STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

On the representations of the Principals of various Sanskrit Institutes Associated with KUK, the Chairperson, Department of Sanskrit and the Dean, Faculty of Indic Studies have recommended to exempt passing of Sanskrit subject in the qualifying examination i.e. Matriculation and 10+2 examination for admission to Visharda Part-I and Shastri Part-I Classes respectively w.e.f. the session 2017-18.

Since the meeting of the Academic Council was not being held shortly and the above mentioned amendment was to be implemented w.e.f. the session 2017-18, the Vice-Chancellor took the above action.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

While considering the above mentioned letter (**Annexure Pages 4(1)**), the Committee, constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, in its meeting held on 02.08.2018 recommended as under:

- (i) The above letter may be implemented in all the courses except M.P.Ed., B.P.Ed., D.P.Ed. and C.P.Ed. being run in the University Teaching Departments/Institutes and affiliated/maintained Colleges w.e.f. the session 2017-18.
- (ii) The Committee observed that it is not possible in the courses like M.P.Ed., B.P.Ed., D.P.Ed. and C.P.Ed. to allow admission to such students and provide maternity leave upto 45 days as all the activities depends upon the physical practice. Provision for admissions to these courses already exists in the eligibility criteria may be continued.
- (iii) The Dean of Colleges may be requested to circulate the above instructions to all the affiliated colleges/institutes for implementation w.e.f. the session 2017-18.
- (iv) The following provision may be added at appropriate places in the Ordinance-V "Condoning Deficiency in the Lectures etc." appearing at pages 22-25 of the K.U. Cal. Vol.I, 2009 with the approval of the competent authority.

"Unless otherwise specifically provided in the concerned Ordinance, a woman student may be granted 45 days maternity leave by the Chairperson/Director/Principal of the Department/Institute/College concerned on the recommendation of Government Hospital Authorities as applicable as per prescribed rules in the case of Government Women Employees with the condition that the concerned student will have to attend the extra classes as per the requirement of attendance of the specified course/professional/research program."

Accordingly, the decision of the State Government has been implemented w.e.f. the session 2017-18. In view of the recommendation at Sr. No. (iv), the above is for consideration.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

(i) As per recommendation of Chairperson, Dept. of Electronic, K.U.K. through Dean, Faculty of Science regarding recognition of M.Tech. (VLSI Design & Embedded System) of Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology, Hisar as equivalent to M.Tech. (Microelectronics & VLSI Design) of K.U.K. and (ii) as per recommendation of Chairperson, Dept. of Music & Dance, K.U.K. through Dean, Faculty of Indic Studies regarding recognition of Master of Performing Art (MPA) as equivalent to M.A. (Music) of this University for the purpose of higher studies at this university the Equivalence Committee after detailed discussion recommends as under:

- (i) **THE COURSE M.TECH. (VLSI DESIGN & EMBEDDED SYSTEM) OF G.J.U., HISAR IS RECOMMENDED AS EQUIVALENT TO M.TECH (MICROELECTRONICS & VLSI DESIGN) OF KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF HIGHER STUDIES.**
- (ii) **MASTER OF PERFORMING ART (MPA) OF KUK IS RECOMMENDED AS EQUIVALENT TO M.A. (MUSIC) OF KUK FOR THE PURPOSE OF HIGHER STUDIES.**

Since the above recommendation of the Equivalence Committee have to be implemented immediately and the meeting of the Academic Council was not being held shortly the Vice-Chancellor took the above action.

6. To approve the recommendations of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor for award of separate Medal to the candidates appearing under CBCS courses running in the University Teaching Departments and 1st Batch will complete the Degree during the examinations to be held in May, 2018 onward.

Note : As per past precedent, the Syllabus/Scheme of examinations for University Teaching Departments and affiliated Colleges was same and Medal was awarded to one candidate. At present the scheme of examinations for the University Teaching Departments (under CBCS) & affiliated Colleges is separate. The issue was discussed in the Academic Council meeting held on 09.01.2018 vide Resolution No. 43(2) and suggested as under:-

“Resolved that Controller of Examinations will examine the issue.”

The case was put up to the Vice-Chancellor & he constituted a Committee of the following:

The Committee recommended that the separate Medal should be awarded to students appeared under CBCS w.e.f. the completion of course session 2016-2018 subject to approval of the Academic Council.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The University has adopted U.G.C. (Credit Framework for Online Learning Courses through SWAYAM) Regulations, 2016 w.e.f the session 2017-18. All the Chairpersons/Directors of UTDs/Institutes have been asked to adopt suitable course in their Department/Institute.

In the meeting of Deans Committee, held on 28.11.2017 in the office of the Dean Academic Affairs to consider the proposals of Massive Open Online Courses of different Faculties of the University, following Departments are interested to adopt these MOOCs and the Committee has recommended that as the Chairperson who adopt the MOOC may be allowed to send their complete proposals and other who could not find the subjects on SWAYAM Portal can continue to log into SWAYAM Portal at the frequent intervals to check the availability of the courses and whenever the relevant courses are available they can also send their proposals for adoption:-

1. Department of Education
2. Department of Fine Arts.
3. Department of Computer Science & Applications
4. U.I.E.T.

In view of the above, the Committee in its meeting held on 21.02.2018 has recommended draft Rules & Regulations/Guidelines for adopting Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) through SWAYAM under National Mission on Education through Information Communication Technology (NME-ICT) Programme of Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Government of India, New Delhi, **as per Annexure Pages 8(1-4)**, w.e.f. the session 2017-18 (common for all the Online Courses i.e. the courses presently adopted and the courses which would be adopted in future) keeping in view U.G.C Credit (Credit Framework for Online Learning courses through SWAYAM) Regulation 2016.

Since meeting of the Academic Council was not being held shortly and the above mentioned Rules/Guidelines were to be implemented w.e.f. the session 2017-18, the Vice-Chancellor took the above action.

(Multimedia), it was resolved that these five year integrated courses be run as three year degree courses and nomenclature may be B.Sc. (Graphics & Animation) and B.Sc. (Multimedia).
