- **Note :** 1. The classes in UG/PG courses will commence w.e.f. 01.10.2021 in Online and Offline modes as per the situation.
 - The duration of 4 to 6 weeks industrial training to be undergone just after B.Tech. 2nd, 4th & 6th semester exams (being held in August 2021) has been reduced to 3 to 4 weeks. Furthermore, the industrial training can be pursued in online mode for the same.
 - 3. If the number of teaching/working days for any class falls less than 180 days (90 days in each semester) in the academic session 2021-22 due to some unforeseen reasons, it would be the responsibility of each Department/Institute/College to make good the loss by arranging extra classes (even on holidays) as & when required.
 - 4. For B.Tech. 3rd Semester Lateral Entry newly admitted students for the session 2021-22, special attention is to be paid by the concerned institute to make good the loss/deficit by arranging extra classes (even on holidays) as & when required to complete the syllabus in time. It would be the responsibility of the concerned institute. The Sessional tests can also be rescheduled for these students by the concerned institute as per need.

- 5. Further updates in the academic calendar would be incorporated as per need and notified from time to time w.r.t. the subsequent guidelines issued by the competent authority i.e. AICTE/State Government.
- 6. The students must adhere to the fulfillment of minimum attendance conditions regarding the classes.
