REPORT OF PULSE POLIO CAMPAIGN DATED- 27th Feb. to 1st March, 2022

Students of Department of social work, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra participated in Pulse Polio campaign organized by LOKNAYAK JAYPARKASH HOSPITAL, District Kurukshetra. In this campaign students played different types of roles and performed number of duties in field assigned by LNJP staff. During this campaign students visited homes, shop, railway station, bus stand, Bahram Sarovar and open area as per on orders of hospital staff. Students made the people aware about the importance of immunization and also ensured that each and every child below 5 years age get polio drops. On second and third day the students also did home visit to cover left out children below 5 years of age.

Students got field work exposure with organized agency (hospital staff) during polio campaign. And they learned to interact with community effectively, execution, organization etc. With this they also developed their speaking skills, introductory skills, observation skills and expression of attitude etc. While providing service to community people, students played role of motivator, informator, facilitator etc. to influence community people to get service. More than 50 students of department of social work participated in the programme. The teaching faculty of the department also visited the booths time to time on all the three days to guide the students.
