



5. Refreshment @ Rs. 50 per head may be allowed (total budget of Rs. 25,000/- maximum).
6. Miscellaneous and contingencies expenses of Rs. 7000/- may be allowed.
7. Secretarial support of Rs. 500/- may be allowed.
8. A fee of Rs. 100/- for the purpose of Registration may be charged from the participants and deposited through online to the following bank account:



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Department of Social work, Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra organized Five Day Theatre Workshop (Skill Enhancement Through Experimental Learning) under the aegis of CENTRE FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION RASITRIYA UCHATAR SHIKSHA ABHIYAN (RUSA 2.0) from 9th to 14th December, 2022. It was a successful workshop, where the students of social work department interacted with six different resource persons from diverse backgrounds.

The glimpses of workshop are:

Workshop Day-1


The first day of the workshop was started with the formal introduction of five-day workshop by Mr. Krishan Kumar, Assistant professor, Department of Social Work. After this Prof. Vanita Dhingra, Chairperson, Department of Social Work introduced the resource person of the day Dr. Ajay Sharma to participants and welcomed everyone in the workshop.

Dr. Ajay Sharma is Professor at Institute of Textile and Sciences, Bhiwani. Dr. Ajay started his session by giving examples from society and told the participants about the forms of society and also showed the importance of communication for better understanding of each other. The resource person has named this workshop as 'A Personality Development Lab' i.e. Social Lab, which was used for skill development through experiential learning.

After this formal interaction, all the participants and the coordinating teachers were taken to the open space inside the university campus near the Department of Social Work, where the exact workshop activities were to be played.

These activities and games were for body warm-up, test of attention and presence of mind, test of concentration, handling multiple tasks simultaneously, teamwork, sense of independence, the importance of taking initiative and many more.

This first activity was meant to warm up the participants and orient them towards the workshop.


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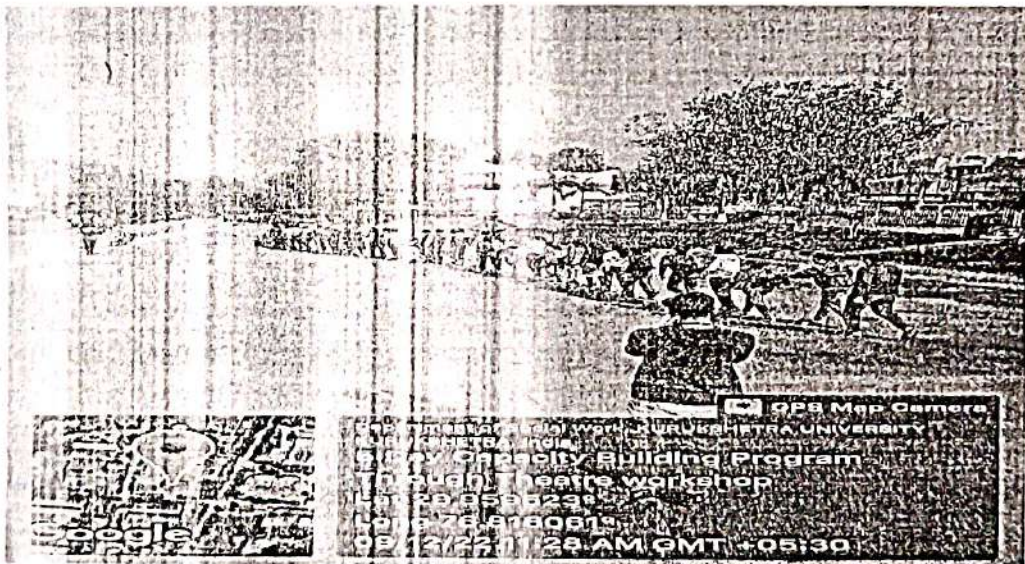

Other activities were Catch the Index Finger and Rail Games. These activities helped the participants to understand the importance of multiple tasking and the importance of each member in group tasks.

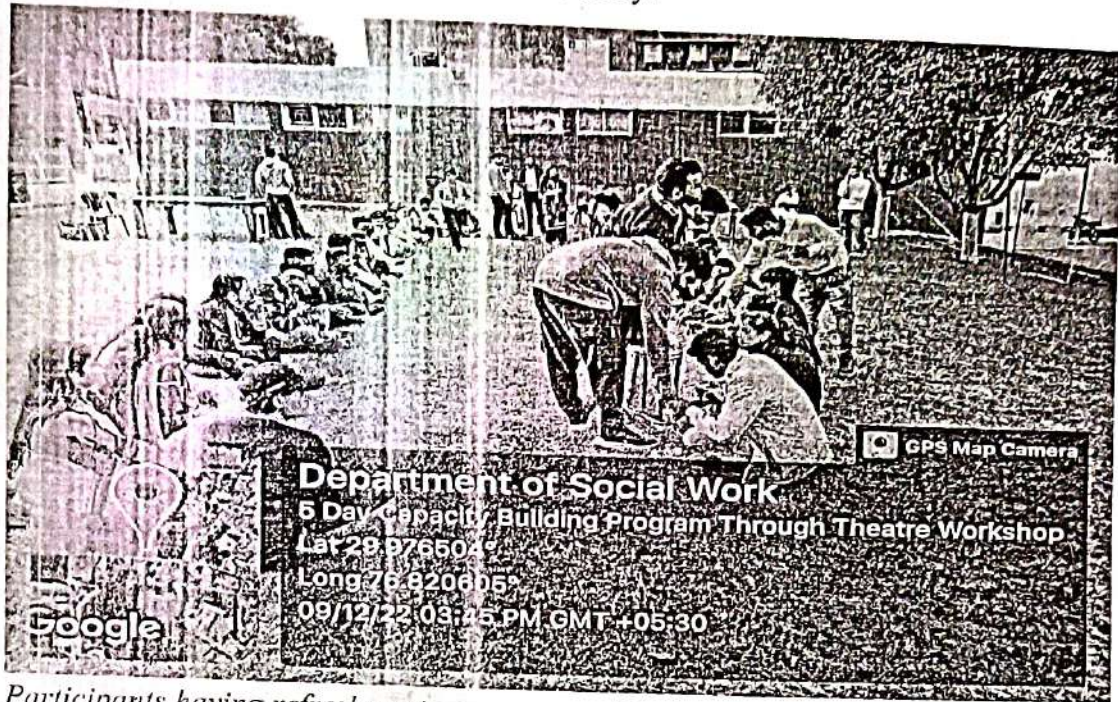


Participants during Trail Game

Other activities were Bird Fly, Puzzle Solving and Believe in Team or Not. These activities were to make participants feel free, to check shyness among the participants and to increase the activeness of the participants. It was also to take initiative and develop trust in the team.

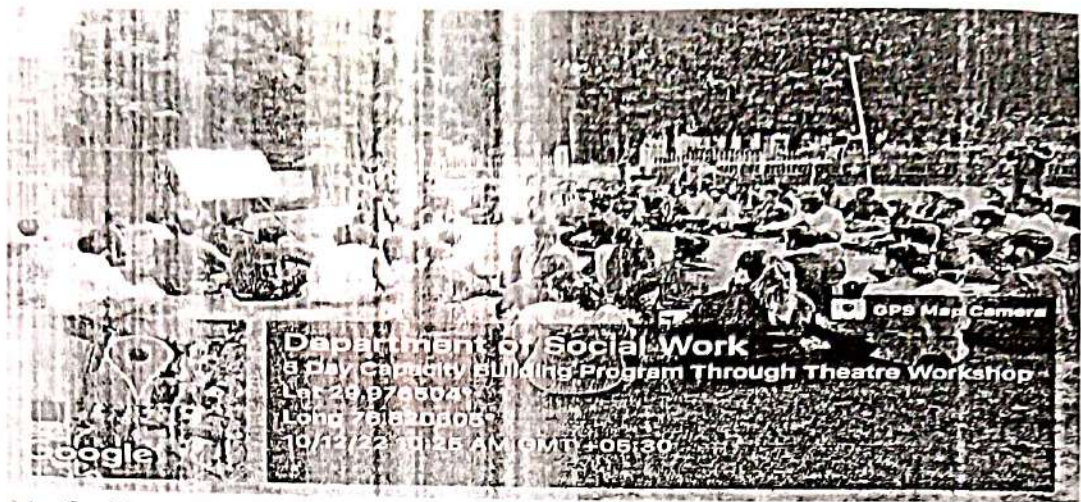
Workshop Day- 2

The second day of the workshop was started with the spiritual knowledge of Bhagavad-Gita and Ramayana imparted by Dr. Ajay Sharma to the participants. He told the story of Hanuman, the struggle he faced on his visit to meet Mata Sita in Lanka. He mentioned that Lord Hanuman was a great leader and posed a varied number of managerial and leadership skills. He advised the participants to believe in own strengths and capabilities.

Then Ms. Surbhi took over the session and she started with meditation activity. Firstly, she explained the correct posture to participants for meditation and asked them to concentrate on middle portion of the forehead with closed eyes. During this process, she provoked the imagination of the participants by asking them to visualize and feel the serene beauty and tranquility of mountains, snowfall, fragrance of flowers etc. She also asked the participants to remove all the negative thoughts prevailing in their minds. After few minutes later, she took this activity to end by asking the participant to rub the hands and put the palm on the eyes and slowly open the eyes. The main aim of this activity was to build concentration, to release negative thoughts and feelings.

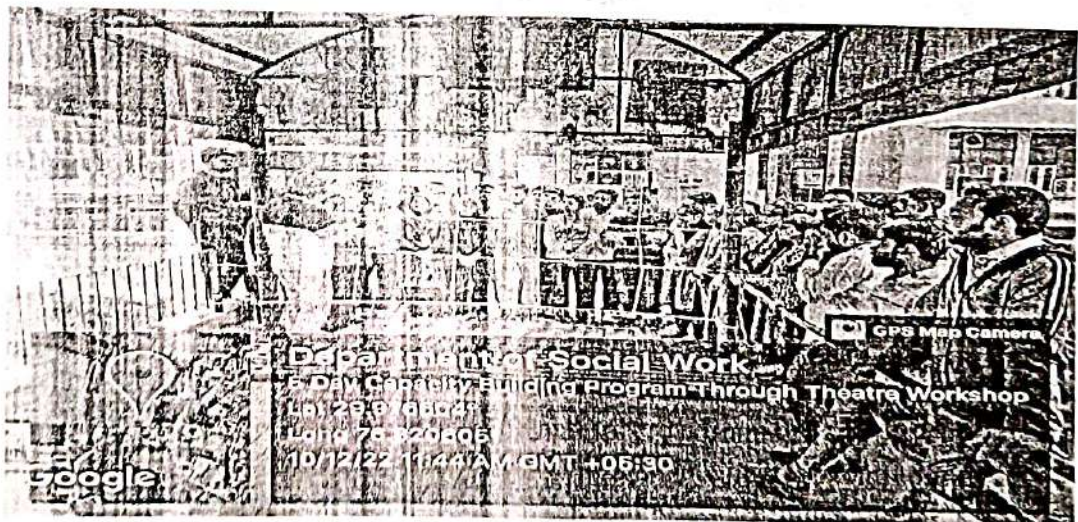

After this, Dr. Ajay Sharma engaged the participants in other activities and games such as one folded leg or 'dangdi taang', cross the river, web crossing, supply chain management and hole in the system. In 'dangdi taang' game Dr. Ajay Sharma chose 5 to 6 participants and asked them to fold their one leg and grab the remaining participants. The participants caught by them will also help them to catch other students by folding their one leg. The aim of this game was team building. After this, cross the river activity was done for enhancing the logical reasoning among the participants. Basically, it was a reasoning puzzle which participants has to resolve. Then this activity was followed by web crossing task. With the help of ropes a web like structure was created by the instructor and every participant has to cross that web within twenty minutes following certain rules. The aim of this activity was to enhance the concentration level of mind and to increase their logical reasoning abilities. Thereafter, refreshment has been distributed among the participants.

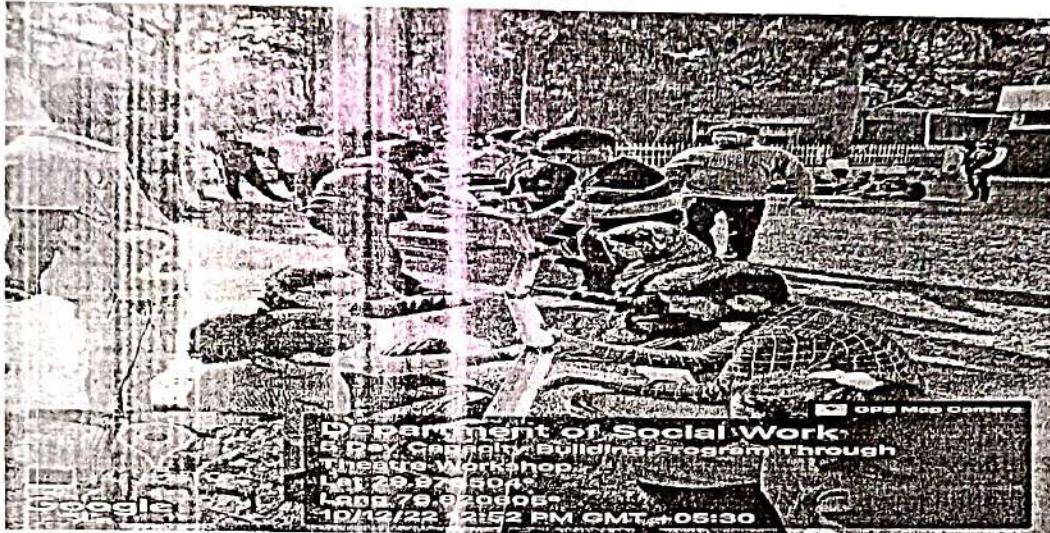


Instructor and participants during web crossing task


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After refreshment, Supply Chain Management, Hole in The System, Cat & Bull and Eggs Can Fly activities were organized. In supply chain management and hole in the system game, the participants have to supply the water from one end to another by using pipe cuttings. The objectives of these activities were to develop coordination, leadership skills, team building and to promote innovative ideas among the participants.

Thereafter, Cat & Bull and Eggs Can Fly activities were organized. In 'eggs can fly activity' participants have to make something creative out of waste material. The aim of this activity was to promote creativity among the participants using limited resources.

Thereafter, refreshment had been provided to the participants and formal vote of thanks was delivered by Mr. Krishan Kumar, Assistant Professor, Department of Social Work, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. He thanked Dr. Ajay and Ms. Surbhi for imparting their valuable time and sharing knowledge with the participants of social work department. Prof. Vanita Dhingra, Chairperson, department of social work also presented a token of gratitude to Dr. Ajay and Ms. Surbhi.

Workshop Day-3

For this day, the Resource Persons were Dr. Anas and Ms. Deepshikha, Visiting Faculty from Jamia Milia Islamia, Delhi. Firstly, Mr. Krishan Kumar welcomed the Resource persons and called the chairperson of the department Prof. Vanita Dhingra to give formal introduction about them. She introduced the resource persons and mentioned that both the instructors have wide experience in theatre activities. Then Dr. Anas and Ms. Deepshikha thanked the faculty members of social work department for warm welcome and took the participants in the open space for theatre associated activities.

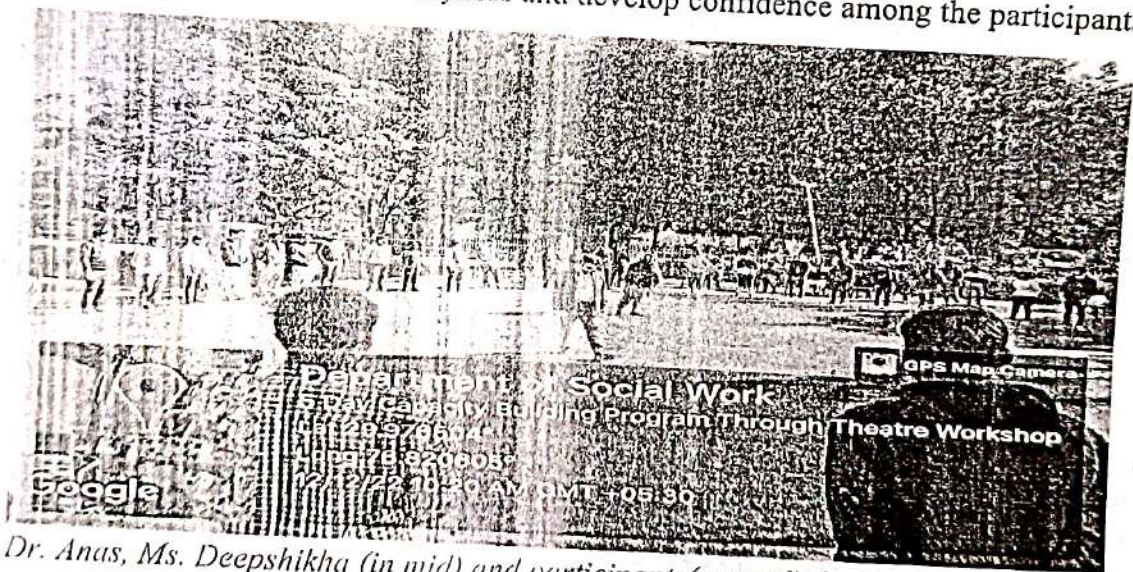

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Mr. Krishan Kumar, Prof. Vanita Dhingra, Dr. Anas & Ms. Deepshikha (from left to right) during welcome address

Firstly, instructors told the participants about significance of voice during theatre. They mentioned that when we perform nukkad natak in the community; our voice should be loud and clear. They taught the technique to participants that how to raise and maintain the pitch of voice from beginning to end of the theatre. Then task was assigned to participants that every participant has to shout own name loudly by using breathing and stomach techniques. The main objective of this task was to remove shyness and develop confidence among the participants.



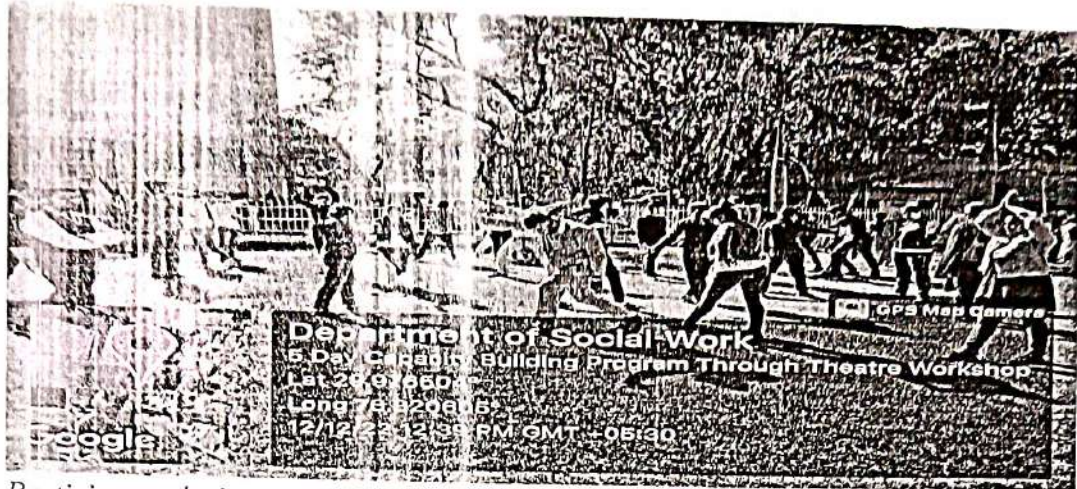
Dr. Anas, Ms. Deepshikha (in mid) and participants(around) during call your name task

Then other activities were organized namely call formation, poster making, daily routine activity and devil in the circle. In call formation activity every participant has move inside the circle without making physical contact with others. The aims of this activity were to develop observation skills, to promote non-verbal skills and to enhance the attention span of participants.

In this activity, participants have to perform their morning routine from waking up to till going to department. The main objective of this activity was to carve the acting skills among the participants. At last, devil in the circle game was performed. The game serves the purpose of enhancing the alertness among the members of the game.


Thereafter, refreshment had been provided to the participants. Faculty members of the social work department, Dr. Anas and Ms. Deepshikha thanked all the participants and invited them for the next day of the workshop.

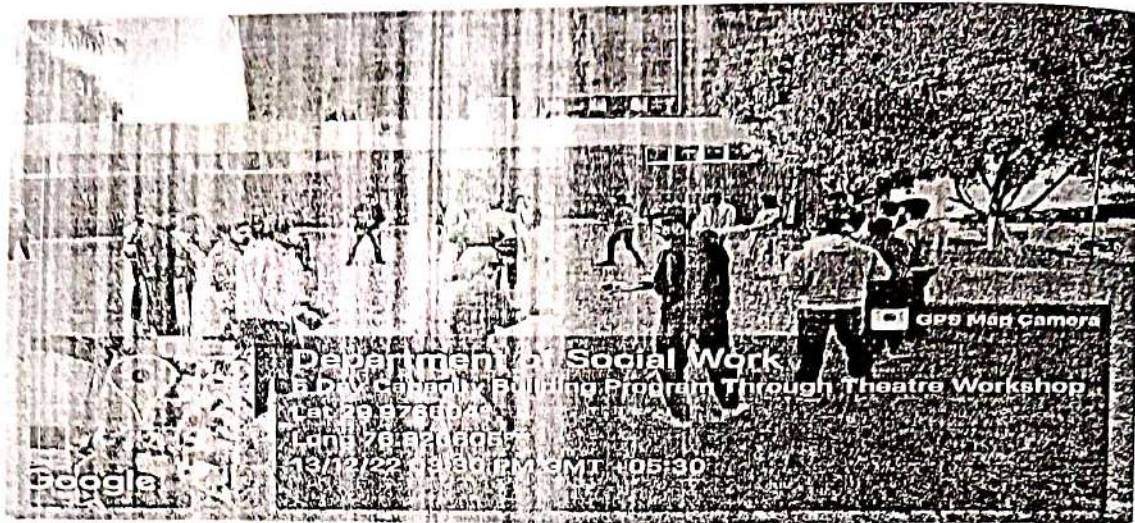
Workshop Day-4

Dr. Anas and Ms. Deepshikha started this day with a voice raising exercise. This activity was meant to build confidence among the participants. After that, a warm-up activity namely 'Haryali Idhar Udhar' was performed. Thereafter, poster making was done by the participants for personality development. In this activity participants have to make different posters by using own body posture and in combination with other persons.

After that Ms. Deepshikha involved the participants in a ball passing activity namely 'juggling game'. The goals of this activity were to enhance the attention level, cooperation and coordination. In this game every participant had to pass the ball with other participants and if someone dropped the ball eventually the participant who dropped and who passed the ball were eliminated.



On warning signal, they have to imagine that bear has entered into their village and they have to safeguard themselves by laying down and to act like a dead person. If someone moves his/her body he will be eliminated from the game. All the participants enjoyed this game a lot. Thereafter, refreshment had been distributed to the participants.


At the end, vote of thanks and a token of gratitude was presented by Prof. Vanita Dhingra, Chairperson, Department of Social Work, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra to Dr. Anas and Ms. Deepshikha. She thanked them both for sparing their time and to teach students about theatre activities. Students also thanked both the instructors for providing such a beautiful experience through theatre activities.

Workshop Day-5

The last day of the workshop was started with welcome address by Mr. Krishan Kumar. He informed the participants about the guests for the day i.e., Ms. Shyampriya and Dr. Darshan Singh. Then formal introduction of the guests was given by Prof. Vanita Dhingra, Chairperson, Department of Social Work, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. She mentioned that Ms. Shyampriya is a Wellness Trainer for Ayurveda and she has a lot of experience in Ayurveda field. Then Ms. Shyampriya thanked Prof. Vanita Dhingra for her welcome and started the session. She took two sessions. First session was on health wisdom and second session was on personality development.

During first session she explained the meaning of ayurveda that is "ayu" refers to life and "Veda" means knowledge at the deepest level. She mentioned that ayurveda gives us the


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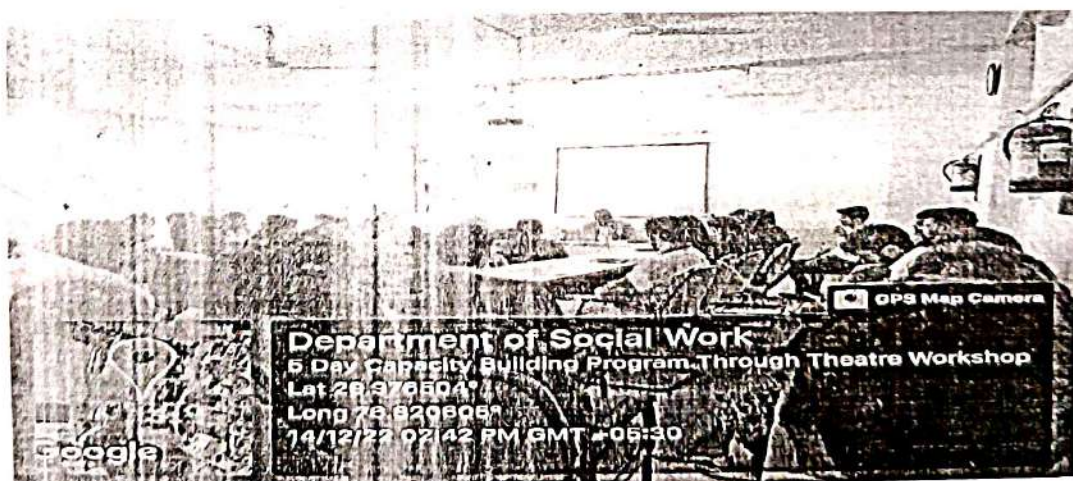





Ms. Shyampriya while delivering lecture to participants

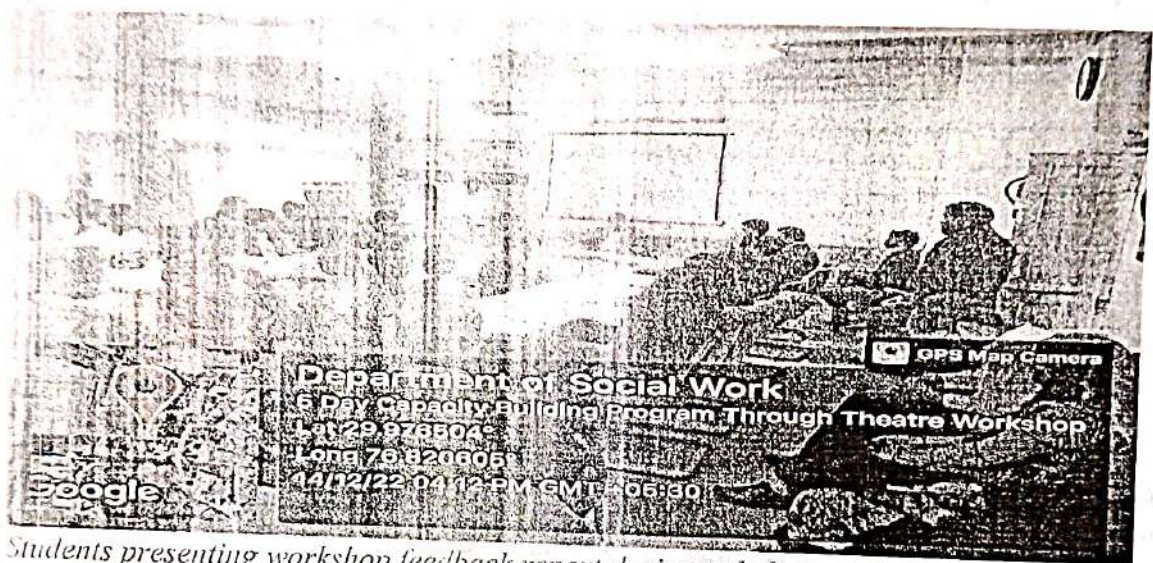

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Prof. Darshan Singh while taking session on community engagement

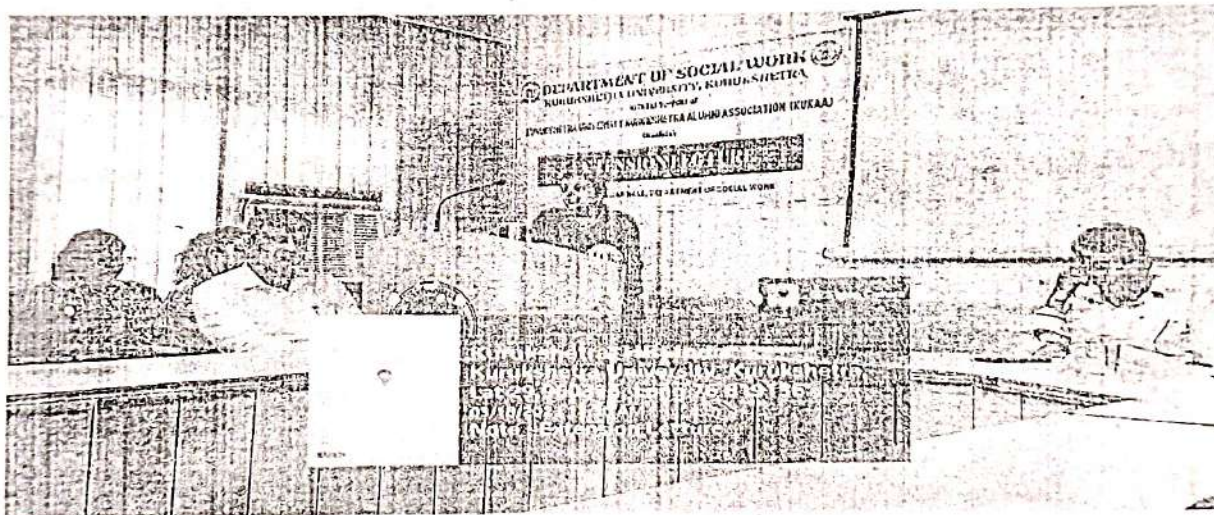

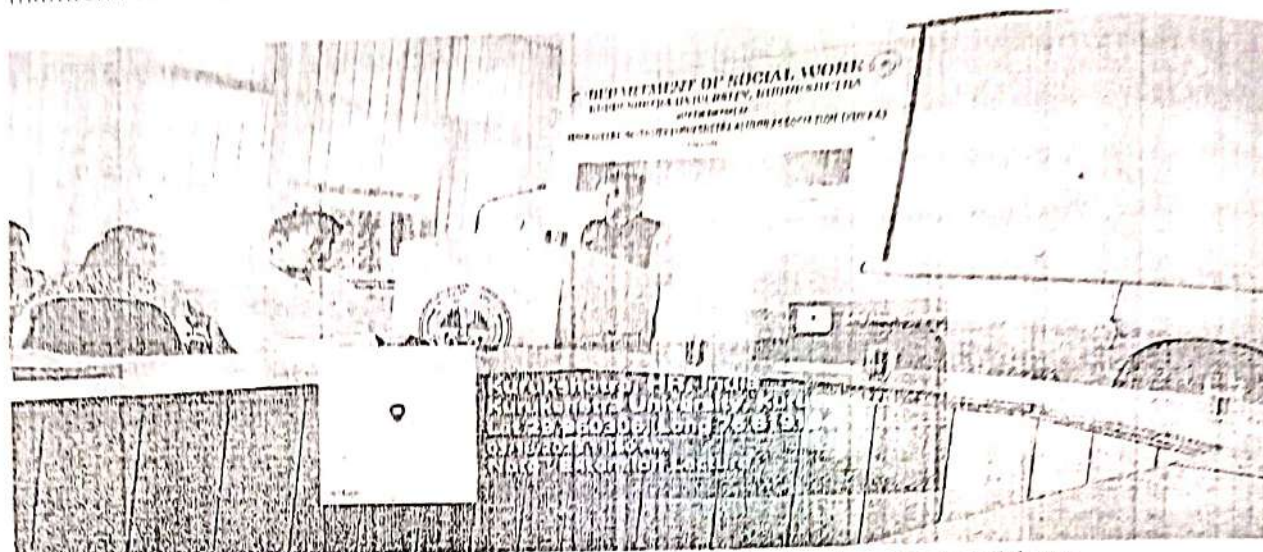
Prof. Vanita Dhingra, Head, Department of Social Work giving welcome address



Online Workshop on Gender Sensitization
For Ph.D. Research Scholars/Post Doctoral Fellows (All Disciplines)
July 20 – 22, 2022

Report

Women's Studies Research Centre in collaboration with UGC-Human Resource Development Centre organized online workshop on Gender Sensitization from 20-22 July 2022 for Ph.D. Research Scholars of all disciplines of Kurukshetra University. In this workshop about 65 research scholars both male and female participated.

Delivering the inaugural address Prof. Manjula Choudhary, Dean Academic Affairs, Kurukshetra University said that gender sensitization is a broad term and all the members of the university have to put in efforts for it. The university is dealing with this issue through two bodies, one is the Women's Studies Research Centre, which creates awareness against gender biases in our society and second the ICCASH, which deals with this issue within the university campus.

Prof. Anita Dua, Director, Women's Studies Research Centre said that although women constitute 50 percent of the population of the country, but its contribution in the economy is very marginal. There are physical, social and psychological barriers preventing women from participating in development. Sustainable Development Goal-5 focuses to achieve gender equality and to eliminate gender bias. She said that to bring in more women into development there is a need to work on women's health, financial literacy, use of technology by women.

In the first technical session Prof. Neera Verma, Department of Economics, Gurugram University, Gurugram delivered her talk on Understanding Gender Bias and Gender Equality. Highlighting the report of World Economic Forum on Global Gender Gap Index, she said that India is far behind the neighbouring countries like Nepal, Bhutan, Bangladesh and it will take 135 years to fill this gender gap. She gave an overview of gender roles from ancient time to the current and explained different gender bias prevalent in the society. Discussing discrimination and its types, she also suggested ways to combat it.

The second technical session was conducted by Dr. Hitashi Lomash, Director, Sushma Swaraj Institute of Foreign Service, New Delhi on Leadership Skills. She talked about sharpening leadership skills in the academic institutions. She discussed psychological safety and need to build psychological safety. She also mentioned some of the important

leadership skills like team building, trust building, interdependence etc. which may be beneficial to work as a team.

On the second day, in the third technical session Prof. Vinti Davar, Director, Ural Organics Pvt. Ltd. and Chief Dietician, Ayushman Hospital and Services, New Delhi conducted a session on Women's Health and Nutrition. She defined some of the related terms like nutrition, malnutrition, wellness, fitness, diet etc. and then discussed six types of health issues which are more common these days. These were chronic backache, diabetes, obesity, depression, infertility and cardio vascular diseases. She elaborated reasons of these diseases and suggested methods to keep good health. She also talked about sources of vitamins & minerals, its functions in our body and the consequences of malnutrition and under nutrition.

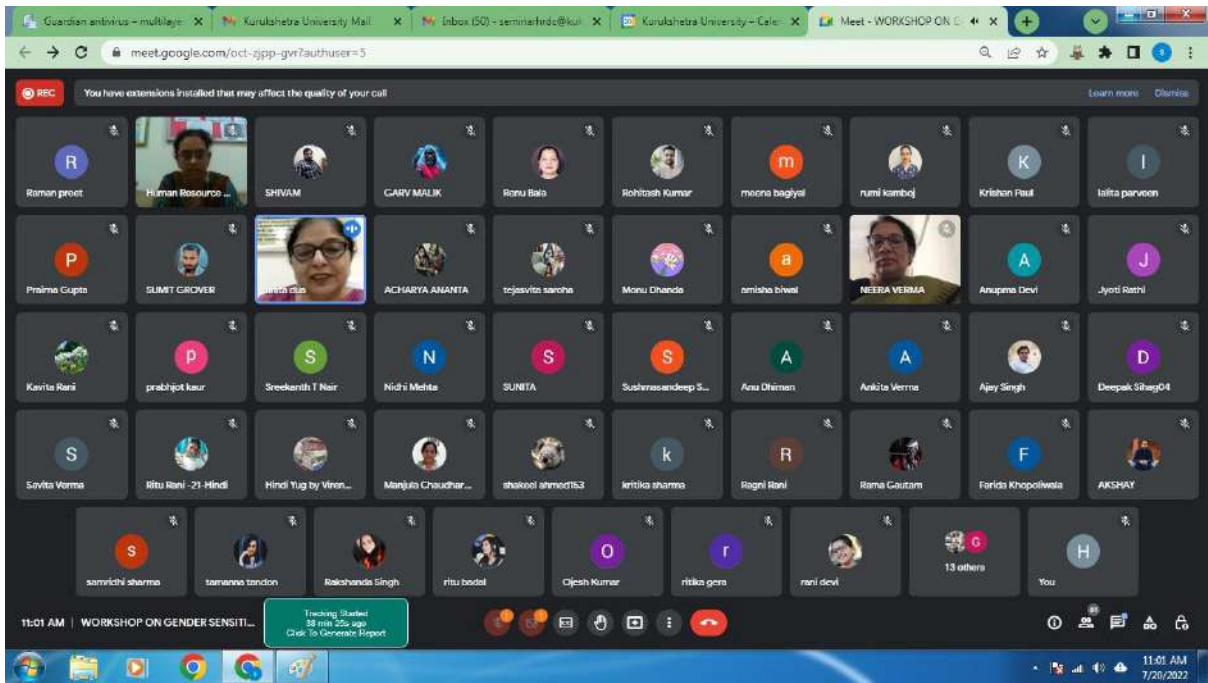
The fourth technical session was conducted by Prof. Bulbul Dhar James, Dept. of Political Science, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi on Gender based Violence. After explaining the meaning of gender based violence she highlighted its reasons such as misogyny, entitlements, superiority and control sanctioned to males through patriarchy and socialization. She elaborated BOIS locker room, power and control and men's lockdown anxiety which explain gender based violence. She also talked about domestic violence and violence beyond gender binary.

Prof. Nisha Rana from Dept. of Commerce, Deen Dayal Upadhyay College, Delhi in the fifth technical session deliberated upon Work Life Balance. She started her talk with a brief comparison of the challenges and opportunities of each era since ancient to present and also mentioned the phases of evolution of Indian women. She discussed various reasons of women's entry into work as well as current challenges of women's work. Highlighting the need to maintain work life balance, she elaborated KAS model of training, old and new role parameters of women and the dilemmas faced by working women. She also recommended some ways to reduce stress caused due to dual role of working women.

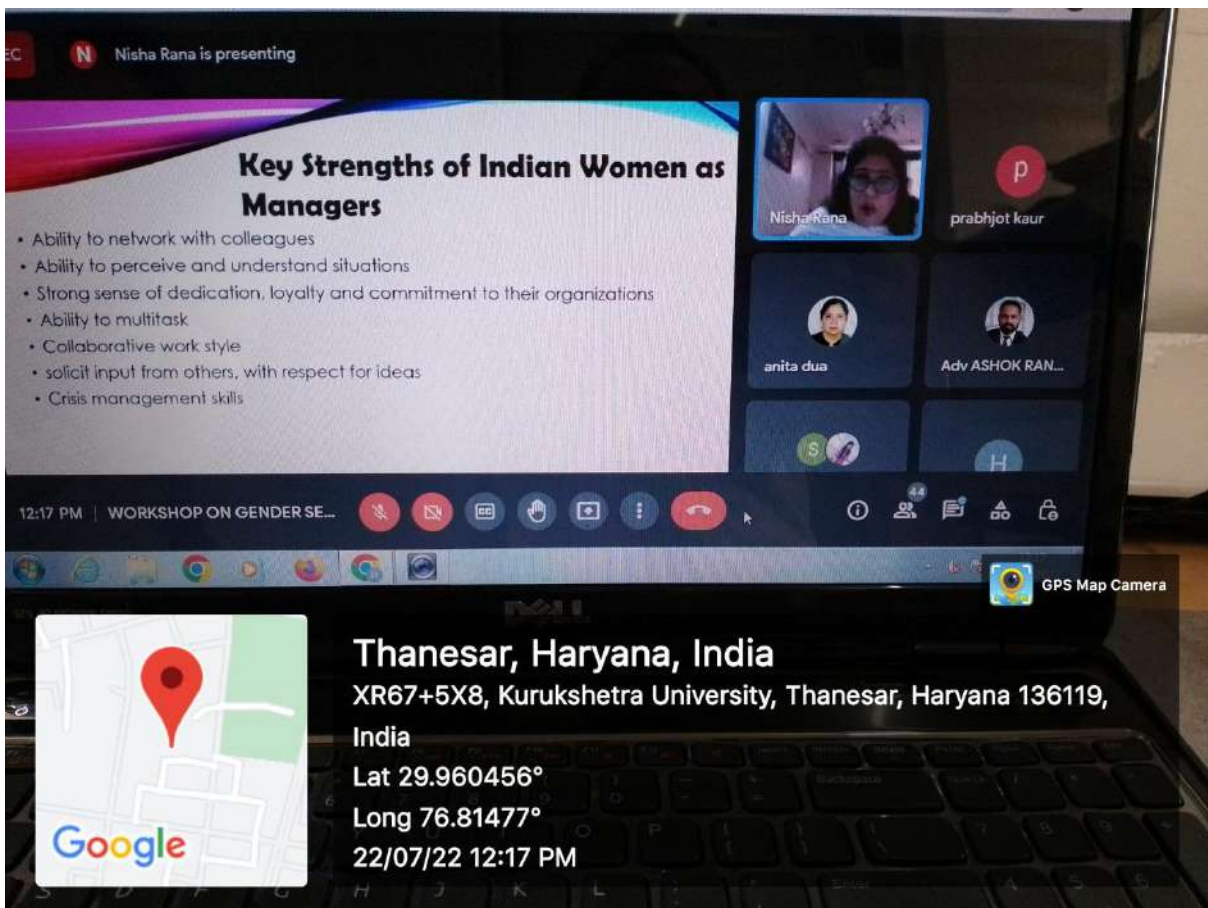
The sixth technical session was dealt by Prof. Vanita Dhingra, Dept. of Social Work, K.U. Kurukshetra on Internal Complaints Committee against Sexual Harassment. She first of all explained the meaning of sexual harassment as per the act and then mentioned the provisions of ICCASH of Kurukshetra University. She explained the scope of the policy, its applicability, procedure of filing the complaint, method of inquiry and redressal mechanism. She also talked about dos and don'ts in case of sexual harassment.

The last technical session was conducted by Dr. Vivek Chawla, Dept. of Commerce, IIHS, K.U. Kurukshetra on Financial Management. He elaborated the need of financial management, steps and strategies of financial management. He discussed a 50:30:20 formula for management of finances through which one can manage his/her needs, wants and savings in a balanced manner. He also discussed the importance of health insurance schemes.

In the valedictory session Prof. Anita Dua, Director, WSRC readout the report of the three days sessions and then feedback from participants was invited. Chief Guest of this session Prof. Anurekha Sharma, In-charge, Incubation Centre, K.U. Kurukshetra delivering the valedictory address highlighted the need of gender sensitization. Sharing several live examples of gender biasness in science, she motivated the students to come ahead and be sensitive towards each other. She also informed the students about the functions of Incubation Center of the university.

केयू के महिला अध्ययन शोध केन्द्र तथा यूजीसी मानव संसाधन विकास केन्द्र द्वारा ऑनलाइन जेंडर संवेदनशीलता कार्यशाला का हुआ समापन



कुरुक्षेत्र (दो.आर.संवेदनगर) : कुरुक्षेत्र विश्वविद्यालय के महिला अध्ययन शोध केन्द्र तथा यूजीसी मानव संसाधन विकास केन्द्र द्वारा पीएचडी शोधार्थियों के लिए तीन दिवसीय ऑनलाइन जेंडर संवेदनशीलता कार्यशाला का आयोजन 20 से 22 जुलाई 2022 को किया गया, जिसमें विश्वविद्यालय के विभिन्न शैक्षणिक विभागों से लगभग 70 शोधार्थी भाग लिया। कार्यक्रम के दुसरे दिन के शहत सत्र में पुरत ऑर्गेनिक्सा प्रा. सि. की खपरवट प्रो. विन्ती डवर् ने स्वास्थ्य एवं पोषण पर व्याख्यान दिया। संध्याभंग उन्होंने स्वास्थ्य, बेलनस, फिटनेस, चंचल, आहार आदि शब्दों को स्पष्ट किया, तापरयत्ता उन्होंने स्वभाव जीवन शैली के कारण होने वाली स्वास्थ्य संबंधी परिस्थितियों को विवक्षित किया। जिसमें कमर दर्द, मधुमेह, मोटापा, तनाव, बड़बहन तथा इत्येव रोग का प्रमुख रूप से वर्णन किया। उन्होंने कहा कि खरव दिनचर्या के कारण हमारे जीवन शैली प्रभावित हो गई है जिसके कारण स्वास्थ्य संबंधी हारमोनों का उत्तर भी प्रभावित हो गया है तथा विभिन्न

रोगों से शरीर प्रभावित हो रहा है। अच्छे स्वास्थ्य के लिए पर्याप्त नींद, व्यक्तिगत स्वच्छता, प्रशान्तचित रहना, संतुलित आहार लेना, सक्रियता, व्यायाम आदि आवश्यक है। उन्होंने हमारे शरीर के लिए आवश्यक विटामिन, मिनरल, प्रोटीन एवं उनके स्रोतों की भी विस्तार से चर्चा की। दूसरे सत्र में जामिया मिलिया इस्लामिया से प्रो. बुजबुल बर जैम ने जेंडर आधारित हिंसा पर चर्चा की। उन्होंने कहा कि हिंसा महिलाओं को नियंत्रित करने एवं अधीन बनाने का एक माध्यम है। हमारे समाज में व्याप्त माइक्रोअग्रेसिविटी काल्पनिक रूप पुरत व्यवस्था के कारण हिंसा उत्पन्न होती है। उन्होंने कहा कि समाज एवं संस्कृति आचरण के नियम, अधिकार, बंधन आदि तय करते हैं जो पुरुषों के पक्ष में होते हैं। चिनुत्सता का निवारण करते हुए उन्होंने स्पष्ट किया कि यह महिलाओं की गतिशीलता, शक्ति, स्वास्थ्य, शिक्षा, रोजगार आदि को प्रभावित करता है तथा यौगि व निरक्षण पुरुषों में कोप्रिया करती है। उन्होंने एकधतरपूर्ण समाजीकरण, पूर्वाग्रहों आदि की भी विस्तार से चर्चा की तथा कहा कि भेदभावपूर्ण समाजीकरण के कारण न केवल महिलाओं वरत पुरुषों का भी नुकसान होता है। वे अपने जेंडरों एवं संवेदनशीलता को प्रकट नहीं कर पाते हैं। आज कार्यशाला के तीसरे दिन के पहले सत्र में डीन वजाल उपपथाय महाविद्यालय दिल्ली से प्रो. निशा ताना ने कार्य-परिहार संतुलन पर व्याख्यान दिया। उन्होंने कहा कि

हमारा समाज व संस्कृति सभी सदस्यों को विकसित होने के लिए एक कोड ऑफ कंडक्ट प्रदान करता है जिसमें महिलाओं व पुरुषों के अंतर पर पुनीतार्थ्य अलग-अलग ढंग से विकसित होती है। वैशुकीकरण तथा शौकीनीकरण के कारण हमारे सामाजिक-सांस्कृतिक संदर्भ बदल रहे हैं, हमारी जीवन शैली बदल रही है, साथ ही स्त्री-पुरुष के बीच समता में भी बदलाव आ रहा है। इस बदलते हुए परिवेश में महिलाओं के लिए सबसे बड़ी चुनौती अपने परिवार की, स्वयं की तथा अपने कार्यस्थल की आवश्यकताओं में संतुलन बिदाला है। उन्होंने स्वतंत्रता के परम्परा से आज 21वीं सदी तक महिलाओं के कार्यक्षेत्र में सतने के विभिन्न कारणों की चर्चा करते हुए कहा कि वर्तमान महिलाएं चुनौतियों से घबरलती नहीं बलिक इत अवसर का फायदा उठाना जानती हैं साथ ही वे परिवार के प्रति अपनी जिम्मेदारी को डीक ढंग से न निरा करने के कारण तनाव, खुदा एवं अपराध बोध से गुसित हो जाती हैं। अतः इस स्थिति को संकलतपण बनाने के लिए सजुट सिल्टम को स्थापित करना चाहिए, अपनी आवश्यकताएं अपने स्वास्थ्य, अपने आकांक्षाएं स्पष्ट करने में शर्मिता न महसूस करें। उन्होंने कहा कि कार्य-परिहार संतुलन की कोई निश्चित परिभाषा नहीं होती, यह सबसे निर अलग अलग होता है। डॉ. वरीया बीगत, महिला अध्ययन शोध केन्द्र की उपनिदेशिका जी यौन उत्पीडन को आंतरिक शिकारता कमेटी की सदस्य

पी हैं, ने कुरुक्षेत्र विश्वविद्यालय की इन कमेटी के बारे में प्रतिभागियों को विस्तार से समझाया। उन्होंने सर्वथम कार्यस्थल पर महिलाओं के यौन शोषण की परिभाषा को स्पष्ट किया, उन्होंने कहा कि वह कमेटी यौन उत्पीडन की रोकथाम निषेध तथा रिपोर्ट के लिए बान करती है साथ ही उन्होंने शिकारित दर्ज करने की प्रक्रिया तथा समय सीमा की जानकारी दी। दूसरे सत्र में आईआईएफएस से डॉ. विवेक जाल्ना ने वित्तीय प्रबंधन पर चर्चा करते हुए कहा कि देश की रिपोर्ट 24 प्रतिशत जनसंख्या वित्तीय प्रबंधन के विषय को नहीं डन से समझती हैं। उन्होंने अपनी फूजे को डीक ढंग से निवेक करने हेतु उपयोगी टिप्पणियां दीं। उन्होंने बीमा योजना के लाभ समझाये तथा बहती नईगाई का हमारे निवेश पर पड़ने वाले प्रभावों से भी प्रतिभागियों को अवगत कराया। तीन दिवसीय कार्यशाला के समापन समारोह में कुरुक्षेत्र विश्वविद्यालय के इंटरकेशन सेंटर की मनारी प्रो. अनुपमा शर्मा मुख्य अतिथि रही उन्होंने प्रतिभागियों को प्रोत्साहित किया। महिला अध्ययन शोध केन्द्र की निदेशिका ने तीन दिवसीय कार्यक्रम की रिपोर्ट पढ़ी। इस अवसर पर डॉ. वंदना दवे ने समक आभात व्यक्त किया।

समाचार निर्देशक ब्यूरो कुरुक्षेत्र, (दलबीर मलिक जिला ब्यूरो चीफ) कुरुक्षेत्र विश्वविद्यालय की डीन एकेडमिक अफेयर्स तथा मानव संसाधन विकास केन्द्र की निदेशिका प्रो. मंजूला चौधरी ने कहा कि जेंडर संवेदनशीलता एक बहुत ही विस्तृत विषय है, जिस पर विश्वविद्यालय तथा समाज के सभी वर्गों को मिलकर काम करना होगा। उन्होंने कहा कि विश्वविद्यालय स्तर पर दो व्यवस्था बनी हुई है जो जेंडर संवेदनशीलता विषय पर काम करती हैं। वे बुधवार को कुवि के महिला अध्ययन शोध केन्द्र तथा यूजीसी मानव संसाधन विकास केन्द्र द्वारा पीएचडी शोधार्थियों के लिए तीन दिवसीय ऑनलाइन जेंडर संवेदनशीलता कार्यशाला के उद्घाटन अवसर पर बतौर मुख्यातिथि बोल रही थीं।

प्रो. मंजूला चौधरी ने कहा कि विश्वविद्यालय में कार्यस्थल पर महिलाओं के यौन उत्पीडन के विरुद्ध जेंडर संवेदनशीलता कमेटी सक्रिय रूप से कार्य कर रही है। इसके साथ ही विश्वविद्यालय का महिला अध्ययन शोध केन्द्र समाज के सभी वर्गों हेतु जेंडर संवेदनशीलता पर कार्य करता है। उन्होंने कहा कि समाज में व्याप्त लैंगिक पूर्वाग्रहों को कम करने के लिए हमें अपनी विचार प्रक्रिया को परखना तथा दुरुस्त करना होगा, ताकि हम लैंगिक समानता की ओर अग्रसर हो सकें। इस अवसर पर महिला अध्ययन शोध केन्द्र की निदेशिका प्रो. अनिता दुआ ने सभी का स्वागत करते हुए कहा कि देश की आधी जनसंख्या महिलाओं की है लेकिन यदि विभिन्न क्षेत्रों में उनकी भागीदारी देखे तो वह

अत्यन्त नगण्य है। विभिन्न सामाजिक-सांस्कृतिक, शारीरिक तथा मनोवैज्ञानिक बाधाएं इसके लिए जिम्मेदार हैं। यह बाधाएं न केवल महिलाओं की प्रगति को रोकती हैं, बलिक देश की प्रगति में भी बाधक हैं। हमें उन समाधानों की आवश्यकता है जिससे समाज के विकास में सभी बराबर के भागीदार बन सकें। सतत विकास लक्ष्य के अन्तर्गत लैंगिक समानता को ध्यान में रखना चाहिए तथा लैंगिक पूर्वाग्रह को दूर करना भी सतत विकास का लक्ष्य है। सभी को इस दिशा में काम करने की आवश्यकता है। उन्होंने कहा कि हर क्षेत्र में महिला शोधार्थियों की संख्या बहुत कम है। हमें स्वास्थ्य, तकनीकी ज्ञान का उपयोग वित्तीय साक्षरता आदि विषयों पर भी काम करने की जरूरत है।

रिपोर्ट

कुरुक्षेत्र विश्वविद्यालय के महिला अध्ययन शोध केन्द्र द्वारा स्त्री शक्ति: द पेरलल फोर्स एवं शिवनिंग एल्यूमनी प्रोजेक्ट फंड के सहयोग से "शी लीड्स – भारत में महिला नेतृत्व को सशक्त बनाना" विषय पर छात्राओं हेतु एक दिवसीय प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम दिनांक 17.12.2022 को आयोजित किया। जिसमें विश्वविद्यालय की 60 से अधिक जेंडर चेम्पियन तथा छात्राओं ने भाग लिया।

कार्यशाला का प्रारम्भ करते हुए केन्द्र की निदेशिका प्रो० अनिता दुआ ने कहा कि नेतृत्व में महिलाओं के प्रतिनिधित्व को यदि देखें तो यह एक पिरामिड की तरह है जिसमें टॉप लेवल पर बहुत कम महिलाएं हैं हालांकि एंट्री लेवल पर महिलाओं की संख्या फिर भी काफी है। इस असंतुलन को ठीक करना बहुत जरूरी है। ऐसा नहीं है कि लड़कियों में टैलेंट नहीं है या क्षमताएँ नहीं हैं, आवश्यकता इस बात की है कि हम उनकी क्षमताओं को विकसित करें। उन्होंने कहा कि इस प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम के माध्यम से छात्राओं में नेतृत्व क्षमताओं को विकसित करने का प्रयास किया जाएगा।

कार्यक्रम में प्रमुख प्रशिक्षिका श्रीमति आभा भट्ट, जो कि व्यावसायिक अधिवक्ता तथा जानी मानी मोटीवेशनल स्पीकर हैं, ने कहा कि महिलाओं में पुरुषों से अधिक कम्यूनिकेशन स्किल तथा संवेगात्मकता होती है, जो हमें जन्म से ही प्राप्त हुई है, इनका बेहतर इस्तेमाल करना सीखना चाहिए। लड़कियों को प्रारम्भ से जजमेंटल हो कर देखा जाता है। दूसरों के कमेंट्स को अलग रखकर स्वयं को परिभाषित करना आवश्यक है। उन्होंने कहा कि महिलाएं इमोशनल होती हैं पर इन संवेगों को अपनी शक्ति तथा प्रेरणा बनाना चाहिए न कि कमजोरी। गुस्सा, तनाव, भय तथा ईर्ष्या की चर्चा करते हुए कहा कि 'लीडर' बनने के लिए ये कमजोरी नहीं बननी चाहिए बल्कि इन सब विषयों पर काम करके नियंत्रित करने की कोशिश करनी चाहिए। लीडर की शक्ति एक्शन में है, हमें अवचेतन मन के संदेह, भय आदि से घबराकर कंफ्यूज नहीं होना चाहिए। उन्होंने आगे कहा कि जीवन में दो चयन सोच समझकर करने चाहिए। एक तो यह कि हमें जीवन में क्या करना है और दूसरा हम किन लोगों को अपने आस-पास चाहते हैं। उन्होंने कहा कि महिला होना कोई मुद्दा नहीं है, बल्कि जीवन के जो वास्तविक मुद्दे हैं उन्हें सुलझाने का प्रयास करना चाहिए। हमें अपने व्यक्तित्व को मुख्यवान बनाना चाहिए। परिस्थितियों को बदलने के लिए खुद को बदलाव के लिए तैयार करना जरूरी है। उन्होंने छात्राओं को आर्थिक रूप से आत्मनिर्भर बनने के लिए प्रेरित किया।

स्त्री शक्ति: द पेरलल फोर्स की प्रोग्राम एवं पार्टनरशिप हैड एवं कंसल्टेंट श्रीमति सविता सेठी ने ग्रामीण स्तर पर महिला नेतृत्व पर किये गये कार्यों के अनुभव सांझा किये।

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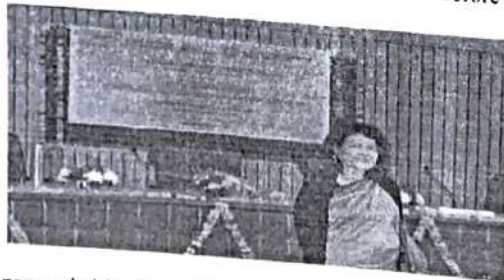

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DAY 1 – February 06, 2023

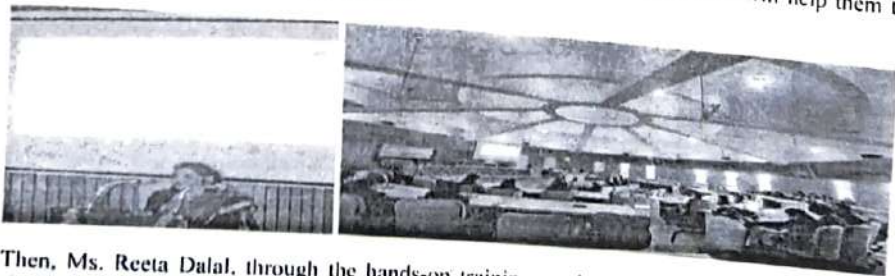

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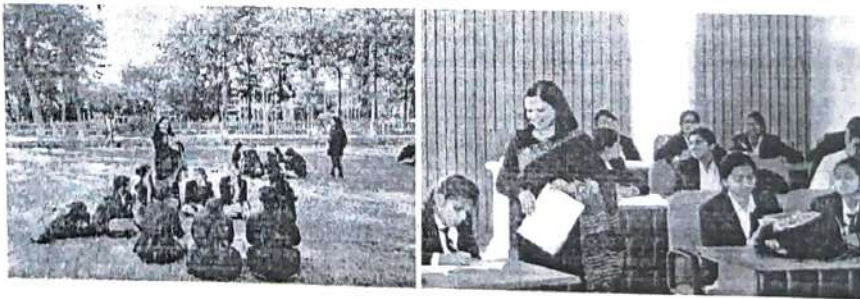
DAY 2 – February 07, 2023

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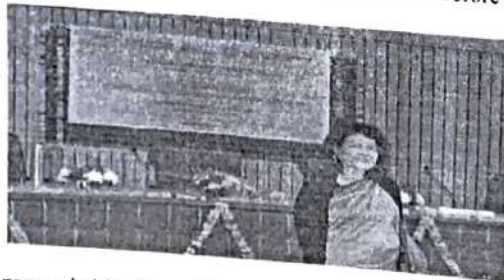

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DAY 1 – February 06, 2023

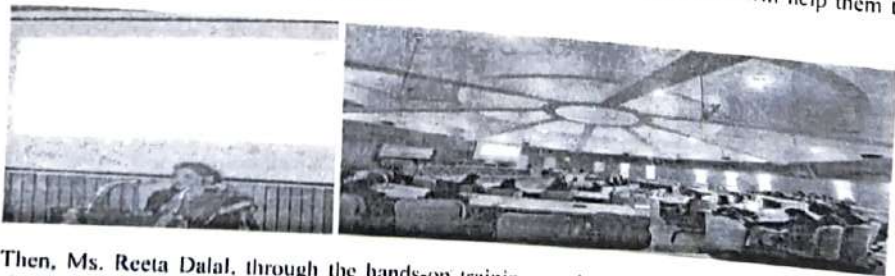

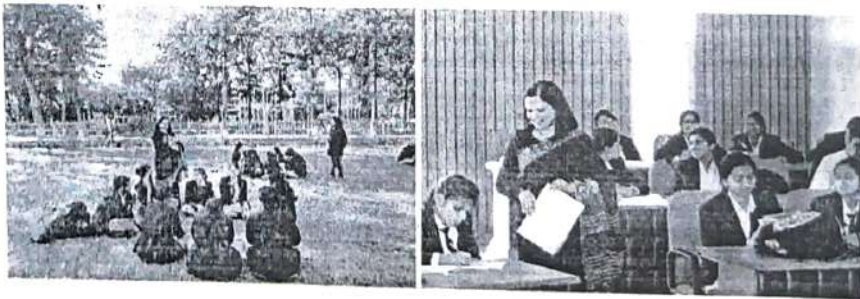
DAY 2 – February 07, 2023
