The Committee considered the proposal of the Chairperson, Dept. of Philosophy for starting a new course "Diploma in Yoga & Applied Philosophy" (one year) under SFS w.e.f. the session 2019-20. The Chairperson has also justified the introduction of this course that in the modern world Philosophy of Yoga and other applied aspect of Philosophy are very essential for Physical, Mental and Spiritual Health. Yoga is an Ancient Indian Philosophy which can help human beings learn the practical methods as well as theoretical principals for all round development of mind, body and soul. The students will learn methods and principals which can help them in their personal well being as well as provide them job opportunities in the field of Yoga and Philosophy (Annexure-I).

As per information supplied by the Chairperson, Deptt. of Philosophy, K.U.K. for introduction of this course in the Department w.e.f 2019-20, "Diploma in Yoga & Applied Philosophy" will be introduced under SFS in annual system with intake 30 and fee of Rs. 12000+ other charges (Annual) of each student. The eligibility of the course will be as under:-

" 10+2 pass from any recognized board/university with 45% marks."

Further, the workload of the course will be covered from the existing faculty. For uncovered workload, if any, contractual/guest/part time faculty may be engaged. The Chairperson, Deptt. of Philosophy submitted the expected income and expenditure of the course as at Annexure-I. Therefore, running this course under SFS is financially viable.

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Considering the above, the committee recommends that "EG Diploma in Yoga & Applied Philosophy" (one year) course under SFS in annual system may be started in the Deptt. of Philosophy w.e.f 2019-20 as proposed by the Chairperson, Deptt. of Philosophy, K.U.K. as at Annexure-I.

The Committee considered the proposal submitted by the Director, Institute of Mass Communication & Media Technology, K.U.K. regarding introduction of B.Sc. (Printing & Packaging Technology) course (3-years) under SFS in semester system in Institute of Mass Communication & Media Technology, K.U.K. which has been recommended by the Dean, Faculty of Commerce & Management, K.U.K. (Annexure-I).

As per information supplied by the Director, Institute of Mass Communication & Media Technology, K.U.K. for introduction of this course in the Institute w.e.f. 2019-20, B.Sc. (Printing & Packaging Technology) course (3-years) will be introduced under SFS in semester system with intake 40 and fee of Rs. 40000/- annual of each student which will be charged in two equal installments. The eligibility of the course will be as under:-

" 10+2 passed in any stream from the CBSE or a recognized board with 50% marks or its equivalent there to"

Further, the workload of the course will be covered from the existing regular & contractual faculty of the Institute and no additional financial burdon is required in this case. The Director of the Institute of Mass Communication & Media Technology also submitted the expected income & expenditure of the course as at Annexure-II. Therefore, running this course under SFS is financially viable.

The Director has also justified that this course is industry oriented course in the area of packaging & printing industries. This course will provide entrepreneurship and jobs to the

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graduate skilled professionals in India and abroad. The packaging industries are world's 2<sup>nd</sup> largest industries. With the demands of packaged products for the society as well as in all industries like pharmaceutical, cosmetic, food & beverage, tools and equipments etc., the demands of skilled professionals in printing and packaging industries will also increase in the future. The course is designed in such a way that it will cater to these needs.

Considering the above, the Committee recommends that B.Sc. (Printing & Packaging Technology) course (3-years) under SFS in semester system may be started in the Institute of Mass Communication & Media Technology w.e.f. the session 2019-20 as proposed by the Director, Institute of Mass Communication & Media Technology, K.U.K.

The Committee considered the proposal submitted by the Dean, Faculty of Education & Chairperson, Dept. of Education regarding introduction of Sign Language Interpretation (DISLI)-2 year course in semester system under SFS in the Dept. of Education, K.U.K. in compliance with the letter of DHE, Govt. of Haryana vide reference memo No. 18/36-2019UNP (4) dated 12.02.2019, in which it was desired that as per guidelines/norms of RCI, training courses be started in K.U. in view of the Judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Rajiv Rathore V/s Union of India and report be submitted to them.

The Chairperson, Department of Education also pointed out that this course can be started in 2020-2021, as the approval of Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), New Delhi (regulatory body) is mandatory to start a new course. The visiting team inspects the institution for availability of physical and academic infrastructure, which is a time-consuming process. Besides, online application for applying for the course is subject to the opening of the RCI portal during 2019 i.e. as and when it is notified on the RCI website.

The Committee examined the proposal for introduction of this course with financial implications (Recurring and Non-Recurring Expenditure). Therefore, to meet the requirement of the course as per RCI norms, the Committee recommends to start this course in the Dept. of Education w.e.f. 2020-21 as under:-

1.1 The duration of the course of instruction for award of Post-Graduate Diploma in Export Marketing Management/Personnel Management & Labour Welfare/ Marketing Management/Forensic Science & Criminology/ Human Rights/Urban Development/Taxation/Cyber Law and Intellectual Property Rights examination shall ordinarily be one academic year and shall be offered through the Directorate of Distance Education. The examinations shall ordinarily be held annually in the month of May/June on the dates to be notified by the Controller of Examinations.

The duration of the course of instruction for award of Post-Graduate Diploma in Export Marketing Management/Personnel Management & Labour Welfare/Marketing Management/Forensic Science & Criminology/Human Rights/Urban Development/ Taxation/Cyber Law and Intellectual Property Rights/ Business Analytics/Buddhist Studies examination shall ordinarily be one academic year and shall be offered through the Directorate of Distance Education except Buddhist Studies, which will be offered through Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Studies Centre. The examinations shall ordinarily be held annually in the month of May/June on the dates to be notified by the Controller of examinations.

Company in case of P.G Diploma in Personnel Management & Labour Welfare and PG Diploma in Marketing Management and 3-week practical training in a company/CA Firm in case of P.G. Diploma in duly approved by the Course co-Taxation, ordinator concerned of the Directorate of Distance Education. After successful completion of the Incompany training/Laboratory Training, as the case may be, each candidate will submit a copy of the Training Report in the Directorate of Distance Education by 31st August of the Year. Company in case of P.G Diploma in Personnel Management & Labour Welfare/P.G Diploma in Marketing Management; 3-week practical training in a company/CA Firm in case of P.G. Diploma in Taxation and 6-8 week practical training in a Business Enterprise in case of P.G. Diploma in Business Analytics duly approved by the Course co-ordinator concerned of the Directorate of Distance Education. After successful completion of the In-company training/Laboratory Training, as the case may be, each candidate will submit a copy of the Training Report in the Directorate of Distance Education by 31st August of the Year. The Training Report will be evaluated by the External Examiner. However, in case of P.G. Diploma in Taxation, comprehensive viva-voce will be conducted by an External Examiner appointed by the University to evaluate the Training Report.

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



The Committee perused the letter submitted by Officiating Principal, Guru Nanak Khalsa College, Yamuna Nagar regarding admission of the students of B.Com. and B.Sc.III (Sports Sci) keeping in view of the Notification No. ACR-III/19/10374-10392 dated 26.06.2019 issued with regard to relaxation in eligibility conditions for admission in Post-graduate Courses. The Committee also perused the request of the Director Distance to also allow the students having re-appear in one paper of the final year of graduation for seeking admission in the Distance Education. The Committee observed that Colleges are facing queries with regard to the condition mentioned with regard to not allow the student in the concerned P.G. After detailed deliberations, the Committee unanimously recommends that the above notification be amended as follows:-

To allow admission to the students having re-appear in only one paper either in 5<sup>th</sup> OR 6<sup>th</sup> Semester at Under-graduate level for admission to the Post-graduate courses/P.G. Diploma (s) w.e.f. the Session 2019-20 (other than the subject/paper in which he/she has sought admission in Post-graduate Courses), in the affiliated Colleges/Directorate of Distance Education subject to the condition that they will not be allowed promotion

Respected Sir,

It is humbly brought to your kind notice on behalf of the Haryana Govt. Aided Colleges Principals Association that the student strength in postgraduate courses especially in Humanities stream is constantly declining in the colleges for the last many years. The main reason is the provision of promotion to next class at undergraduate level inspite of reappears in all papers. As a result of which the pass percentage in undergraduate courses especially in the final year comes down significantly.

Due to this reason and the prevailing eligibility condition for admission to postgraduate courses (clear cut pass in all subjects in lower class) maximum seats remain vacant especially in Humanities subjects in every college in spite of adequate faculty and infrastructure. As a result of which the academic environment and revenue/generation in the colleges is suffering badly due to less admission in postgraduate courses.

In order to augment the intake of students in Postgraduate Courses especially in Arts stream, it is requested that a student having Reappear in one subject at undergraduate level other than the opted subject for post-graduation may be allowed to seek admission to a postgraduate course. This eligibility condition is already prevailing in the Panjab University Chandigarh.

This matter has already been discussed with your good self in presence of Principals of some colleges and your good self-had desired proper written representation in the matter.

Your good self is humbly requested to consider this request sympathetically in order to facilitate the admission seekers and for optimum utilisation of the qualified faculty which remains under-utilized in most of the Govt. Aided Colleges.

Needless to say that It will also generate additional revenue for the colleges as well as for the university and it will help in increasing the total number of admissions in colleges without any adverse qualitative effect on the postgraduate course.

I hope that your gracious self will give due consideration to the aforementioned submission and take a positive decision in this respect.

In case you find it desirable to constitute a committee to look into various aspects and implications in this matter, I request you to include one Principals' representative in such a committee.
