



1. Credits (C), Core Courses (CC); Discipline Specific Elective Courses (DSE); General Elective Courses (GE); Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC).
2. Major, Minor, Generic Elective subjects and DSE options will be offered depending upon the availability of faculty/infrastructure /timetable of the Institute/College.
3. At least one of the subjects opted at level 5 and level 6 should be language UG with major subjects in Arts
4. Students can opt exit after completing internship after 2nd semester and earn a Certificate. Continuing students can do internship after 4th semester.
5. Students can opt for one course from other programmes as General Elective @ 6 credits in IIIrd, IVth, Vth and VIth semesters subject to the eligibility, availability of seats and class timings not overlapping.
6. If Honors courses, CC- 1H1 and CC-1H2 are honors courses to be taken if students opt for Honors course in third year and will have to be taken compulsorily by the students opting for 4th year of the programme (Honors and Research) if these courses are not completed earlier at level 7.
7. All the field work, Internship, dissertation/thesis will be effected through guided learning by allotting a teacher as guide to every student.
8. Each candidate shall be examined in the courses through a system of Comprehensive Continuous Assessment using a mix of Internal and End term evaluation. The Internal Assessment and End term evaluation for different courses of programme shall carry weightage of 50% each. Internal assessment (50%) shall be based on clearly defined components of class attendance and participation (10%), mid term exam of 2 hour duration (30%) and assignments-presentations (10%) of the credit and the rest (50 %) through End term Examination.
9. Evaluation rubrics shall be followed as per Annexure -1
10. Hobby/activity courses are audit courses and shall be evaluated by the instructor as prescribed in syllabi. The grades will be as Completed/Non-completed. These grade will not contribute to the calculations of SGPA/CGPA.
11. The code of the courses shall be identifiable with following format:
B - ENG - N101 B- HIN - N101 and so on (prefix N before number to distinguish from earlier codes).



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WHEREAS

The parties wish to establish a friendly relationship to promote and accelerate the academic cooperation and have decided to enter into this MoU and agree hereby as per articles given below:

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS**1.1 DEFINITIONS**

- (a) "KUK" means Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.
- (b) "CDLU" means Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Sirsa.
- (c) "DOP-KUK" means Department of Physics, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.
- (d) "DOP-CDLU" means Department of Physics-Chaudhary Devi Lal University, Sirsa.

1.2 RELATION BETWEEN THE PARTIES AND SCOPE

- a. Both the parties will recognize each other as an Institute for research in the disciplines of Physics.
- b. Research instrumentation and library facilities available with DOP-KUK and DOP-CDLU will be made available free of cost on mutual basis to the faculty and research scholars of both the departments.
- c. There shall be an exchange of research students and faculty for research and academic purposes. Accommodation in the hostel/guesthouse shall be arranged, wherever possible, as per extant rates.
- d. DOP-KUK and DOP-CDLU shall subscribe to the principle of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, caste or religion. Both the Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement and shall not impose criteria for exchange of scholars or students, which violate principles of non-discrimination.
- e. Both parties understand that all financial agreements will have to be negotiated separately and will depend on the availability of funds.
- f. In case of joint research authorship of publication arising out of such research work shall be shared depending on the extent of contribution by the authors, by mutual consent along with credit to authors.

1.3. GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION

This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any dispute arising under these terms and conditions shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of the courts of Kurukshetra (Haryana).

1.4 LANGUAGE

This MoU has been executed in English language, which shall be the binding and controlling language for all matters relating to the meaning of interpretation of this MoU.

1.5 LOCATION

Research implementation arising under this MoU shall be performed by both the parties from their head offices.

1.6 AUTHORISED REPRESENTATIVES

Any action required or permitted to be taken and any document required or permitted to be executed under this MoU may be taken or executed.

(a) On behalf of the first party, by the Registrar/competent authority, KUK.

(b) On behalf of the second party, by the Registrar/competent authority, CDLU, Sirsa.

2. COMMENCEMENT, COMPLETION, MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION OF THIS MoU

2.1 This MoU shall come into force from the date of signing.

2.2 The MoU shall be effective for a period of five years, but will be reviewed/renewed/modified (if needed) mutually by both the parties, based on the research outputs/outcomes.

2.3 This MoU may be modified /amended by mutual written agreement at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party.

2.4 The modification/changes shall become part of the MoU and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

2.5 The MoU may be terminated prematurely by either party with mutual agreement by giving prior notice. Such notification must be given to the other party at least three months in advance from the effective date of termination.

2.6 All joint activities not completed at the expiration of termination of the MoU may be continued until their completion under the terms of this MoU.

3. MANAGEMENT

The Chairperson, DOP-KUK and Chairperson, DOP-CDLU, Sirsa will be responsible to work out operational details of co-operation between the two departments and ensure proper and effective implementation of this MoU.

4. RESEARCH COLLABORATION

DOP-KUK and DOP-CDLU will work on mutually agreed collaborative research projects funded by one or both parties and/or by a third party in areas of mutual interest. Each research collaboration will require the approval of competent authorities of both the parties.

5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

5.1 DOP-KUK and DOP-CDLU will be expected to ensure protection of the intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) generated during the student's research work. KUK and CDLU shall be the joint

applicants for IPRs and the students and involved faculty members shall be included as the inventor/breeder/author. Finances involved for all types of IPR filing, publishing, grant, maintenance etc. shall be equally shared by KUK/CDLU.

5.2 Each party will ensure appropriate protection of IPRs generated from co-operation pursuant to this MoU. IPRs, research publications and benefits arising out of collaborative research under these agreements shall be jointly sought/owned/shared by KUK and CDLU on case to case basis as per extant rules.

5.3 In case of evaluation of already developed technology/product, IPRs shall rest with the providing party of the particular product/technology. The parties shall not assign any rights and obligations arising out of the IPRs generated to inventions/activities carried out under the MoU to any third party without the consent of the other party.

6. CONSEQUENCE OF BREACH AND PENALTIES

6.1 It shall be obligatory on part of either party to ensure timely research implementation and facilitation as per the pre-approved work plan as agreed upon in the MoU.


6.2 In the event of breach of any term or conditions of this agreement, either party shall have the right to terminate the agreement and recover costs incurred that are associated with the project.



RIO with the remarks that on an another application of Ms. Manjeet Kaur dated 19.07.2021 (Copy enclosed) for the same subject, the Registration Branch has clarified that as per concerned class ordinance (Clause 9.3) for MFA she is not eligible for getting admission in MFA 2nd year.

The concerned Clause 9.3 is being reproduced as under:-

"A candidate who fails to pass all the four semester examinations within four years of his/her admission to an MFA course shall be deemed to be unfit for this Programme.

The bar shall not apply to a candidate appearing to avail the extra chance in the Fourth Semester Examination, provided the extra chance is availed next to the last admissible normal chance under Clause 8 above."

As per clause, a candidate who fails to pass all the four semester examinations within four years of his/her admission to an MFA course shall be deemed to be unfit for this Programme. But, in the case of Ms. Manjeet Kaur,

she had to discontinue her studies after getting admission in MFA 2nd Year (3rd Semester) in the academic session 2018-19 for some medical reasons as she mentioned in her application at prepage.

In view of above, it is recommended that Ms. Manjeet Kaur may be allowed to complete her course (MFA 2nd Year) in the academic session 2021-22.

The Committee was apprised that Ms. Manjeet Kaur got admission in MFA for the session 2017-18 and complete Ist and IInd semester examinations successful. after getting admission in MFA 3rd semester she had discontinued her studies in the academic session 2018-19 for some medical reasons as she was in family way copy of medical certificate attached annexure -I.

The Committee perused the concerned class ordinance for MFA course mentioned in University calendar Volume -II at page No. 390 (Clause 9.3) reproduced below:-


9.3 A candidate who fails to pass all the four semester examination within four years of his/her admission to an MFA course shall be deemed to be unfit for this Programme.

Hence, as per the ordinance she is not eligible to seek admission in MFA 3rd semester as the duration of the course has been exhausted.


The Committee also perused the clause of No. 10 mentioned page No. 24 in University Calendar 2009 Volume -I amended vide EC Resolution No. 7 (3) dated 13.2.2019 reproduced below:


10. "Unless otherwise specifically provided in the concerned Ordinance, a woman student may be granted 45 days maternity leave by the Chairperson/Director/Principal of the Department/Institute/College concerned on the recommendation of Government Hospital Authorities as applicable as per prescribed rules in the case of Government Women Employees with the condition that the concerned student will have to attend the extra classes as per the requirement of attendance of the specified course/ professional/research program." annexure -II.

After considering all the facts and due deliberations, taking a lenient view in the academic interest of the student the Committee recommends that Ms. Manjeet Kaur may be allowed to take admission in MFA 3rd semester to complete her degree as a special case for 2021-22, failing which her admission shall stand cancelled ab-initio, in anticipation approval of Academic Council.

Amendment/addition in the above Ordinance appearing at pages 22-25 of K.U. Cal. Vol.I, 2009, approved vide Executive Council Resolution No.7(3) of 13.02.2019:

EXISTING

9. In the case of a candidate for any Competitive Examination, conducted by the Government for Public Services, the days spent in the examination (i.e., from the first to last paper of the candidate concerned and in travelling connected herewith) shall be counted, on production of satisfactory evidence as attendance at lectures delivered to his class during the aforesaid period, subject to a maximum of ten days in an Academic year.






After detailed deliberations the committee unanimously recommends as under: -
