Amendment/addition to Statutes 8 and 12 appearing in K.U. Act & Statutes, 1986 at pages 29-33 and 37-41 as approved by the Executive Council vide its Resolution No.47 of 29.3.2011 and assented to by the Hon’ble Chancellor on 22.6.2011.

8.(1) The Court shall consist of the following members, namely:-	NO CHANGE

(iv) one principal from the colleges of education admitted to the privileges of the University, on the basis of seniority, by rotation;	
(v) one principal to be elected from amongst themselves by the principals holding their posts in a substantive capacity in colleges, other than colleges of education, included in each of the four zones to be demarcated by the Vice-Chancellor;	(iv) (a) one principal and three teachers to be elected from amongst themselves by the principals and teachers respectively, holding their posts in a substantive capacity in Government Colleges of Arts, Science/Commerce, included in each of the two zones to be demarcated by the Vice-Chancellor.
(vi) four teachers other than principals to be elected from amongst themselves by the teachers holding their posts in a substantive capacity in colleges (except the colleges maintained by the University) included in each of the four zones to be demarcated by the Vice-Chancellor.	(b) one principal and three teachers to be elected from amongst themselves by the principals and teachers respectively, holding their posts in a substantive capacity in Non-govt. colleges of Arts, Science/Commerce, included in each of the four zones to be demarcated by the Vice-Chancellor.
Provided that not more than one teacher under this sub-clause shall belong to any one college.	(c) one principal and three teachers to be elected from amongst themselves by the principals and teachers respectively, holding their posts in a substantive capacity in Colleges/ Institutes of Education.
	(d) one principal and three teachers to be elected from amongst themselves by the principals and teachers respectively, holding their posts in a substantive capacity in other

professional colleges.

Provided that not more than one teacher elected from a zone shall belong to any one college, and out of the three elected teachers from a zone at least one shall be a woman.

(vii) Secretary, Kurukshetra University Students' Union and two Secretaries to be elected from amongst themselves by secretaries of the Students' Union in Colleges for the period from the date of election till 31st May of the academic year;

(viii) & (ix) xxx xxx

(x) two persons elected from amongst themselves by the representatives of the managements of non-government colleges. The representatives of the managements shall be from amongst the members of the concerned managements.

NO CHANGE except that these will be re-numbered as (v), (vi) and (vii) respectively.

(viii) four persons elected from amongst themselves by the representatives of the managements of colleges, as mentioned below:

(a) two persons elected from managements of Non-professional colleges, i.e. Arts, Science/Commerce colleges;

(b) two persons from managements of professional colleges.

Academic Council and its Constitution

12.(I) The Academic Council shall consist of the following persons, namely—

(iv)(a) one principal and three teachers to be elected from amongst themselves by the principals and teachers respectively, holding their posts in a substantive capacity in Government Colleges of Arts, Science/Commerce, included in each of the two zones to be demarcated by the Vice-Chancellor.

(b) one principal and three teachers to be elected from amongst themselves by the principals and teachers respectively, holding their posts in a substantive capacity in

(c) Non-Government Colleges, other than the Colleges of Education, in each of the following four zones to be demarcated by the Vice-Chancellor.
 Provided that not more than one teacher elected under this clause shall belong to any one college.

Non-govt. colleges of Arts, Science/Commerce, included in each of the four zones to be demarcated by the Vice-Chancellor.

(c) one principal and three teachers to be elected from amongst themselves by the principals and teachers respectively, holding their posts in a substantive capacity in Colleges/Institutes of Education.

(d) one principal and three teachers to be elected from amongst themselves by the principals and teachers respectively, holding their posts in a substantive capacity in other professional colleges.

Provided that not more than one teacher elected from a zone shall belong to any one college, and out of the three elected teachers from a zone at least one shall be a woman.
