MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

In furtherance of their mutual interest in the fields of education and research, and as a contribution towards the betterment of Social and Moral life of citizens of India and Mauritius, Srimad Bhagwad Gita Addhyan Kendra, Department of Philosophy, Kurukshetra University having its registered address at Kurukshetra-136119, Haryana, India (hereinafter referred to as KUK)

and

Mahatma Gandhi Institute (hereinafter referred to as MGI), Mauritius, entered into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on this 13th day of January, 2020 with broad terms & conditions as follows:

ARTICLE-I

The MoU involves collaboration between KUK and MGI (both also referred to as institution in related disciplines).

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

- (i) The setting up of a KUK Chair of Sustainable Peace & Bhagavad Gita at MGI;
- (ii) Exchange of Staff and Students (Faculty, Research Scholars, Post Graduate & Doctoral Students and Research Projects) regarding Academics and Research for the mutual benefit of both institutions on the teachings of Srimad Bhagwad Gita and Indian Philosophy, Sanskrit and other related fields;
- (iii) Exchange of Students for pursuing Courses of Study and Academic Programs for mutual benefit of both institutions;
- (iv) Collaboration in Teaching, Research & Development, and Spiritual Counselling (Practice of Philosophical Praxis);
- (v) Exchange of Academic and Research Material and Publications;
- (vi) Co-operation in Project Proposals and Research Activities of mutual interest on Srimad Bhagavadgita's teachings;
- (vii) The provision of Cultural and Intellectual enrichment opportunities for the Staff and Students of both institutions;

- (viii) Publication of Research Papers;
- (ix) Exchange of Faculty members and Students for Summer/Winter vacations;
- (x) Hosting International Conference/Seminar/Workshops;
- (xi) State of Art Technology to promote and disseminate teachings of Bhagavad Gita;
- (xii) Jointly design new courses in accordance with the expertise available and as per the identified academic needs of both institutions;
- (xiii) Assistance for capacity building and counselling skills for staff and new recruits;
- (xiv) Publication of Intellectual Properties (IPs) developed jointly through Project/Research Collaboration. Such IP would acknowledge joint Inventorship of Personnel/Students belonging to both the institutions, as applicable;
- (xv) Writing Books/Booklets jointly in the areas of mutual interest.

ARTICLE-II

The activities under this MoU will include:

1. Staff Exchange:

Staff Exchange activities cover visits to either institution for any of the following purposes:

- (i) Undertaking Joint Teaching, Evaluation and Research;
- (ii) Attachment of Staff for purposes of Curriculum Development and Review, Attendance in Courses, the upgrading of Teaching and Research Skills and delivery of lectures;
- (iii) Participation in Seminars, Colloquia, and other types of Academic discussions;
- (iv) Contributions of Teaching Programmes;
- (v) Co-supervision of Post Graduate Students/M.Phil. and Ph.D. Scholars;
- (vi) Conduct Study Tours;
- (vii) Research and Joint Consultancy Research Work;

2. Student Exchange:

Student Exchange activities (for Post Graduate & Doctoral Students) cover visits to either institution for any of the following purposes:

- (i) Participation in Research & Teaching programme;
- (ii) Students exchange activities;
- (iii) Visit of K.U. Students & Research Scholars at MGI, Mauritius and vice-versa;
- (iv) Exchange of relevant Academic Materials will be carried out subject to the mutual agreement of both institutions;
- (v) Visit of K.U. Delegation at MGI, Mauritius and vice-versa.

ARTICLE-III

- (i) The implementation of cooperation based on this MoU shall be dealt with between the relevant Faculties and Divisions/Departments of both the institutions;
- (ii) Wherever necessary, a specific plan shall be worked out for each activity setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration;
- (iii) Such plans shall be subject to the approval of the appropriate authorities of each institution;
- (iv) To facilitate the development of such plans, each institution shall nominate a member of its staff to coordinate activities arising under this MoU.

ARTICLE-IV

- (i) Both institutions agree and undertake to keep confidential at all times any information and/or data that may be exchanged, acquired and/or shared in connection with the area of cooperation as mentioned above unless otherwise the same information already exists in public domain.
- (ii) This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual consent of parties and any amendment shall enter in force upon signature by both parties.
- (iii) Both Parties shall endeavour to amicably settle any dispute which may arise during the execution of this Memorandum of Understanding.

ARTICLE-V

Ownership of any findings of any joint research shall be vested in both institutions on this MoU and any publication regarding the same shall only be possible after prior approval from both institutions.

ARTICLE-VI

The MoU shall remain in force for a period of 3 (Three) years commencing from the date of signing and may be reviewed by mutual consent by serving 3 (Three) months written notice to the other institution. Upon renewal, both institutions shall select either to proceed with the existing or new terms of understanding.

ARTICLE-VII

Both KUK and MGI reserve the right to terminate this MoU by either institution giving 3 (Three) months written notice to the other. Where such termination occurs, the provisions of this MoU shall continue to apply to ongoing activities until their completion.


ARTICLE-VIII

Participating staff and students involved in any activities under this MoU must adhere to the law of the country and the rules and regulations of the host institutions.





4. In the event the Scholarship is not being awarded to deserving students due to any reason including being recipient of any other scholarship/stipend/financial assistance the next student will be awarded the Scholarship.
5. The Scholarship will be effective from the session 2020-21.
6. The Vice-Chancellor will have the right to increase/decrease the value of the Scholarship according to the interest amount available on the Endowment Fund.
7. The merit list will be obtained from the Examination Branch to award the Scholarship.

8. A certificate in the name of "Dr. R.S Mehrotra Scholarship" will be given by the Chairperson, Department of Botany with the signatures of Chairperson and Donors/Donors Nominee.
9. In the event of tie in marks the student senior in age will be awarded scholarship. In the event of tie between any students will not be decided on the basis of laid down criteria the matter for deciding the student to award the scholarship or any other matter be referred to the Committee consisting of the following.

A meeting of the following members was convened today i.e. 07.11.2019 at 1.00 PM in the office of the Dean Academic Affairs, Kurukshetra to re-examine the issue regarding special mercy chance to the students of UG/PG and other professional courses. The following members were present :-

After detailed discussion the Committee recommends that a special mercy chance may be allowed to the students of UG/PG and other professional courses who have availed/exhausted all the permissible chances within prescribed period and fall within three years after permissible period i.e. session 2009-10 onward (B.Tech.), 2011-12 B. Tech. (LEET), 2011-12 onward (UG) and 2013-14 onward (PG) to pass Compartment/Re-appear/Improvement with an additional fee of Rs. 20,000/- + usual fees i.e. Rs. 1500/- for each examination. The Committee further recommends that in addition, the students of UG/PG/B. Tech. LEET courses of 2009-10 onward session will also be eligible for this special mercy chance with additional fee of Rs. 25,000/- + usual fee of Rs. 1500/- for Odd Semester (Re-appear/Improvement) examination to be held in Nov/Dec. 2019 & Even Semester (Compartment, Re-appear and Improvement of marks/Score, wherever applicable) to be held in April/May/June, 2020. The last date for submission of examination form for such students will be 18.11.2019 (4.00 PM) (for Odd Semesters) and the examination of this special mercy chance will be conducted as per current syllabus of the course.

The Committee perused the letter Memo.No.27/190-2018 Co (1) Dated 14th January, 2020 issued by the Deputy Director (Coordination) Higher Education Haryana, Panchkula and noted that there is a specific weightage in NAAC for representation of Colleges under Board of Studies. The Committee also discussed the present scenario and observed that there is need to give more representation of teachers of Govt. Colleges in the Board of Studies. Accordingly, the Committee ^{has} gone through the existing constitution of the Statute 28 i.e. Board of the Studies appearing in the K.U.Act,1986 (2016) and noticed that presently there is representation of Six teachers (including Principals) of the Under-graduate Classes from the Colleges including Directorate of Distance Education in the subject concerned according to Seniority in the U.G. Board of Studies. The Committee recommended that in order to give more representation of teachers of Govt. Colleges, atleast two teachers of Govt. Colleges should be given representation in the U.G. Board of Studies as per seniority. The Committee also observed that there is no need to change the constitution of P.G. Board of Studies.

After detailed deliberation, the Committee unanimously recommends the draft amendments/additions in the relevant Statute of Board of Studies may be made as per Annexure-I and put up to the higher authority for consideration.
