These hostels have a capacity to accommodate 2764 boys and 3290 girls respectively. All the machines are modern and students can join the gym to keep themselves physically active.</p> <p><b>Library</b> KUK library is well established, located at a central place in the middle of various departments and maintained with a vast collection of books, journals, and international journals. The best place for students who love to read and to find answers to all the academic questions. The library has various sections such as registration, periodical, internet services, technical, reference and offers open access to its books and periodical collections.</p> <p><b>Sports</b> The university offers various sports facilities to its students so that they can have a healthy and fit lifestyle. KUK has two multipurpose halls. The new one is equipped with workout machines, gymnastic</p>

equipment and mats of Judo, wrestling etc. The university has various courts for sports such as basketball, volleyball, tennis etc.

#### Cafeteria

A cafeteria is a place where students can go and take a break from their day-to-day chaos. Healthy and delicious meals are provided at a nominal price at the university cafeteria to students, faculty and staff members.

#### Auditorium

An auditorium is a venue for all the cultural events of the university. The auditorium has modern audio and visual technology, accomodating a good amount of people at a time.

#### Medical/Hospital

The university has a health centre that takes care of all the medical needs of the students, staff and their family members. All the medical facilities are provided such as computerised ECG, X-Ray, ambulance facility. The university has 65+ doctors on its panel to offers free consultation services.

The IT infrastructure of the university is well-maintained with computers in all departments. The computers are installed with the latest software and are connected to high-speed internet.

## Games and sports facilities

The University Sports Department is a full- fledged Department with one Director, Physical Education & Sports. Two Assistant Directors (Male & Female), 4 University Coaches and enthusiastic team of 30 members of the non-teaching staff. Affairs of Kurukshetra University sports come under the auspices of Kurukshetra University Sports Council, where Principals and Lecturer Physical Education of all the affiliated Colleges are its member. Due representation is given to Coaches in the body. The Executive Board of Kurukshetra University Sports Council headed by President, Kurukshetra University Sports Council, manages routine affairs.
