

**“A candidate, who fails in a Semester examination shall be exempted from re-appearing in the paper(s) in which he/she may have obtained at least 45% marks. Such a candidate shall be allowed to appear, for passing in the remaining paper(s), only at the next four respective semester examinations held in immediate succession to the examination in which he/she appeared and failed, or having been eligible, did not appear. Provided that a candidate for the LL.B. Degree must pass all the Semester examinations, i.e. Semester I, II, III, IV, V and VI within five years of his/her admission to the LL.B. I Semester class, failing which he/she will be deemed to be unfit for the course and shall not be allowed to appear in the same either by attending classes again as a regular student or as ex-student unless he/she has been otherwise allowed by the Academic Council of the University.”**

As per above clause the duration of the course of above said student has already been exhausted. Further department is not running evening session presently.

Considering the above and after due deliberations, the Committee noted that Mr. Ram Kumar Singh, student of LL.B. 3 year Course (Evening) for the session 2014-15 appeared in 1 to 5<sup>th</sup> semester Examinations of LLB 3year course and required to appear in 6<sup>th</sup> semester examination of LL.B. to complete his degree. In the pretext of recommendations of the earlier Committee and facts, the request of the candidate to continue his study, the Committee recommends that permission may be given in his academic interest to Sh. Ram Kumar Singh to attend LLB 6<sup>th</sup> semester 2023-24 as a regular students with an additional fee of Rs. 50,000/- *plus* admission fee for 6<sup>th</sup> semester as specified by the Fee Section, subject to approval of Academic Council to full fill the following conditions:

1. NOC and study leave may be obtained from the department concerned where he is presently posted before the admission in 6<sup>th</sup> semester.
2. During the 6<sup>th</sup> semester he will attend the Classes as a regular student.

The B.A. English (General) is already equivalent to B.A. English (Elective), therefore, the Equivalence Committee recommends that B.A. English (Additional) is equivalent to B.A. English (General)/B.A. English (Elective).

As the meeting of the Academic Council was not going to be held shortly, and the above recommendations of the Equivalence Committee dated 14.07.2023 to be effective, hence the Vice-Chancellor has taken the action.
