MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("Agreement") is made on the 29th of June 2021.

AMONGST :

(i) **CodeQuotient Pvt. Ltd** company incorporated under the laws of India having its corporate office at F429, Phase 8B, Industrial Area Sector 74, SAS Nagar, Punjab 160059, hereinafter referred to as "**CodeQuotient**";

(ii) **DCSA** (Department of Computer Science and Applications), **Kurukshetra University** having its campus at Kurukshetra, Haryana, (hereinafter referred to as the "Partner").

(individually a "Party" and collectively the "Parties").


WHEREAS

- A. CodeQuotient is in the business of training & software development and offers training programs that help students gain vital technology skills needed for success in today's workforce.
- B. The Partner is a UGC approved University and has always endeavored to launch programs that will create employable manpower, which is of crucial importance to the country.
- C. CodeQuotient shall collaborate with the University to enhance the quality of the education for students thereby enabling them to meet industry needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth herein and for other good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereto agree as follows :

1. This MOU is for collaboration between both parties, for mutual benefit, to enhance the quality of the educational experience of students of the Partner by offering online training and Internships. Following are the activities under this program:

Activity #	Description
1	Access to CodeQuotient online coding platform/courses to all the students and teachers of the Partner.
2	Online/On-campus training.
3	Industrial Training (Summer/Winter) to the selected students.
4	Internships/Jobs to the selected students.



2. The Partner shall be responsible for providing the requisite infrastructure, network , internet access, accommodation/food/transport (as per University norms) to the trainers and any other facility required for the on-campus training. There shall be no financial liability for the partners to MOU expect in case of training scheduled by the partner.
3. Trainings will be planned as per schedule mutually agreed upon by both the parties.
4. The Partner shall provide First slot to CodeQuotient during campus placements for hiring the students trained by CodeQuotient. And selected students would not be allowed to appear in any further campus placement drive, offering the same/less salary package.
5. Both the parties agree that CodeQuotient is not obliged on account of this MOU to recruit any fixed number of students from the Partner.
6. Both parties hereby agree to designate a representative from its side who will be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party.
7. Both parties shall take all reasonable steps to ensure the successful completion of the collaboration, and co-operate with each other in duly carrying out the obligation agreed upon.
8. Each of CodeQuotient and Partner may use the name and logo of the other Party (with prior approval) in commercially reasonable marketing, advertising and/or publicity releases, and describe work completed under this Agreement in summary and general form, without revealing any of the other party's confidential information so long as the relationship between the Parties is accurately portrayed, without securing additional written approval of the other Party.
9. Each party shall ensure that they do not actively solicit the faculty of the other party who is involved in the implementation of this MOU during the period of such faculty's involvement with the program and for twelve (12) months thereafter.
10. Each party shall respect the other's intellectual property (IP) and shall not use any trade name, trademark, symbol or designation belonging to the other, without prior written approval. No party shall hold out as an agent or representative of the other or create any liability for the other. The parties shall indemnify the other for the breach of this clause.
11. Both parties shall maintain confidentiality about any information, course material, plans, discussions, strategies or any material which shall be deemed to be confidential and marked accordingly. Any information, course material or the like in the public domain shall not be part of this commitment.



12. This MOU shall be valid for 3 years from the date of signing and each party shall be at full liberty to terminate the collaboration, with a notice period of 3 months.

13. The parties hereby agree that they are not bound exclusively by this MOU and are at liberty to enter into any separate agreements or arrangements with any third party without reference to the other party.

14. This MOU is an indication of good faith and intent on the part of both parties and does not create any legal obligations between them. In the event of any differences or disputes arising from the implementation of the provisions of this MOU, the parties shall as far as possible settle such differences or disputes in good faith by consultation or negotiation between the parties.

15. This MOU shall be governed by the laws of India and Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh shall have exclusive jurisdiction.

 4. No Amount is Payable by The University/Students/Teachers for the purpose of this present collaboration/service prescribed herein.
 5. This agreement does not include financial compensation from the UNIVERSITY and CYPE. The CYPE software included in the agreement shall not be used for commercial use. There is no liability on the University regarding use of software by the students/teachers.
 6. This present MoU may be renewed on an annual basis, with prior acceptance by both parties.
 7. As proof of compliance with the above, this document is signed at the place and on the date indicated at the start of this document.
 8. The annual review by both the parties will include program updates and the addition of new programs that appear during the period of validity of this present MoU.
 9. CYPE guarantees compliance with current regulations regarding the Protection of Personal Data, and in particular that stipulated in the Spanish Organic Law 3/2018 of 5th December on the "Protection of Personal Data". Under no circumstances will the provision of services be understood as a transfer of data but rather as a "Data Processing Order"
 10. CYPEs periodically conducts workshops/symposiums/conferences etc. For such events; any participant from University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.







The MOU is made on the 25th day of August month in the year of 2020, at Kurukshetra, Haryana, between Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra (hereinafter called KUK) include his/her successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the First Party

AND

Indian Council of Agricultural Research – Indian Institute of Wheat & Barley Research, Karnal (hereinafter called ICAR-IIWBR) with its headquarters at Karnal include his/her successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the Second Party.

WHEREAS

The parties which wish to establish a friendly relationship to promote and accelerate the programmes of academic cooperation in the areas of mutual concern, have decided to enter into this MoU and agree hereby as per the articles given below:

GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1 DEFINITIONS

- (a) "University" means Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana.
- (b) "KUK" means Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra
- (c) "ICAR-IIWBR" means Indian Council of Agricultural Research – Indian Institute of Wheat & Barley Research

1.2 RELATION BETWEEN THE PARTIES AND SCOPE

- a. The KUK will recognize the IIWBR as an Institute for research for students of M.Sc. and Ph.D in the disciplines of Biotechnology and allied Biological Sciences. The KUK will recognize scientists of the ICAR-IIWBR as recommended by its Director as faculty for research guidance of M.Sc/Ph.D students. The major supervisor/advisor shall be from KUK and scientists of ICAR-IIWBR as recommended by Director, ICAR-IIWBR can work as co-supervisor/co-major advisor in the advisory committee of the student.

b. Research instrumentation facility and library facilities available with KUK and ICAR-IIWBR will be made available to the faculty and research scholars.

c. There shall be an exchange of students and faculty/scientist staff for research and academic purposes. Accommodation in the Hostel shall be arranged, wherever possible, as per extant rates.

d. It is understood that the KUK and the ICAR-IIWBR subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, caste or religion. Both the Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students, which violate principles of non-discrimination.

e. Both parties understand that the financial agreements will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on the availability of funds.

f. The student, major supervisor and the co-supervisor shall share the authorship of publication arising out of this research work. The authorship for the publication shall depend on the extent of contribution by the authors, by the mutual consent of both the parties.

g. A soft and hard copy of the thesis/dissertation will also be submitted to the ICAR-IIWBR after award of the degree by the KUK.

1.3 GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION

This MoU, its meaning and interpretation, and the relation between the parties shall be governed by the law applicable in India and they only shall have exclusive jurisdiction over matters relating to or arising from this MoU

1.4 LANGUAGE

This MoU has been executed in English language, which shall be the binding and controlling language for all matters relating to the meaning of interpretation of this MoU

1.5 LOCATION

Research implementation arising under this MoU shall be performed by the second party from the head offices at Karnal and/or its nearest regional office, in addition to Department of Biotechnology, Kurukshetra University as agreed upon by the first party.

1.6 AUTHORISED REPRESENTATIVES

Any section required or permitted to be taken and any document required or permitted to be executed under this MoU may be taken or executed

- a) On behalf of the first party, by the Registrar, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra or his/her designated representative.
- b) On behalf of the second party, by the Director, ICAR-IIWBR, Karnal or his/her designated representative.

2. COMMENCEMENT, COMPLETION, MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION OF THIS MoU

- 2.1 This MoU shall come into force from the date of signing, or other earlier date that is mutually agreed by the two parties.
- 2.2 The MoU shall be effective for a period of five years, but will be reviewed/renewed/modified (if needed) mutually by both the parties, based on the research outputs/outcomes.
- 2.3 This MoU may be modified/amended by mutual written agreement at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party.
- 2.4 The modification/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.
- 2.5 The MoU may be terminated prematurely by either party with mutual agreement by giving prior notice. Such notification must be given to the other party at least six months in advance from the effective date of termination.
- 2.6 All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of the MoU may be continued until their completion under the terms of this MoU.
- 2.7 After signing by the parties this MoU shall supersede and replace all prior MoU's between the parties.

3. MANAGEMENT

- 3.1 The Registrar, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and Director of ICAR-IIWBR will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.
- 3.2 The supervisors/advisory committee will meet at least once in a year in KUK or ICAR-IIWBR to review the progress.

4. RESEARCH COLLABORATION

KUK and ICAR-IIWBR will work on mutually agreed collaborative research projects funded by one or both parties and/or by a third party in areas of mutual interest. Each research collaboration will require the approval of competent authorities of both the parties.

5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- 5.1 The KUK and ICAR-IIWBR will be expected to ensure protection of the Intellectual Property Rights generated or likely to be generated during the students research work. The KUK and the IIWBR shall be the joint applicants for IPRs and the students and involved scientific staff shall be included as the inventor/breeder/author.
- 5.2 Each party will ensure appropriate protection of Intellectual property rights generated from cooperation pursuant to this MoU. Intellectual property rights, research publications and benefits arising out of collaborative research under these agreements shall be jointly sought/owned/shared by KUK and ICAR-IIWBR on case to case basis.

5.3 In case of evaluation of already developed technology/product, IPR shall rest with the providing party of the particular product/technology. The parties shall not assign any rights and obligations arising out of the IPR generated to inventions/activities carried out under the MoU to any third party without the consent of the other party.

6. ADMISSION AND FEES

6.1 All those students who wish to register for Master/Doctoral programmes under this MoU must apply for admission at the KUK. Students admitted under this MoU may do their course work as per prescribed curriculum of KUK at KUK and research at ICAR-IIWBR/KUK. Students allotted research work at ICAR-IIWBR will pay fees as per norms set by ICAR-IIWBR and ICAR New Delhi.

6.2 Allotment of students at the ICAR-IIWBR, if found violating the rules and regulations laid down by the parties or indulge in such activities that amount to tarnishing the image of either of the parties. The KUK will not complete the formalities of issuing the certificates to such students until they compensate the losses to the First party.

7. REPORTING OBLIGATION

The **Second Party** shall submit to the **First Party** reports and documents as may be specified and at such frequency as may be agreed upon between the two parties. The **Second Party** will collect and maintain the records of the students and shall monitor and report their progress to the **First Party**.

8. ARBITRATION

The parties would act strictly according to the relevant provisions of law while implementing this MoU. All questions related to this MoU arising during its term will be settled by the parties by mutual agreement. In case of any dispute that may crop up during execution of MoU the matter would be settled through arbitration by referring it to a committee appointed by the parties on mutual consent.

9. CONSEQUENCE OF BREACH AND PENALTIES

9.1 It shall be obligatory on part of either party to ensure timely Research implementation and facilitation as per the pre-approved work plan as agreed upon in the MoU.

9.2 In the event of breach of any term or conditions of this agreement, either party shall have the right to terminate the agreement and recover the costs incurred that are associated with the project.



The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.4 **Internships and Placement of Students:** Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs.
- 2.5 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of - **Printing Technologies and Packaging.**
- 2.6 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gaps and make them industry ready.
- 2.7 **Expert Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver expert lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.8 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting industrial exposure/ training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid initially for a period of 3 years. It can be extended further with mutual consent.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their existing obligations

CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent entities, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

AND WHEREAS it has been considered expedient to agree in writing to participate jointly in the projects requiring, expertise and logistics from both the parties, have decided to enter into this MOU and agree hereby as per articles given below:

Article 1: GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1: DEFINITIONS

KUK - means KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY, KURUKSHETRA

"LUVAS" - means LALA LAJPAT RAI UNIVERSITY OF VETERINARY AND ANIMAL SCIENCES

1.2: SCOPE

a) The **KUK** will recognize **LUVAS** as an institute for conducting research related to Life Science. The **KUK** will recognize Scientists of the **LUVAS** Institute as recommended by its Director in accordance with the University rules and regulations for research guidance.

(b) Research instrumentation facility and library facilities available with the First party and the Second party will be made available to the faculty and research Scholars. However, the costs of specific consumables will be born by the respective organizations.

(c) There shall be an exchange of students for academic, research and training purposes. Accommodation in the Hostel shall be arranged, wherever possible, as per extant rates. The duration of exchange visits will be determined by mutual consent between both the parties.

(d) It is understood that the First party and the Second party subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity.

(e) Both the institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and neither party shall impose criteria for exchange scholars or students, which violate principles of non-discrimination.

(f) Both parties understand that all financial agreements will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on the availability of funds.

(g) Any research publication arising out of collaboration work will be jointly published.

Article 2. COMMENCEMENT, COMPLETION, MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION OF THIS MoU

2.1 The MoU shall come into force from the date of signing.

2.2 The MoU shall be effective for a period of five years, but will be reviewed/renewed/modified (if needed) mutually by both the parties.

2.3 The MoU may be modified/amended by mutual written agreement at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party.

2.4 The modification/changes shall become part of MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

2.5 The MoU may be terminated prematurely by either party with mutual agreement by giving prior notice. Such notification must be given to the other party at least six months in advance from the effective date of termination.

2.6 All joint activities not completed at the expiration or termination of the MoU may be continued until their completion under the terms of this MoU.

Article 3: **MANAGEMENT**

3.1 Vice-Chancellor of the KUK through Principal, Institute of Integrated and Honors Studies and the Vice-Chancellor/Head of the Second party will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two organizations and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.

3.2 An Advisory Committee shall be constituted with representations from the first and second party.

3.3 The Advisory Committee will meet at least once in a year alternatively in the institutions of the First party and the Second party to review the activities.

Article 4: **RESEARCH COLLABORATION**

4.1 KUK and LUVAS will work on mutually agreed collaborative research projects funded by one or both parties and/or by a third party in areas of mutual interest. Each research collaboration will require the approval of competent authorities of both the parties.

4.2 Both parties acknowledge that exchange of students from one party to the other shall be subject to the availability of funds and shall comply with the regulations and policies of the First party and the Second party.

4.3 All questions related to this MoU arising during its term will be settled by the parties by mutual agreement. Disagreements at the operating level shall be forwarded to respective higher officials for appropriate resolution failing which and arbitrator of mutual acceptance may be identified for the settlement for dispute, if any.

4.4 All questions not foreseen related to this MoU will be handled by the parties by mutual agreement.

4.5 Nothing in this MoU is intended to affect other cooperation or collaborations between the parties.




National Bureau of Animal Genetic Resources (NBAGR) Karnal and Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra hereby sign the memorandum of understanding (MoU) for jointly undertaking the research program leading to M.Tech/Ph.D in the field of Animal genetics/Genomics/Biotechnology with the following terms and conditions and agree to carry out their respective responsibilities as detailed in the MoU.

Terms and Conditions:

- 1- The requirement for Major Advisor Guide. The criterion for allocation of Major Guide advisor will primarily be governed by intellectual input and time duration devoted for carrying out the research work at particular institution. It may be decided by mutual consent. If the major Guide is from ICAR Institute, the Co-guide will be from partnering university and vice-versa.
- 2- The students who will register for research programme with KUK and NBAGR shall pay University fee as per parent University norms applicable from time to time.
- 3- Students desiring to undertake research work at NBAGR/KUK will have to get the applications recommended from their respective institutes.
- 4- The students will be uniformly charged as fee of Rs. 20,000/- for training/research/dissertation up to duration of 3 months and @ Rs.30, 000/- per semester for the work exceeding three months. The fee structure is to be reviewed periodically after two years as per terms & conditions issued by ICAR from time to time. However, the students may be charged a fee of Rs. 10,000/- for the training duration of three months not leading to a dissertation/degree by NBAGR. The students will be required to do lab work as NBAGR for at least one year for Ph.D. Thesis.

- 5- The partnering institution may ensure that the students submit at least one paper from Master's thesis and two papers from Ph.D. thesis before thesis submission, as per parent University norms applicable from time to time.
- 6- The Students will protect the Intellectual Property Right (IPR) generated or likely to be generated during his/her research work. The IPRs shall rest with NBAGR (on behalf of ICAR), Karnal where the major part of research work would be carried out. Parents/Protection/Knowledge generated will be equally shared between both the parties i.e. both parties shall be joint owners of this intellectual property.

The Agreement is executed on this 01 day of October month, 2021 (Effective Date) by and between:

Siemens Centre of Excellence hereinafter called the "SCoE" established and operational at National Institute of Technology Kurukshetra, a premier technical Institution of National Importance incorporated under National Institute of Technology Act, 2007 having its permanent campus and office at Kurukshetra (hereafter referred to as 'NIT Kurukshetra', which expression shall include its successors and assigns) of the first part;

And

University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra hereinafter called the "UIET, KUK" (which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of the second part;

WHEREAS:

1. The National Institute of Technology Kurukshetra (formerly known as Regional Engineering College) Kurukshetra was started as a joint and co-operative venture of the Government of India and the Government of Haryana in 1963 with a view to catering to the needs of man-power in technology for the country. The college has been conferred with autonomy in financial and administrative matters to achieve rapid development. Because of this rich experience, this institution was granted Deemed University Status with the approval of the UGC/AICTE and Govt. of India in the year 2003 and renamed as National Institute of Technology, thereafter.
2. SCoE established in 2019 at NIT Kurukshetra premises with 90% investment from Siemens and 10% investment from NIT Kurukshetra. The SCoE operates with a primary objective of creating a robust technical education eco-system through its experience in industrial products and services. This SCoE is intended to bridge gap between industry requirements and technical education, and provide solution that makes technical institutes be more aligned with industry needs and make engineering graduate students, industry compliant / on par with industry expectations.
3. SCoE has eleven Laboratories namely: Design and Validation, Advanced Manufacturing, Test and Optimization, Automation, Electrical and Energy savings, Process Instrumentation, Mechatronics, CNC Machines, CNC Controller, Robotics, Metrology, through which different services are offered to Academic Institutions and Industries.

4. Vision – SCoE

To be a globally recognized and leading center for skill development, training and translational research for empowering indigenous manufacturing

Mission –SCoE

- i. To empower the Indian youth with industry relevant skills in manufacturing technologies by education and training securing rewarding employment opportunities
- ii. To develop capabilities and building capacity for indigenous manufacturing in collaboration with industry, academia, and government agencies
- iii. To provide access to state-of the art machinery and software tools for innovative design and developing new manufacturing technologies

5. Details of University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra

The Kurukshetra University was established in 1956 as a unitary residential University and its foundation Stone was laid by late Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the first President of India. This is "A+" Grade NAAC accredited oldest University of the State. Recently, The University has been ranked among top 100 universities of the country and obtained the prestigious grant from Rashtriya Uchhatar Shiksha Abhiyaan (RUSA). University Institute of Engineering & Technology (UIET) was established by Kurukshetra University in 2004 with objective to develop as a "Centre of Excellence" and offer quality technical education and to undertake research in Engineering & Technology. Presently, the institute is offering four B. Tech (Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Biotechnology and Mechanical Engineering) and six M. Tech. courses in the technically important disciplines of Computer Science Engineering (with the Specialization of Computer Engg.), Electronics and Communication Engineering, Mechanical Engg. (with the specialization of Industrial & Production Engg., and Thermal Engg.), Biotechnology, and Electrical Engg. The institute is offering Ph.D. programs in various engineering disciplines. Within a short span of time, the Institute has received TEQIP grants twice from MHRD, India and earned 25th all India Rank in India Today Survey 2016. The institute is also serving as a nodal agency for the matters of academic importance like, development of scheme of examination, syllabus, academic plan and maintenance of standards in affiliated Engineering colleges. It is also committed towards providing skills oriented training in various technologies like Artificial Intelligence (AI), Internet of Things (IoT), Blockchain, and Robotics etc.

The Siemens CoE, National Institute of Technology Kurukshetra, India enters into the following Agreement to offer Skill Development, Training and other related services to University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

1. Siemens CoE offers various skill development courses across different disciplines. University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra committed/commits to send 100 numbers of students/faculty every year for such courses. The timing/duration of the courses shall be arrived on mutually agreed dates. The CoE offers 20-40% discount on the regular advertised course fee depending on the demand. In case the number of students/faculty are less than the committed numbers on completion of a year, this may lead to reconsideration of discounts offered to the associated institute which is subjected to the review.
2. A student/faculty who has completed any CoE offered courses will be given 10 Hours of free Lab usage time after the course within one-year duration. The timing will be decided by the centre based on the availability.
3. Siemens CoE offers the resources for student projects on chargeable basis. It is the responsibility of the faculty mentor from University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra to monitor the progress. The CoE shall not offer any certification for such usage but shall provide an attendance certificate.
4. Siemens CoE offers Internships to students. The CoE can accommodate a reasonable number of students depending on the demand.
5. The faculty of University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra shall submit funding/consultancy proposals quoting the Siemens CoE resources. In such cases, a NIT KKR faculty will be the Co-PI and budgeting need to be arrived through mutual discussion before submission.
6. Siemens CoE periodically conducts workshops/symposiums/conferences etc.. For such events, any participant from University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra will get 25% discount on the Registration fee.
7. University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra shall organize events such as workshops/ symposiums/


- conferences jointly with SCoE. In such cases, the financial implications need to be discussed and to be approved by competent authorities before the event.
8. SCoE will not be responsible for safety of the students outside the NIT KKR premises. University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra should instruct their students clearly on the safety and precautionary measures.
 9. SCoE will not be responsible for loss/theft or damage of any of the student's belongings. University Institute of Engineering & Technology, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra should instruct their students clearly on the precautionary measures.
 10. The implementation of specific activities will be separately agreed between both institutions on need basis.
 11. Other terms and conditions which are not provided in this Agreement will be deliberated and agreed upon by the institutions hereto.
 12. This Agreement is established in English language and is valid from the date of signing by the representatives of the institutions. The institutions hereto have executed this Agreement in duplicate, and each institution shall keep one copy of the originals.
 13. This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any dispute arising under these terms and conditions shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of the courts of Kurukshetra.
 14. The two parties will consult each other and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that arise in the administration of this agreement informally.
 15. This agreement shall be valid for a period of three years from the date both signatures are affixed to this document or before if terminated by mutual agreement of both. This agreement may be terminated by either party after one hundred and twenty (120) days following receipt of a written notification of intent to terminate by the other party.
 16. If a proposal to renew this agreement is not presented before the end validity period, it will be terminated automatically at the end of three years.
 17. Any deviation from the clauses mentioned in the agreement without any written consent of The Head SCoE, the institute has the right to terminate the agreement without any prior notice.

NON-BINDING STATEMENT OF SHARED GOALS

This Non-Binding Statement of Shared Goals ("Agreement") is entered into as of the later signature date below and is by and between Microsoft Corporation (India) Pvt Ltd ("Microsoft") and Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra through University Institute of Engineering and Technology (UIET) ("Customer").


g. **Governing Law.** This Agreement shall be governed in all respects by the laws of India, without regard to its conflict of laws.

This Memorandum of Understanding ["MoU"] is entered into on the dd-mm-yyyy("Effective") by and between University Institute of Technology (UIT), Himachal Pradesh University (HPU), Summer Hill, Shimla-5 represented herein by Prof. P. L. Sharma, Director, HIT (in the presence of Prof. Sikander Kumar, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor) [hereinafter referred to as "UIT" or "First Party"] and University Institute of Engineering and Technology(UIET), Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana represented herein by Prof. C.C.Tripathi Director (in the presence of Prof. SomNathSachdeva, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra) having its office at Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana Pin-136119, India. [hereinafter referred to as " UIET,KUK " or "Second Party"].

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party').

WHEREAS, the UIT is a Premiere Engineering Institute in the state established in 2000 with single branch of Information and Technology in Himachal Pradesh University.Shimla and presently running five branches of engineering viz. Information Technology, Computer Science, Electronics and Communication, Electrical Engineering and Civil Engineering, having its office at Himachal Pradesh University, Summer Hill, Shimla-171005.

WHEREAS, University Institute of Engineering and Technology (UIET) which was established in 2004 in the campus of Kurukshetra University. It was established with a motive 'MIND TO MARKET' so as to achieve excellence in the key areas of engineering and to produce talented and committed human resources driven by the spirit of innovation and team work. Presently the institute imparts training in the four key branches of Engineering namely Computer Science Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Bio-Technology and Mechanical Engineering. We offer both graduate and post graduate degrees in these branches of Engineering to about 1600 talented students from all parts of India having top ranks in AIEEE. The Institute is accredited by AICTE and ranks third in state of Haryana according the perception of public and admission seekers having its office at University Institute of Engineering and Technology(UIET), Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana

The campus provides excellent infrastructure not only to hone the technical skills of the students but also provides ample space for leisure and extra-curricular activities..

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MoU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE I: MUTUAL COOPERATION

1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institutions and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

1.2 The First Party and the Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of intellectual capabilities of each other and thus providing significant inputs in designing the best training/research systems, keeping in mind the needs of the Academia/Industry with international standards.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

Both the parties under this MoU have agreed to collaborate with each other as below by providing students of UIT to become technology ready for the career and innovations

2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching/training methodology the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

2.3 **Workshops/Conferences/Trainings/Faculty Development Program:** Such activities will be organized on regular basis (in UIT, Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla or in UIET, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra). The host institution will contribute/ raise resources for the workshop. In case funds are available with UIT or UIET, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, then joint programs may also be conducted as per provisions allowed by the funding agency at the time of conducting programs.

2.4 **Placement of Students:** UIT and UIET, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra have also agreed to share the common placement opportunities during on campus placement drives by the host institutes for their mutual benefits.

2.5 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities for the students and faculty members as per following details:

- a) UIT and UIET, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra would support jointly-supervised students at the M.Tech/Ph.D. program in the area of common interests. These students can be supported through funding from outside agencies obtained through UIT and UIET, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. interdisciplinary topics, etc
- b) UIT and UIET, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra have also agreed to work in the area of providing access to digital resources/library/research labs for faculty and students who have registered for courses or engaged in joint research.

2.6 **Skill Development Programs:** Both parties have agreed to train the students on emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

2.7 **Expert Lectures:** Both parties also have agreed to provide experts lectures/guest lecturers to the students of UIT and UIET, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra based on in house requirements as per the rules and regulations of host institute.

2.8 Both parties have agreed to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the learning Environment/facilities on the terms specified herein.

2.9 There is no financial commitment on the part of the UIT, the First Party or UIET, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana the Second Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Each party shall continue to own the intellectual property developed prior to or independently of this Memorandum of Understanding. All rights, title and interests in and to the material used by Parties shall exclusively belong to respective Parties or its licensors. Any and all Intellectual Property Rights with respect to the Services and the Parties Proprietary Material and all modifications, improvements, enhancements, or derivative works made thereto, shall always belong to respective Parties or its licensors and First or Second Party shall not be entitled to claim any rights therein.

PRECLUDED FROM:

The parties agree that they are not bound exclusively by this memorandum and will be at liberty to enter into any other agreements or arrangements with any third party without reference to the other party in this MoU on the similar program(s).

CLAUSE 4: CONFIDENTIALITY

During the term of this MoU, each Party may disclose to the other its Confidential Information. Confidential Information shall mean all information marked "Confidential" or under any similar legend indicating the confidentiality of the information or information which by its nature is confidential, except such information as is

- a) Previously known to the receiving party at the time of disclosure.
- b) Independently developed by or for the receiving party and not derived from the Confidential Information supplied by the disclosing party or the participation of individuals who have had access to Confidential Information of the other.
- c) Disclosed to the receiving party by a third party without an obligation of confidentiality.
- d) In or subsequently comes into the public domain [other than as a result of a breach of this MoU.
- e) Required to be disclosed by the receiving party by law. Regulation, court order or other legal process.

The receiving party shall hold such Confidential Information in strict confidence perpetually for the disclosing party and shall not use it except in furtherance of the relationship set forth in this MoU, or except as it may be authorized by the disclosing party in writing. The receiving party shall further be responsible for the compliance of the foregoing by its employees or agents. Upon the disclosing party's written request at any time, or following the completion or termination of this MoU. The receiving party shall promptly return to the disclosing party, or destroy, all Confidential Information of the disclosing party provided under or in connection with this Agreement including all copies, portions and summaries thereof.

CLAUSE 5: COSTS

This MOU does not constitute any component of financial obligation on UIT and UIET, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

CLAUSE 6: VALIDITY

- 6.1 This Agreement will be valid initially for a period of 3 years and can be continued further with the consent of both the parties.
- 6.2 Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their relating obligations. On termination, each party shall return to the other party all such confidential and proprietary information, documents and reference material of the other party in its possession. All such obligations and terms of this MOU that are required to survive the termination of this MOU shall survive such termination.

CLAUSE 7: RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES

It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent entities, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

CLAUSE 8: LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Neither party shall be liable for any indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages, or damages for loss of profits, revenue, data or use, incurred by either party or any third party in connection with this MoU or the subject matter of this MoU, whether in an action in contract or tort or any other legal theory, even if the party has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

CLAUSE 9: GOVERNING LAW/ARBITRATION/VENUE

The laws of India shall govern this MoU. Any disputes between the parties shall be resolved by mutual discussions. Unresolved disputes, if any shall be subject to resolution by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended from time to time). The language of the arbitration shall be English and the decision of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the parties. The venue of Arbitration shall be Shimla/Kurukshetra. Both parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts in Shimla, for any action or proceeding regarding this MoU.







MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) **Between**

Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra
and
Stree Shakti – The Parallel Force

The MOU is made on the Sept. 14, 2021 day of August month in the year 2021, at Kurukshetra, Haryana, between Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra (hereinafter referred as "**University**") through Director, Women's Studies Research Centre (WSRC), Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and include his/her successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the **First Party**.

AND

Stree Shakti – The Parallel Force, Daryaganj, New Delhi registered in 2003 as a society with a mandate to work for women empowerment through its Founder, and include his/her successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the **Second Party**.

This MOU defines and details the general framework of the collaboration as under:

1. General Provisions

1.1 Definitions

- (a) "**University**" means Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana.
- (b) "**WSRC**" means Women's Studies Research Centre.
- (c) "**Programme**" means the workshops, conferences, training, awareness and other activities performed by the WSRC.

1.2 Relation between the Parties

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as establishing the relation of purchaser and seller as between the first and second party. The second party, subject to this MOU, shall have complete charge of personnel implementing the programme and shall be fully responsible for the task completed by them.

1.3 Governing Law & Jurisdiction

This MOU, its meaning and interpretation, and the relation between the parties shall be governed by the laws applicable in India and they only shall have exclusive Jurisdiction over matters relating to or arising from this MOU.

1.4 Language

This MOU has been executed in English language, which shall be the binding and controlling language for all matters relating to the meaning of interpretation of this MOU.

1.5 Location

The matter i.e. Programme implementation arising under this MOU shall be performed by the second party from its head offices at Delhi and/or its nearest regional office, in addition to the Centre at the University as agreed upon by the first party.

1.6 Authorized Representatives

Any action required to facilitate the development, discussion, implementation, and evaluation of activities under this MOU may be taken or executed

- (a) On behalf of the first party, by the Director, WSRC, K.U. Kurukshetra, or his/her designated representative.
- (b) On behalf of the second party, by the Founder, Stree Shakti – The Parallel Force, or his/her designated representative.

2. Commencement, Completion, Modification and Termination of this MOU

- 2.1 This MOU shall come into force from the date of signing.
- 2.2 Both the parties may at any time review this MOU and the actions taken under it, and by mutual MOU, make any necessary modifications.
- 2.3 The MOU shall be effective for a period of five years, but WSRC will review/renew/modify (if needed) the MOU annually, based on the programme outputs/outcomes.
- 2.4 The MOU may be terminated prematurely by either party with mutual agreement by giving one month's notice.

3. Role & Obligation of the Second Party "Stree Shakti – The Parallel Force" under the collaboration:

- 1. Joint Symposium, Workshop, Conferences, Training and Awareness Programs at National and International level.
- 2. Customized training programs designed for teaching faculty, non teaching staff, students of the university and colleges affiliated to Kurukshetra University, different stake holders and grass root functionaries.
- 3. Short-term visiting faculty program.
- 4. Joint Research and Development Programs and Publication Activities.
- 5. Value added courses for the female students of the university.



6. Internship and Training.
7. Other programs of mutual interest.

4. Role & Obligation of the First Party "WSRC" under the Collaboration

- 4.1 The University shall provide necessary infrastructure for the implementation of various activities under the Programme.
- 4.2 The University shall nominate a single point of contact to facilitate and troubleshoot the programme at the University.
- 4.3 The University shall ensure full support and cooperation to Stree Shakti – The Parallel Force in all aspects of the programme implementation.
- 4.4 There with no financial liability on the part of the Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, for implementation of the programmes.

5. Arbitration

Both the parties shall use all reasonable endeavors to resolve or settle the disputes through mutual negotiation and discussions in connection with this MOU or the interpretation thereof. Any and all disputes, controversies and conflicts ("**Disputes**") arising out of this MOU between the parties or arising out of or relating to or in connection with this MOU or the performance or non-performance of the rights and obligations set forth herein or the breach, termination, invalidity or interpretation thereof which cannot be settled or resolved amicably shall be referred for arbitration to a committee constituted at Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. The arbitral award shall be in writing and shall be final and binding on each party and shall be enforceable in the courts of Kurukshetra or courts having jurisdiction in Kurukshetra. None of the parties shall be entitled to commence or maintain any action in a court of law upon any Dispute arising out of or relating to or in connection with this MOU.


