

ADMISSION CRITERIA

1. Admission Criteria for M.Tech. in: (i) Bio Tech.; (ii) Computer Engg.; (iii) Computer Science and Engg.; (iv) Electronics & Communication Engg.; (v) Mechanical Engg. (Industrial & Production); (vi) Mechanical Engg. (Thermal); (vii) Defence Technology; (viii) Electrical Engg.; (ix) Electrical & Instrumentation Engg.; (x) Energy and Environmental Management; (xi) Microelectronics & VLSI Design:

(i) Candidates whose result of final semester/year is awaited can also apply. Such candidates have to upload the DMCs of all the semesters i.e. 1st to penultimate semester.

(ii) The criteria to make the merits will be as under:

(a) First preference will be given to the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination and have valid GATE score. Admissions of such candidates will be made on the basis of GATE score. No other weightage will be given for preparing the admission list.

(b) If seats remain vacant then admission will be offered to such candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations. Admissions of such candidates will be made on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying Exam. No other weightage will be given for preparing the admission list.

(c) If seats still remain vacant then admission will be offered to the candidate whose result of final semester is awaited and have valid GATE score. Admission will be made on the basis of GATE score. No other weightage will be given for preparing the admission list.

(d) If seats still remain vacant then admission will be offered to the candidates whose result of final semester is awaited. Admission will be made on the basis of total marks obtained from first semester to penultimate semester. No other weightage will be given for preparing the admission list.

For (a), (b), (c) and (d) above, admissions will be made online on the basis of information furnished by the candidate (i.e. candidate will not be asked to report in the department physically).

If seats still remain vacant, then Chairperson/Director of the concerned department may be allowed to give the admissions upto 15/09/2023 if contacted by any willing eligible candidate on first come first serve basis.

2. Admission Criteria for P.G. Diploma in: (i) Archaeology (Morning); (ii) Buddhist Studies (Morning); (iii) Floriculture (Morning); (iv) Knowledge Traditions in Sanskrit & Indology; (v) Yoga (Morning)

(i) All the candidates who have applied for the program till extended last date may be asked to report in the Department physically and admission will be made using counseling on that day and from the waiting list drawn on the day of physical attendance.

(ii) Candidates, whose result of final semester/year is awaited can also apply. Such candidates have to upload the DMCs of all the semesters i.e. 1st to penultimate semester.

(iii) The criteria to make the merits will be as under:

- (a) First preference will be given to the candidates who have passed the qualifying examination. Admissions of such candidates will be made on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying Exam. No other weightage will be given for preparing the admission list.
- (b) If seats remain vacant, then admission will be offered to the candidates whose result of final semester is awaited. Admission will be made on the basis of total marks obtained from first semester to penultimate semester. No other weightage will be given for preparing the admission list.

3. **Admission Criteria for:** (i) M.A. A.I.H. Culture & Archaeology; (ii) M.A.(Business Economics); (iii) M.A.(Education); (iv) M.A.(Womens Studies); (v) M.Ed. Special Education (Visual Impairment); (vi) M.Lib. & Inf. Sc.; (vii) M.Sc. (Mass Communication); (viii) M.Sc. (Printing, Graphics & Packaging Technology); (ix) M.Sc. (Tech.) Applied Geophysics; (x) M.Sc. Electronic Science; (xi) Master of Hotel Management and Catering Technology (MHM&CT):

All the candidates who have applied for the abovementioned programs (i.e. appeared in the entrance test as well as who have not appeared in the entrance test) may be asked to report in the Department physically and admission will be made using counselling.

- (a) First preference will be given to the candidates who have appeared in the entrance test. Admissions of such candidates will be made on the basis of entrance test score. No other weightage will be given for preparing the admission list.
- (b) If seats still remain vacant then admission will be offered to the candidates who have not appeared in the entrance test (i.e. but have applied by 25/06/2023) and admission will be made first on the basis of marks obtained in qualified examination and second on the basis of total marks obtained from first semester to penultimate semester. No other weightage will be given for preparing the admission list.
- (c) If seats still remain vacant then admission will be offered to the candidates who have applied after 25/06/2023 and admission will be made first on the basis of marks obtained in qualified examination and second on the basis of total marks obtained from first semester to penultimate semester. No other weightage will be given for preparing the admission list
