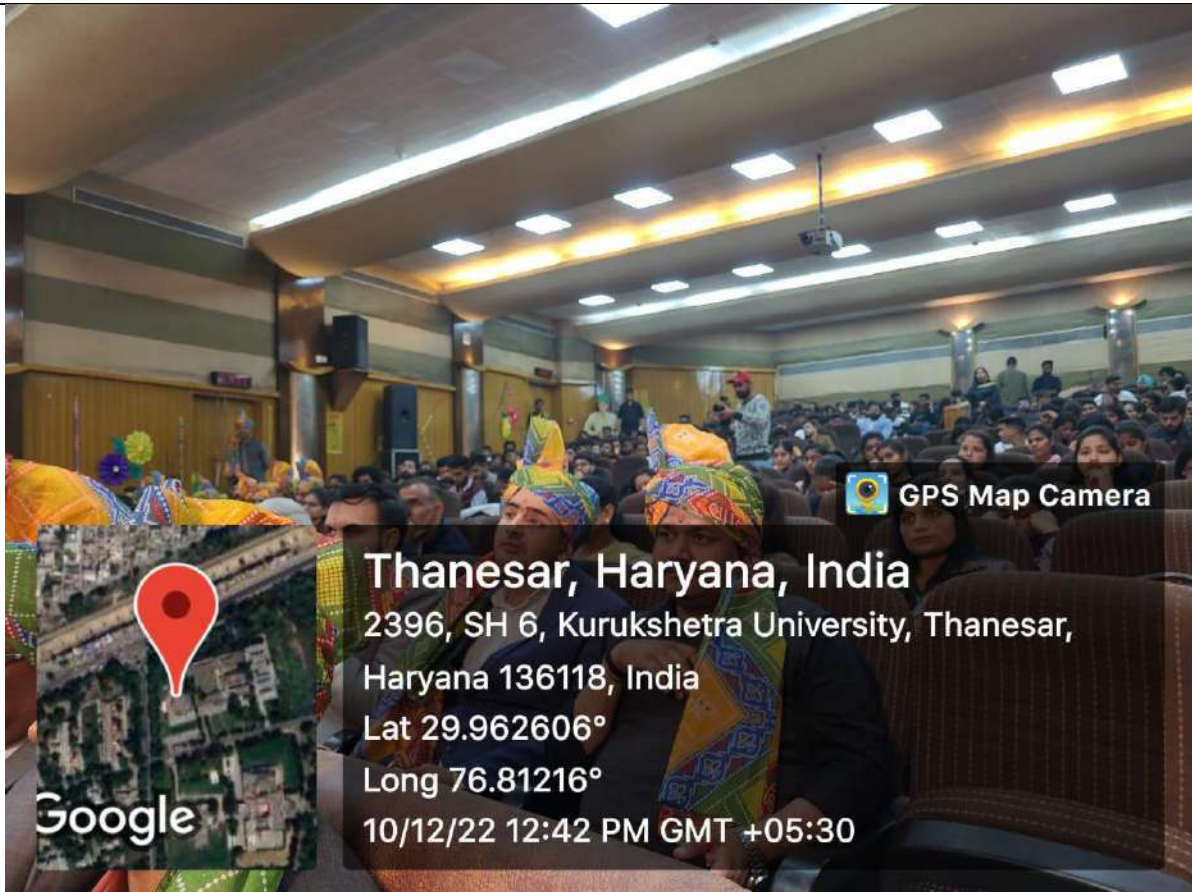
EVENT REPORT- ALUMNI MEET

Industrial Visit at T.C. SPINNERS PVT. LTD, Lalru, Punjab

An Industrial visit was held for 42 students of Institute of Management Studies at T.C. SPINNERS PVT. LTD. accompanied by the staff members Dr. Anil Kumar, Dr. Meenakshi Godara, and Ms. Leeza Chauhan. The students arrived at T.C. SPINNERS PVT. LTD., where Mr. Vijay Girdhar, the organization's head of human resources, greeted and gave a brief overview of the organization. The students split up into three smaller groups for each student to comprehend how the business operates. One senior officer served as the leader of each group. The following describes the route to the industry:

- ✓ Two processes—the "spinning process," in which raw cotton is transformed into thread, and the "weaving process," in which the thread is woven into fabric—are utilized to create the fabric that is typically used for our clothing. Using a mixing and blowing equipment, the compacted staple fiber brought to the spinning facility is unraveled to start the spinning process. Next it is cleaned by getting rid of anything stuck to it, including sand, seeds, or fallen leaves. The staple fiber is then transformed into "lap" in the form of sheets.
- ✓ The cotton is next altered into lap sheets in the second stage. The microscopic dust particles are eliminated at a temperature of 32 to 33 degrees, and the cotton is subsequently turned into rope-like thread. The carding machine is used to separate the fibers and remove short fibers and fine dust from the sheet-shaped lap that was produced during the mixing and blowing process. The remaining long fibers are gathered and approximately parallel-aligned before being processed into "carded sliver," which resembles a string. Twenty people are currently employed there, but the staff estimates that eventually all work in that area will be performed by robots. 18 to 24 carded slivers are fed side by side in a single feeding. They are drafted and a loose form of web is created. The web is rolled up to a lap. This is called "sliver lap." The carded sliver is further combed to remove short fibers and dust that could not be removed in the carding process. Fibers are then arranged parallel to obtain uniform combed sliver. This process is essential to manufacture uniform, high-quality yarn. Six to eight slivers after the carding or combing process are gathered and elongated to six to eight times their original length using a drawing machine to straighten and remove uneven thickness from the fibers. This process transforms fibers into string-like "drawn sliver." Since the drawn sliver is too thick to produce yarns directly, it is further

elongated using a roving machine. Twisting is first applied to fibers in this process to obtain the green yarn, which is wound onto a bobbin.

- ✓ The temperature of the area grows together with the size of the stage. Due to the needs of the machinery, the temperature is kept around 42 to 44 degrees in the third step. The saliver is converted into cotton threads at this stage, and after passing through numerous machineries, the thread gains strength and sharpness. The green yarn produced by the roving process is further stretched to the necessary thickness and then twisted in the fine spinning process, the final of the primary spinning processes. The finished item, or yarn, is wound onto a bobbin. Rewinding the finished yarn onto bobbins and placing it into a cheese or cone, depending on its use, is the winding process.
- ✓ The cotton loses moisture throughout the process. The final inspection of the thread is then performed twice in order to assess its quality and restore the moisture, and then it is wrapped in plastic bags for delivery. The owners invested approximately 75 crores throughout the entire procedure. The organization primarily works in the overseas supply of cotton threads from India and focuses on the quality of the cotton threads. As machines become more sophisticated and full robotic machine operation is anticipated in the future, the number of employees is steadily declining.

After that, we were taken to a meeting room where Mr. Kamalnath, the head of the technical department, Mr. Pardeep Singh, the head of the IT cell, and Mr. Vijay Girdhar answered all the queries of the students and clarified their doubts while educating them on the organization's administration. They finished the meeting by sharing a small treat. After giving letter of appreciation from the Institute, the faculty members concluded their visit.

Guidelines for Department/Institute/UIET Level Competitions (Round-I)

1. All regular students of University Teaching Departments/Institutions on the campus including M Phil. Students can participate. The students enrolled for Ph.D, or pursuing pre-Ph.D. course shall not be eligible for participation.
2. The presentation will be of 3 to 5 minutes. Paper reading will not be allowed.
3. Medium of speech can be either English or Hindi. At Stage-I, students of Department of Punjabi and Sanskrit can speak in Punjabi and Sanskrit language respectively. However, at Stages II & III of the competition, the medium of speech shall either be English or Hindi.
4. The topics must be circulated and displayed on the notice boards by the concerned Deptt./Instt./College.
5. All Chairpersons/Directors/Principals will nominate two teachers from their own or other Departments to be associated as Judges for the Department level competitions. In addition, Chairpersons/Directors/Principals will also nominate one student to the Judges panel thereby providing three Judges for all Department/Institute level competitions.
6. Chairpersons/Directors/Principal will also nominate one student to compere and one teacher to Co-ordinate the Stage-I level competitions. As such, this competition will mainly be a student activity.
7. Teachers associated as Judges & Coordinator at the Deptt./Instt. Level, will be paid an honorarium of Rs. 500/- and students associated as Judges and comperers will be paid Rs.400/- each.
8. In case the number of speaker students is upto 4, then only one prize should be awarded; and if the number of speaker students is upto 6, then two prizes should be awarded; and finally if the number of speaker students is seven and above, then only the number of prizes will be three. All Teacher Co-ordinators are requested to send the attendance of the speaker students along with result performa. No results will be entertained without attendance of the speaker students.
9. Where the number of the students are more as in case of Dept. Law , Inst. of Law, Inst. of Management Studies, IMC & MT, Inst of Pharmacy, the number of prizes shall be two each for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd positions without violating the spirit of point No.8 above.
10. In case of IHS, ITTR and UIET, the competition of Stage-I will be organized at their own level and expenses including prize money at level Ist, so occur, will be met out of their respective A/Funds. These institutions will recommend first ten, twelve and three students respectively for participation at Stage-II of the Rostrum which is to be held at University level in the month of 2023.
11. A cash prize of Rs.1,000/- Rs. 750/- and Rs. 500/- (Ist, IInd and IIIrd) will be given to the winning students along with a certificate.
Note: Only one student will be considered each for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Position. No parallel/(bracketed) prizes will be entertained in any case.
12. Results of the Round-I competitions must be returned by the teacher Co-ordinator through their respective Chairperson/Director/Principal duly filled on the enclosed proforma latest by 11.02.2023 to the office of DSW.







Guidelines

1. The Final round of Rostrum will be in the form of Symposium.
2. The presentation should be 3 to 5 minutes. Paper reading will not be allowed. After completion of the presentation open house discussion will be held in which atleast one question will be asked from judges' panel and two questions may be asked by the audience.
3. Medium of speech can be either English or Hindi.
4. Speakers must observe that no anti-national remarks or the remarks which are not fact based and which hurts the sentiments of any community/religion/caste be made during the speech.
5. The topics of the final round will be displayed on the notice board of DSW, on the students notices at KUK website and will be intimated to the respective Chairperson/Director for further display among concerned students of the Deptt./Inst. through email.
6. There will be three judges to be appointed by the Overall Coordinator/Joint Coordinator. The Coordinator will also nominate two students (one to comperere/coordinate the programme and other as time keeper). It will mainly be a student activity comperered and coordinated by the students. Teachers will only help and guide the students. Coordinator and Teacher Judges will be paid an honorarium of Rs. 1000/- each.
