STATEMENT OF THE CASE

In the academic interest of the students, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has constituted a Committee to look into the matter to grant special mercy chance to the students of all UG/PG courses including Professional, Diploma and Certificates Courses (Semester/Annual Examination) who have availed/exhausted all the permissible chances within prescribed period. The Committee has given its recommendations in its meeting held on 15.10.2024 and the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor under Section 11(5) of the University Act & Statute, 1986 in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council has approved to grant a Special Mercy Chance to the students of all UG/PG courses including Professional, Diploma and Certificates Courses (Semester/Annual Examination) who availed/exhausted all the permissible chances within prescribed period mentioned as under:

1. The special mercy chance be given to the students of all the UG/PG (Annual/Semester) including professional, diploma and certificate courses (wherever applicable) for appearing only in the category of Reappear/Improvement/ Compartment examinations to be held in December 2024/January, 2025 and May/June, 2025.
2. The students enrolled during the academic session 1990-91 to 2004-2005 will appear with an additional fee of Rs. 30,000/- plus usual examination fee for each examination.
3. The students enrolled during the academic session 2005-2006 to 2014-2015 will appear with an additional fee of Rs. 25,000/- plus usual examination fee for each examination.
4. The students enrolled during the academic session 2015-16 onwards will appear an additional fee of Rs. 20,000/- plus usual examination fee for each examination.
5. Where the nomenclature of the subject/scheme does not match with the current subject/scheme, the students will be required to appear with the old subject/ scheme. Where nomenclature is matched, the students will be required to appear with the current syllabus/scheme.
6. The improvement of the professional courses will be applicable in those courses which have been notified by the Deputy Registrar (Academic) vide Endst. No. ACR-III/21/2013-21086 dated 11.11.2021.
7. The desirous candidates of odd semester (ex-student) may submit their examination forms through **online mode upto 14.11.2024**.
8. The schedule for receiving of examination forms of supplementary/compartments candidates may be received only through online mode as per schedule notified by the examination branch.

9. The schedule for receiving of examination forms of even semester/annual examinations to be held in May/June, 2025 may be notified later on by the examination branch.
10. The students of B. A. (one sitting) are not covered under this special mercy chance.
11. In case of old students, where syllabus is not available in the concerned branch, such candidates will not be entitled to claim special mercy chance.

19. To consider the result of UG annual programme Part-I as reappear instead of fail/compartament including the promotion of the students to the subsequent year.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE;

A meeting of the Examination Standing Committee was convened on 21.10.2024 to discuss the issue of declaration of result of UG annual private programme Part-I as reappear instead of fail/compartament including the promotion of the students. In the meeting, the Committee perused the recommendation of the Advisory Committee duly approved by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor that the results of the students of UG annual programme of DDE enrolled in 2023 shall be declared as reappear instead of fail/compartament and further promotion of the students in next higher class. On the basis of this decision, the requisite amendment in respect of declaration of result as reappear instead of fail/compartament including promotion in higher class was also incorporated in the Ordinance of Shastri-I from May, 2022. The Committee has recommended unanimously that on the same pattern the result of the remaining UG annual private programme Part-I may also be declared as reappear instead of fail/compartament including the promotion of the students in next higher class.

(Final) examination to be held in May, 2025 to complete her M.Com. degree as a special case with extra fee to Rs. 7000/- in addition to normal fee/late fee etc. for permitting her extension **one year** beyond 4 years which is stipulated period for passing M.Com. Degree Course.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

As per Clause 6.3 of the Ordinance for M.Com. examinations, appearing at page 356 of K.U. Calendar Vol.II, Part-B 2014, a candidate who fails to pass M.Com. Examination within a period of four years of his/her admission to the course shall be deemed to be unfit for the course.

In the instant case, Ms. Archita took admission in M.Com. (Previous) first time during the session 2020-21 but could not complete the course within stipulated period i.e. 2023-24. Now she has requested to allow her to take admission in M.Com. (Final) in the Centre for Distance and Online Education to complete her M.Com. degree course during the session 2024-25. The Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council allowed admission to her in M.Com. (Final) through Centre for Distance and Online Education as a special case with extra fee of Rs. 7000/- in addition to normal fee/late fee etc.

The Academic Council has already allowed admission to some candidates also to complete their degree courses as a special case on one or the other grounds with the penalty of Rs. 7000/- in addition to normal fee/dues for permitting them extension of **one year** beyond four years which is the stipulated period for passing M.A./M.Com. degree course.

Hence the above is submitted.

4. The degrees of all the persons who have passed various examinations held in April/May, 2024 as private candidate and has become qualified for award of such degrees may be sent by post of them.
5. The following candidates may be called to receive their degrees on the XXXIVth Convocation of the University which is likely to be held in the month of 18th February, 2025.
 - I) The candidate who will complete their PH.D.
 - II) Post graduate candidates, who have passed their various M.A/M.Sc./MHMCT/MBE/MCA/MSW/MPA/MFA/MMT/M.Com/LLM/ Lib.Sc./M.ED/M.P.ED/other Master's Degree & Under Graduates candidates from the University Teaching Departments in 2024.
 - III) Recipients of Medals for the year 2024.
