For DRC Manders only

1. a) Research Scholarship of the value of Rs.14,000/- p.m. tenable for two years in the first instance and Rs.16,000/- p.m. for 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year will be awarded in each Departments/Institutes by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendations of the Departmental/Institutional Research Advisory Committee on the criteria given in clause-2 below. There will be one scholarship against each PG Programme in every Department/ Institute. In case the number of scholars exceeds Ten (10) in a Department/Institute against a PG Programme one additional scholarship will be provided. In addition, there will be Ten (10) University Research Scholarships for S.C. candidates and Five (05) University Research Scholarships for physically challenged candidates as per rule-2 below.

The Scholarship may be extended on yearly basis ordinarily for a period of one year but in no case beyond a period of two years, by the Vice-Chancellor subject to explicit clarification in support of good work progress on the recommendations of the Departmental/Institutional Research Advisory Committee and Supervisor of the candidate.

No payment of Scholarship shall be made to the research scholars after the submission of his/her thesis or up to the tenure of scholarship whichever is earlier. (In case of externally funded scholarships/ fellowship such as JRF, these shall be payable upto the date of Viva-Voce or upto the tenure of scholarship whichever is earlier)

- b) No URS will be awarded to the candidates who are on Regular/ Contract/Guest faculty/Consolidated salary in the Centre/State/Semi Goyt. or Private Organization/ Departments etc.
- 2. a) Only the enrolled students in Ph.D. Course shall be eligible to apply for the award of University Research Scholarship on the prescribed application form at Appendix-I. The criteria for determining the merit for award of University Research Scholarship out of the enrolled students of Ph.D. course will be as under:
- i) Percentage of marks in qualifying examination = 30%
- ii) Percentage of marks at graduation level = 20%
- iii) Percentage of marks in qualifying Entrance Test = 50%

OR

UGC NET/JRF/GATE/GPAT

= 40 marks

- iv) Weightage of 5 marks to the candidates who pass qualifying examination from K.U. Kurukshetra.
- 3) The Scholar will be required to do full-time research work under a supervisor, on the topic approved by the P.G.B.O.S. of the respective Department as per Ph.D. Ordinance.
