre, spreading its wings, has made an effort to reach out to contractual teachers and supporting staff as well. MAHATMA GANDHI ALL INDIA SERVICES COACHING INSTITUTE

The Mahatma Gandhi All India Services Coaching Institute was established in the year 1982. The prime purpose of the Institute is to encourage the students coming from the downtrodden and backward sections of the society including SC/ST students by way of providing them coaching for various competitive examinations and preparing them for various Civil Services examinations. The courses for Bank Probationary officers examination; M. B.A. Entrance Test; Haryana Civil Services (Executive Branch) and Remedial Coaching for the target section of the candidates have also been undertaken by the institute.

The Institute has organized two coaching courses (two weeks each) for UGC NET Paper-I in the Months of January, 2017 and September, 2017.

DR. RADHAKRISHNAN FOUNDATION FUND

Dr. Radhakrishnan Foundation Fund was established in the University in the year 1994 for raising donation and mobilization of resources for overall development of the University under Finance Resources Mobilization (FRM) services of the University Grants Commission. Only the interest accruing on the Fund is utilized as per the guidelines approved by the Executive Council of the University. The decisions for allocation of money are taken by the Standing Committee of Dr. Radhakrishnan Foundation Fund.

The interest money is utilized mainly for the welfare of the Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate students of affiliated/maintained colleges and University Teaching Departments of the University and the Directorate of Distance Education in the following ways.

The Fund awards Dr. Radhakrishnan Foundation Scholarships of the value of Rs.250/- p.m. to Undergraduate and Rs.300/- to the Postgraduate students as follows:

1. Undergraduate Scholarship @ Rs.250/- p.m.

a. Merit-cum-Meansb. Means50

2. Postgraduate Scholarship @ Rs.300/- p.m.

a. Merit-cum-Meansb. Merit25

- 3. Whosoever wins National Level Bravery Awards/President Medals etc. will get Scholarship @ Rs.250/- and Rs.300/- per month at the level of Undergraduate and Postgraduate courses respectively.
- 4. Financial Assistance is granted to needy and deserving students of Directorate of Distance Education on the recommendations of a committee as may be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.
- 5. Two Kargil Shaheed Capt. Jintu Gogoi Memorial Scholarships @ Rs.300/- p.m. instituted in the name of an erstwhile student of the Deptt. of Social Work of the University were allowed to be given out of Dr. Radhakrishnan Foundation Fund to the toppers of all the University Teaching Departments (excluding Science Departments). These scholarships will be given to two Departments in alphabetical order each year.
- 6. Two Kargil Shaheed Sh. St Pal Singh Memorial Scholarships @ Rs.300/- p.m. instituted in the name of an erstwhile student of the Department of Physics of the University were allowed to be given out of Dr. Radhakrishnan Foundation Fund to the toppers of Science Departments to be rotated on yearly basis in alphabetical order.
- 7. Two scholarships @ Rs.300/- p.m. in the name of Kalpana Chawla Memorial Scholarships to be awarded to the toppers of Science and Technology Departments (to be rotated on yearly basis in alphabetical orders).
- 8. Scholarships @ Rs.250/- p.m. as educational assistance to one ward of each deceased employees of the University who is pursuing studies in the University.
- 9. The students with disability of 80% or more with family income from all sources not exceeding Rs.1.00 lac per annum will be given scholarships of Rs.1000/- per month. The students of University Teaching Departments and Colleges on the campus will only be eligible for scholarships out of Dr. Radhakrishnan Foundation Fund. The applicant should submit and income certificate from the employer is case of employees, and in other cases in the form of an Affidavit duly attested by the 1st Class Magistrate.
- 10. In case of BPL Card Holders, the following Scholarships out of Dr. Radhakrishnan Foundation Fund are introduced from the session 2005-06.

Workshops

On March 8-9, 2017 the Centre organized Haryana Swarna Jayanti National Seminar on Women in Haryana: A Review. A book 'Women in Haryana: A Statistical Review' was also released on the occasion. About 35 research papers on various themes related to women's roles, status, identity and contribution in Haryana were presented in this interdisciplinary seminar.

Organized a National Workshop on 'Mainstreaming Gender in Higher Education' on 13-15 September, 2017. About 65 women faculty from the universities of Haryana and neighbouring states and affiliated colleges of Kurukshetra University attended the workshop.

University Level Competition

Organised University Level Competition as part of Nationwide Competition to Create Awareness about the Legal Rights of Women in Collaboration with National Commission for Women, New Delhi on 16 November 2017. About 350 students from various social sciences and science departments of the university participated in the competition.

Chhatra Se Chhatra Ka Sashaktikaran

Launched a drive on Chhatra Se Chhatra Ka Sashaktikaran where 3 students of Women's Studies who are already having degree in Law and 4 students of Institute of Law, KU will make girl students of the campus aware of their legal rights from the next semester starting from Jan. 2018.

Extension Activities

(a) Training in Tailoring & Embroidery

The Centre has been providing 6 months Training in Tailoring & Embroidery to rural women from August, 2006. Till now, 22 centres in villages surrounding Kurukshetra have been successfully completed.

Gender Sensitization lectures have been organized from time to time for these groups of rural women regarding female foeticide, dowry, domestic violence, health, education and empowerment of women etc. Rallies have been organized and street plays have also been enacted by the students of the Centre on such issues on different occasions.

(b) Field Action

The Centre has organized a number of awareness building programmes for the rural women and girls on the issues of declining sex ratio in Haryana and PNDT Act, Domestic Violence, Dowry, Girls Education, Crime against Women and Women's Health. They were also informed about anemia, health and nutrition among adolescent and pregnant women, importance of sanitation and hygiene, Dowry Prohibition Act and Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act. The methodology for these awareness programmes consisted of a variety of tools like interactive sessions with the audience, banners, posters and charts depicting the statistical information on sex ratio and adverse effects of female foeticide on women and society. The number of participants ranged from 30 to more than hundred in these awareness raising programmes.

A number of villages and semi urban areas of Kurukshetra like Narkatari, Samsipur, Mirzapur, Dayalpur, Brahman Kheri, Thanesar, Mirzapur Colony, Kheri Markanda, Gandhi Nagar, Shanti Nagar, Mess Workers Colony NIT, Lakshaman Colony, Kainthala Khurd and Bhatta Colony have been covered and women and girls are made aware about important issues and laws related to women.

(c). Advocacy

Advocacy on important issues such as Declining Sex Ratio, PNDT Act, Crime against Women, Sexual Harassment of Women at the Workplace Act and Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) of Kurukshetra University against Sexual Harassment of Women at the Workplace was conducted in the Institute of Law for Students and Research Scholars.
