

# OFFICE OF DEAN STUDENTS' WELFARE KURUKSHETRA UNIVERSITY KURUKSHETRA

(Established by the State Legislature Act XII of 1956) ('A++' GRADE, NAAC ACCREDITED)

#### Annual Report -2023

The office of Dean Students' Welfare facilitates student empowerment, leadership, and advocacy by strengthening student participation in the life, governance and success of the University. The office provides resources and support to help students turn their ideas into reality. The office works for engaging the students to let them harness their energy for constructive creativity and to further empower themselves by sharpening their skills as well as inculcating leadership capabilities transforming themselves into positive catalysts for personal and National growth. The office looks after students' welfare in different ways and promotes various cultural, sports and academic activities.

#### 1. <u>Bus/Railway passes facility to the students</u>

One of the major activities of the office is to facilitate students to travel to the University and back. The office as such arranged 3846 bus passes and 170 railway passes for the students of University Teaching Departments (UTD) in 2023. The work involves various processes, such as online data entry of students on the Haryana Roadways website, cash collection, deposit, preparation and distribution of passes. In case of railway concessions, the office of D.S.W. disbursed the concession forms supplied by DRM, New Delhi, to the eligible students.

#### 2. <u>Earn While You Learn Scheme</u>

This novel scheme provides financial assistance to upto 50 UTD students in the form of their engagement for Department related work upto 18 hours a week @ Rs. 60/- per hour. The meritorious students, not possessing financial resources to fund their education are selected on the recommendations of the Chairperson of respective departments. The spirit of the scheme is based on the idea of enabling needy students to meet their educational expenses with dignity. Total 16 students have received engagement letters under this scheme in session 2023-24.

#### 3. Financial aid to differently abled students

Every year, the office of the Dean Students' Welfare provides financial aid @Rs. 4,000/(per student) to the needy and physically challenged students. In session 2023-24, the aid was provided to 24 students. Most of the buildings entrance has been provided with ramp engaging hassle free entrance to differently abled persons.

#### 4. Funding of Educational/Cultural Tours

Students are encouraged to undertake trips and tours to places of educational and historical importance. In addition to their academic relevance, these trips develop leadership qualities, promote team work and develop an attitude of cooperation among students. The trips are also expected to sensitize the students to appreciate other cultures, societies and languages. During the year 2023, total 44 tours were funded by this office.

#### 5. Funding for Inter-Disciplinary, Guest Lectures & Co-Curricular activities

The office of D.S.W. provides financial assistance for arranging guest lectures, extension lectures and other inter-disciplinary lectures of outside experts in different University Teaching Departments for the sake of exposing our students to multitude of ideas. In the year 2023, the office of DSW provided funds of Rs. 80,229/- for organizing 15 such lectures.

#### 6. <u>Common Rooms</u>

Separate Common Rooms for boys and girls are maintained at several places on the campus i.e. Arts Faculty, Institute of Law etc. In these common rooms, newspapers, magazines and other equipment are provided to the students. An expenditure of Rs.49,603/- was incurred on newspapers and magazines in 2023.

#### 7. Subhash Sadan

The Subhash Sadan (Students' Home) is maintained for providing a venue for gettogether and other programmes of students. Students' Home was provided to the students for such diverse programmes of discussions and other cultural events etc. Community Centre & R. K. Sadan are also provided to the students, if need arises. The installation of metal false ceiling, repair of windows glass pane, doors and floor was done during the year.

#### 8. Group Insurance Scheme for the Students

The Kurukshetra University is running a Group Insurance Scheme for students of the University whereby all the regular students of UTDs are insured for Rs. 2,00,000/- for a token premium @Rs. 14.16/- per student. An amount of Rs. 1,34,520/- was spent as insurance premium for the students of UTD during the session 2023-24.

#### 9. Answer Books for Internal Tests

This office provides answer books to all the Teaching Departments/Institutes for internal tests of the students. The answer books (8 pages) are got printed from the University Press on requirement basis.

#### 10. Rostrum Competitions

Rostrum, an annual public speaking competition was organized in the university campus at three stages, namely Stage-I (University Teaching Departments/Institutes Level), Stage-II (Faculty Level) and Stage-III (University Level). More than 25 topics for the three stages covering issues on education, technology, sports, climate change, spirituality, society, politics etc. were provided.

First of all, Stage-I competition was conducted from January 21, 2023 to February 20, 2023 in the respective Departments/Institutes of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. The speakers of 44 Departments/Institutes participated very vigorously in the competition. More than 450 speakers won 123 prizes at this stage. Besides, 2500 students and 200 faculty members attended the event. At Stage-II, winners from Departments/Institutes (Stage-I) were grouped into five faculties. The competition at faculty level was conducted from March 14, 2023 to March 18, 2023 in the Faculty Lounge of Kurukshetra University,

Kurukshetra. The major milestones achieved at this stage were (i) 81 speakers (ii) 26 prize winners, and (iii) more than 200 students and faculty members attended the event.

After Stage-II, to enhance the skill of above 26 prize-winning speakers, a workshop was conducted on March 31, 2023 in the Senate Hall of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. In this workshop, Dr. Jimmy Sharma from Institute of Integrated and Honours Studies, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and Mrs. Punita Bawa, a Freelance communicator from Chandigarh were invited as resource persons to train the speakers in communication skills. Afterwards, the Stage-III competition was conducted on April 12, 2023 in Senate Hall of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. All the 26 prize-winning speakers of Stage-II made their presentations and this event was attended by more than 150 students and faculty members. For this stage, three judges were invited from outside the University to keep a transparency in the judgment. The spectacular feature of this stage was that one question from the speaker pertaining to his speech was asked by the panel of judges and two questions from the audiences to make the competition livelier.

The ROSTRUM-2023 event concluded with the distribution of prizes to the prize-winning speakers of three stages. The prize distribution function was held on April 26, 2023 in the Senate Hall of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and worthy Vice-Chancellor Prof. Somnath Sachdeva give away the cash prizes to the winners of all stages and a prize money of worth more than Rs. Two Lakh Sixty Thousand were distributed among the winning speakers on this occasion.

#### 11. Adopted Village Pabnawa

As desired by Hon'ble Chancellor of Kurukshetra University and Hon'ble Governor of Haryana, vide his office letter no HRB-UA-2018/629-646 dated 19.01.2018, Kurukshetra University has adopted village Pabnawa in the month of April-2018 and the progress report of the same had been updated to the O/o Hon'ble Governor from time to time. It is humbly submitted that the office of Hon'ble Governor of Haryana has been informed time to time vide letter Nos. DSW/2018/460-61 dated 17.04.2018; DSW/2018/499-501 dated 27.04.2018; DSW/2018/288-89 dated 06.08.2018 and emails dated 24.09.2018 and 15.10.2018. The following activity was made by the Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra from 01.01.2023 to 31.12.2023

 A Blood Donation Camp was organized in Pabnawa in association with YRC, KUK on 30/03/2023 and 88 blood units were collected.





#### 2. <u>Cultural activities</u>

The DSW office manages the participation of students of University Teaching Departments' teams in various activities of the University. Teams of students are selected to participate in these functions. The Dean Students' Welfare as Vice-Chairman of the Kurukshetra University Cultural Council also monitors the smooth functioning of the University's cultural activities.

• A **Talent Show Competition-2023** for the students of UTDs was organized by the office of DSW on the 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st,</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of September, 2023. A total of 450 students registered and participated in the 9 events (Speech, Singing, Dance, Mono-Acting, Painting, Poetical

Symposium, Mimicry, Quiz and playing Instruments). The winners of each event were awarded a cash prize of Rs. 600/- (1st), 500/- (2nd) & 400/- (3rd) along with certificates.

• Ratnawali-Haryana Day State Level Fest-2023 at Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra (28<sup>th</sup> October to 31<sup>th</sup> October 2023). More than 150 students from UTD/IIHS/UIET/ ITTR being the KU campus team participated in Haryana Day (Ratnawali)-2023 in 34 events. We won a total of 20 prizes in various events: 1<sup>st</sup> prize in 6 events, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize in 9 events, and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize in 5 events. Moreover, the overall trophy in Fine Arts Events went to K.U. Campus Team, Kurukshetra.



- Students from UTD performed in various cultural events (Republic Day celebration, KUK Band, during NAAC visit and DDE Alumni meet) organized by Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra time to time during 2023.
- Cultural events mainly Haryanvi Group dance and Haryanvi loor dance presented on 23.12.2023 by the students of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra on the main stage at Brahmasarover, Kurukshetra on the occasion of International Gita Mahotsav-2023.

#### 12. N.S.S. Activities

The NSS UTD Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra works very actively under the office of the Dean Students' Welfare. It has four different Units with strength of approximately four hundred and fifty volunteers, working under the supervision of their respective Programme Officers namely Dr. Raj Kamal, Dr. Dipti Chaudhary, Dr. Manisha Sandhu and Dr. Sunil Kumar. A number of activities were performed (online/offline) by volunteers throughout the year. The participation by the youth in various social service activities is a matter of pride for the university.

- Yoga training camp was organized by the NSS, UTD on dated 20.06.2023 i.e., the day prior to the International Yoga Day.
- NSS UTD KUK celebrated the tree plantation week from 23.07.2023 to 29.07.2023. It was
  celebrated with the objective to make INDIA pollution free and also in the remembrance
  of Kargil Vijay Diwas i.e., on 26.07.2023.

- On this occasion, NSS Volunteers planted at least on plant, Volunteers also shared their
  activity in terms of selfie with plant to make the event memorable. Total about 70 plants
  were planted in different places as the event was celebrated in online mode due to
  vacation period of university.
- A poster making competition on the themes i.e., Drug Abuse, Environment Safety and Plastic free Haryana, has been organized by the NSS, UTD on 04.09.2023 as one day camp.
- Volunteers participated in the NSS day event celebrated on 23.09.2023 at University level. In this event NSS (UTD) represented the various activities of last year in the form of poster presentation. Chief Guest of the event recognizes the contribution of the NSS, UTD.
- Volunteers spread the message of "Cyclothon" cycle rally i.e., Drug Free Haryana in the University campus and village adopted by NSS, UTD. NSS volunteers participated in the closing ceremony of rally for Drug Free Haryana, on 25.09.2023 with great zeal and enthusiasm.

Volunteers collected the plastic waste from common gathering places of market and from the vicinity of food courts area. While collecting the plastic waste, volunteers also educated the shop-keepers and students regarding the effects of burning of plastic on the environment. Volunteers also encouraged the shop-keepers to avoid the single use plastic items in their day-to-day activities.
- Volunteers of NSS, UTD KUK also participated enthusiastically and showed their presence in the different events organized by Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra at mass level like "Run for Unity" (31.10.2023) and "Ratnawali festival" (28-31.10.2023).
- National Flag day on 24.11.2023 was also celebrated. An amount of Rs. 6370/- (Six thousand three hundred and seventy only) was also collected by NSS volunteers to donate the National Foundation of Communal Harmony, New Delhi.
- Celebrated National constitution Day on 26.11.2023. Dr. Monika Dagar, Assistant Professor, Institute of Law, KUK delivered an introductory lecture to NSS volunteers via Online mode. A quiz competition namely "ConstiGenius" was also organized followed by this lecture.
- One Special Camp/ Seven days NSS camp is scheduled to be organized in the month of February 2024.

#### 13. Sports Activities

The University Teaching Departments have been the main feeder in the University teams for various Inter-University tournaments. They have indeed been the nucleus of games and sports in the University. The University Teaching Departments have played a pivotal role in the growth and achievement of the University teams and they have established their supremacy in various Inter-collegiate tournaments.

- University Teaching Departments have spent Rs69,837/- from the period 01.01.23 to 31.12.23 by participating in various Kurukshetra University Inter-Collegiate games men and women teams.

#### 14. <u>Eco-Club Activities</u>

Eco Club, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra was formed under the guidance of the Environmental Nodal Officer and Dean Student Welfare (DSW) Eco-club, to promote and manage environmental protection activities on campus. Eco-club team members including teachers and students participate actively along with the Environmental Nodal Officer to make KUK a leading institution in maintaining its green campus and to contribute towards society in different areas of environmental protection.

Under the able guidance of the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Prof. Som Nath Sachdeva regular activities have been organized by the Eco club, KUK in collaboration with Paryavaran Sanrakshan Gatividhi (PSG) since January 2021.

- Five students every month were recommended by the KUK for the Social Internship Programme (SIP) organized at the national level by Paryavaran Sanrakshan Gatividhi (PSG). During this special training students learned various aspects of environment conservation and trained students are called Eco-Commanders. Eco-Commanders further works to strengthen the Eco club and motivate the society for maximum tree plantation, saving water and energy. During this year more than 20 students completed their Social Internship Programme and got various certificates. Furthermore, 10 students from our Kurukshetra University were registered and selected for a three-day Online SIP Workshop during September and October months 2023 organized by Paryavaran Sanrakshan Gatividhi.
- Students from Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra actively participated in the National Student Paryavaran Competition 2023 "Ek Ped Desh Ke Naam" from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 21<sup>st</sup> August 2023 organized by Paryavaran Sanrakshan Gatividhi (PSG). For the active participation of the students of Kurukshetra University, also one appreciation letter to the University has been issued by the organizers.
- Seven students were selected and actively participated in the Lifestyle for Environment
  (LiFE) and Youth Parliament Stage-1 (North Zone) Competition 2023 organized by
  the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF &CC), Govt. of India. One
  of our students Mr. Ankit from the Law department got a special appreciation certificate
  based on his performance during this event.
- "Tree Plantation Drive" was organized by Eco-club, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra on 4<sup>th</sup> October 2023. More than 100 plants were planted by the student teams near 2<sup>nd</sup> gate of the University.
- During the NAAC visit (14<sup>th</sup> September 2023), students of Eco Club also performed very well and got appreciation and feedback from the NAAC Peer Team Members.
- Eco-club, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra in collaboration with Students for Development & Paryavaran Sanrakshan Gatividhi (SFD-PSG) organized University-level National Environment Youth Parliament- (NEYP) 2024 "Paryavaran Chetana Nurturing Green Leadership for a Sustainable Future" on 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023 through online mode, in which students from affiliated colleges and KUK participated and the winners from this competition advanced to the Regional Level competition. The objective of conducting NEYP-2024 was to encourage and engage the youth with Environmental Issues and to obtain a resolution of their opinion on the Vision of New India towards Environment and Sustainability. This year, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra was nominated as the Regional Host University for Haryana and Jammu & Kasmir Zone. On 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2024, the regional phase of National Environment Youth Parliament-2024 will be organized through virtual mode under the joint aegis of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

#### 15. Youth Red Cross Activities

#### Awareness Programme on HIV and Signature Campaign

Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra organized Signature Campaign for HIV/AIDS awareness under National Youth Day Fortnight Campaign from 12<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> January 2023. Students, Teachers, guests and University Staff members participated in this signature campaign.

The security staff showed great enthusiasm in learning and actively engaged in role-play scenarios, simulating real-life emergencies.

## Day 3: 26th July 2023

The final day of the training camp emphasized first aid for specific situations, including burns, allergic reactions, and handling unconscious casualties. Participants were encouraged to share their experiences and ask questions, promoting a dynamic learning environment.

A comprehensive assessment was conducted at the end of the camp to evaluate the participants' grasp of the training material. It was heartening to witness their competence in applying the acquired knowledge to assess and administer first aid effectively.

Chief Guest and other guests applauded the security staff for their dedication and commitment to enhancing their skills for the greater safety of the community. Approximately university 95 Security personnels attended the training camp on 26.07.2023.
