Meeting of the Academic Council was not going to be held in near future, therefore, the Vice-Chancellor has approved the minutes dated 11.05.2024 of the NEP Core Committee and the Deans’ Committee in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council.

44. STATEMENT OF THE CASE

As per clause 7.2 of the Ordinance for B.Ed (2 years) Examination appearing at page 183 of Ordinance- Bachelor of Education Examination (2 years Programme through Distance Education), a candidate who fails to pass B.Ed examination within a period of five years of his/her admission to the course shall be required to repeat the course de novo if he/she desires to pass the course after the time limit. In the instant case Mr. Ram Kumar took admission in B.Ed-Ist during the session 2011-12 and was required to complete the course upto 2016 but could not complete the course within stipulated period. He has passed the B.Ed-Ist year and took admission in B.Ed-IIInd year but he remains absent in Health and Physical Education, School Education Programme and Community Based Project and Work Experience during the session July 2012-2013. Due to the reason non receipt of Internal assessment awards Health and Physical Education, School Education Programme and Community Based Project and Work Experience his result was declared RLA by Examination Branch. Now he has requested to allow him to submit the assignments of above said subjects. The Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council allowed to him to submit the assignments in the CDOE as a special case with extra fee of Rs.15000/-.

The said candidate has deposited the fee of Rs 15000/- vide Bank Scroll No. 1 dated 7.3.2024 and he has submitted the assignments. The result of the candidate of B.Ed-IIInd year has been declared by the examination branch and the Detail Marks Card received by the Candidate from CDOE.
