WHEREAS, in order to support the Government of India (GoI) in its efforts to address the food security and nutrition needs of the population, WFP has signed an MoU with the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare for the current CSP (2019-2023) for supporting the government's efforts towards achievement of sustainable development goal 2 by providing technical assistance and transfer and exchange of knowledge, skills and expertise to concretely

strengthen the existing systems. The dialogue on the new CSP (2023-27) is currently underway extending the mandate to work on these aspects over the next 5 years, the MoU for which will be signed in early 2023.

Whereas aligned with the Partnership MoU with GoI, recognizing the potential areas for knowledge collaboration with Kurukshetra University (KU), a detailed proposal indicating potential areas, especially related to nutrition, climate change and gender equity and empowerment was shared with Kurukshetra University.

Whereas the Kurukshetra University (KU) established in 1956 is an A+ grade NAAC accredited university focused on preparing a class of proficient scholars and professionals with ingrained human values and commitment to expand the frontiers of knowledge for the advancement of society.

Whereas, World Food Programme (WFP), an autonomous joint subsidiary programme of the United Nations and the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, with headquarters in Rome, Italy, acting through its country office in INDIA.

Whereas, through its Country Strategic Plan (CSP), WFP seeks to support the government of India in achieving its targets under Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) 2 and 17 by capitalizing on its investments under four sub-targets of SDG 2:

- SDG 2.1: By 2030, end hunger and ensure access by all people, in particular the poor and people in vulnerable situations, including infants, to safe, nutritious and sufficient food all year round.
- SDG 2.2: By 2030, end all forms of malnutrition, including achieving, by 2025, the internationally agreed targets on stunting and wasting in children under 5 years of age, and address the nutritional needs of adolescent girls, pregnant and lactating women and older persons.
- SDG 2.3: By 2030, double the agricultural productivity and incomes of small-scale food producers, in particular women, indigenous peoples, family farmers, pastoralists and fishers, including through secure and equal access to land, other productive resources and inputs, knowledge, financial services, markets and opportunities for value addition and non-farm employment.
- SDG 2.4: By 2030, ensure sustainable food production systems and implement resilient agricultural practices that increase productivity and production, that help maintain ecosystems, that strengthen capacity for adaptation to climate change, extreme weather, drought, flooding and other disasters and that progressively improve land and soil quality.

Whereas, in order to support the Government of India in its efforts to address the food security and nutrition needs of the population, WFP has signed an MoU with the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer's Welfare for the current CSP (2019-2023) which also includes focusing on issues of gender, climate change and nutrition among others. The dialogue on the new CSP (2023-27) is currently underway extending the mandate to work on these aspects over the next 5 years, the MoU for which will be signed in early 2023. To take forward these commitments in this agreement and the forthcoming MoU, WFP and KU seek to work together on research, capacity

building and policy advocacy relating to **gender, climate change and nutrition** (the "Project").
The objectives of this project are as under:

- (i) To enhance gender equality and women empowerment through gender transformative approaches and gender mainstreaming around intra-household access to food, improved nutrition and social and financial inclusion;
- (ii) To work in the climate resilience, adaptation and resilience building to establish scalable models to ensure that farthest are reached first with sustainable and resilience strategies;
- (iii) To enhance the nutritional effectiveness of the Government's food-based safety nets (Targeted Public Distribution System, Mid-Day Meals and Integrated Child Development Services) by increasing knowledge of and demand for diverse, nutritious and fortified foods.

Whereas, WFP and KU seek to undertake a strategic knowledge collaboration to address the key challenges with respect to food and nutrition insecurity as scoped out in Annexure I.

Whereas, both WFP and KU recognize the importance and value of cooperating with each other and therefore desire to strengthen their relationship by entering into this Agreement with the purpose of providing a coherent, predictable and structured framework for collaboration to support the implementation of the Project.

Now therefore, it is agreed that parties shall engage in partnership and knowledge collaboration under this LoU and shall be guided as follows:

Article I

KU shall

- 1.1 Identify a Partnership Manager as well as focal points in the Women's Studies Research Centre, Department of Social Work, Home Science and Institute of Environmental Studies for regular dialogue, discussions and support to WFP. This Manager would be responsible supervision and coordination under this project and liaise with designated person/s from WFP.
- 1.2 Provide technical support on gender, climate change and nutrition in following areas:
 - Research
 - Community engagement
 - Training and capacity building
 - Oversight and monitoring
- 1.3 Support in broadening the implementation of activities across India through its network of partners in other states.
- 1.4 Support and guide any local partners hired by WFP to support implementation of project activities.

Article II

WFP shall

- 2.1 Identify overall Partnership Manager and designated contacts for the three areas of collaboration (gender, nutrition and climate).

- 2.2 Receive 2 interns per year from KU for their professional development.
- 2.3 Provide funds for key research and pilot activities, including consultations depending upon availability.
- 2.4 Consult with technical teams in KU for technical advice and support.
- 2.5 Prepare a Project Strategy and Implementation Plan for project implementation.
- 2.6 Undertake other activities as deemed necessary for smooth functioning of the project.

Article III

Together

- 3.1 WFP and KU will formulate a Steering Committee comprised of representatives from both the organizations that will meet quarterly (in person or virtually) to review the progress of implementation, etc.
- 3.2 KU and WFP shall jointly monitor progress of the project implementation and suggest solutions for addressing gaps.
- 3.3 KU and WFP shall jointly identify global/national best practices in supporting gender, climate change and nutrition
- 3.4 KU and WFP shall jointly document good practices/ success stories.
- 3.5 KU and WFP shall jointly issue and disseminate communications and advocacy related to the project such as press releases, publications, workshops etc.
- 3.6 Planning and organization of events for policy advocacy, including consultations or conferences.

Article IV

- 4.1 The obligations of WFP and KU under this LoU are subject to the constitutional, financial and budgetary rules of WFP and any decision of WFP/KU.
- 4.2 Both sides agree to treat confidentially any sensitive information exchanged in the course of implementation of this LoU. Should either side wish to disclose such information to third parties it shall seek prior written concurrence from the other side.

Article V

5.1 Any claims, controversies or disputes between the Parties arising under this Agreement or under any agreements and/or documents entered into in connection with this Agreement, shall be settled amicably through consultations or negotiations between the Parties to the Dispute and in accordance with Article VI (Settlement of Disputes) of the Basic Agreement between the Government of India and WFP.

Article VI

6.1 Nothing in this Letter of Understanding or any document entered into in relation to this Letter of Understanding will imply a waiver or be construed as waiver, express or implied, by WFP, the United Nations or the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) of any privileges or immunity enjoyed by them pursuant to the 1946 Convention on Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations, the 1947 Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of

Article VII

- 7.1 This LoU shall commence on the date the last of the Parties signs this LoU (the "Effective Date") and the total duration of the collaboration would be 31st December 2027
- 7.2 This LoU may be modified in writing by mutual consent between KU and WFP by exchange of letters.
- 7.3 This LoU shall enter into force upon signature by both KU and WFP.







Stree Shakti – The Parallel Force, Daryaganj, New Delhi registered in 2003 as a society with a mandate to work for women empowerment through its Founder, and include his/her successor in office, legal representative, nominee and assignee as the **Second Party**.

This MOU defines and details the general framework of the collaboration as under:

1. General Provisions

1.1 Definitions

- (a) "University" means Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, Haryana.
- (b) "WSRC" means Women's Studies Research Centre.
- (c) "Programme" means the workshops, conferences, training, awareness and other activities performed by the WSRC.

1.2 Relation between the Parties

Nothing contained herein shall be construed as establishing the relation of purchaser and seller as between the first and second party. The second party, subject to this MOU, shall have complete charge of personnel implementing the programme and shall be fully responsible for the task completed by them.

1.3 Governing Law & Jurisdiction

This MOU, its meaning and interpretation, and the relation between the parties shall be governed by the laws applicable in India and they only shall have exclusive Jurisdiction over matters relating to or arising from this MOU.

1.4 Language

This MOU has been executed in English language, which shall be the binding and controlling language for all matters relating to the meaning of interpretation of this MOU.

1.5 Location

The matter i.e. Programme implementation arising under this MOU shall be performed by the second party from its head offices at Delhi and/or its nearest regional office, in addition to the Centre at the University as agreed upon by the first party.

1.6 Authorized Representatives

Any action required to facilitate the development, discussion, implementation, and evaluation of activities under this MOU may be taken or executed

(a) On behalf of the first party, by the Director, WSRC, K.U. Kurukshetra, or his/her designated representative.

(b) On behalf of the second party, by the Founder, Stree Shakti – The Parallel Force, or his/her designated representative.

2. Commencement, Completion, Modification and Termination of this MOU

2.1 This MOU shall come into force from the date of signing.

2.2 Both the parties may at any time review this MOU and the actions taken under it, and by mutual MOU, make any necessary modifications.

2.3 The MOU shall be effective for a period of five years, but WSRC will review/renew/modify (if needed) the MOU annually, based on the programme outputs/outcomes.

2.4 The MOU may be terminated prematurely by either party with mutual agreement by giving one month's notice.

3. Role & Obligation of the Second Party "Stree Shakti – The Parallel Force" under the collaboration:

1. Joint Symposium, Workshop, Conferences, Training and Awareness Programs at National and International level.
2. Customized training programs designed for teaching faculty, non teaching staff, students of the university and colleges affiliated to Kurukshetra University, different stake holders and grass root functionaries.
3. Short-term visiting faculty program.
4. Joint Research and Development Programs and Publication Activities.
5. Value added courses for the female students of the university.

6. Internship and Training.
7. Other programs of mutual interest.

4. Role & Obligation of the First Party "WSRC" under the Collaboration

- 4.1 The University shall provide necessary infrastructure for the implementation of various activities under the Programme.
- 4.2 The University shall nominate a single point of contact to facilitate and troubleshoot the programme at the University.
- 4.3 The University shall ensure full support and cooperation to Stree Shakti – The Parallel Force in all aspects of the programme implementation.
- 4.4 There with no financial liability on the part of the Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra, for implementation of the programmes.


5. Arbitration

Both the parties shall use all reasonable endeavors to resolve or settle the disputes through mutual negotiation and discussions in connection with this MOU or the interpretation thereof. Any and all disputes, controversies and conflicts ("Disputes") arising out of this MOU between the parties or arising out of or relating to or in connection with this MOU or the performance or non-performance of the rights and obligations set forth herein or the breach, termination, invalidity or interpretation thereof which cannot be settled or resolve amicably shall be referred for arbitration to a committee constituted at Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. The arbitral award shall be in writing and shall be final and binding on each party and shall be enforceable in the courts of Kurukshetra or courts having jurisdiction in Kurukshetra. None of the parties shall be entitled to commence or maintain any action in a court of law upon any Dispute arising out of or relating to or in connection with this MOU.

INTRODUCTION

This memorandum of understanding (hereinafter referred to as MOU) is an agreement between the Shri Krishna AYUSH University (hereinafter referred to as SKAU) and the Kurukshetra University (hereinafter referred to as KU) to work together for furthering cooperation, education and research in the common interest of the two University. SKAU and KU have a general understanding that academic linkages and collaborations facilitate better understanding and cooperation.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this MOU is to establish a mutually beneficial relationship which will stimulate cooperation and strengthen research, teaching and outreach to promote development, broaden experiences and understanding among staff, faculty and students of both Universities.

AREAS OF COLLABORATION

The following broad areas of collaboration will be pursued for both Universities

- Exchange of academic staff and researchers
- Collaborative research projects and curriculum development
- Jointly organized conferences, seminars, academic interactive sessions and professional
- Development programmes
- Exchange of academic materials and published information
- Access of library and internet facilities
- Access of research laboratory facilities of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Bio-Chemistry, Zoology and Microbiology departments. The strength of incoming students for each research laboratories will be five in number at one time.

As discussions continue, both institutions shall prepare more detailed agreements to clarify perceived areas of ambiguities in respect to any specific project. This collaboration only serves as an indication of each University's desire to partner in joint academic and educational pursuits. Where possible, legally binding obligations may be negotiated and executed in future, by virtue of this memorandum.

OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES

The following shall constitute the basic ground rules for the implementation of the provisions of this memorandum of understanding between SKAU and KU.

- i. All exchange of Academic/Research and Professional staff must be approved by the host (receiving) institution in writing at least three months in advance. Written approvals will include the responsibilities of the exchange participants, the period of the exchange and any other conditions governing the terms of the exchange.
- ii. SKAU and KU will explore the possibility of joint seeking of funds and conduct of collaborative research, training and consultancy with industries/institutions in India/abroad.
- iii. SKAU and KU will consider favourably and encourage staff of their respective institution to work in each other laboratories on sabbatical/short term period. The period of stay and honorarium shall conform to the extant guidelines on the subject.

It is mutually agreed that program of this MOU will be monitored by a Review committee consisting of the Vice Chancellor, SKAU and Vice Chancellor KU or their nominees through periodic meetings.

VALIDITY

This MOU is valid for a period of 3 years commencing from, March 2020. Any mid-course change introduced/suggested by the Review committee and duly approved by the appropriate authorities shall also be deemed to be valid.
