TARGET PARTICIPANTS & ELIGIBILITY

In the capacity of participants, the Research Methodology Course aims at Research Scholars pursuing Ph.D. / PDF programs in Social Sciences including Commerce, Management Economics, Sociology, History, Psychology, Education, Political Science, Law and allied disciplines in research institutions, Colleges and University Postgraduate Departments.
