ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

After successfully running these courses, later in 2004 department has started BFA (4 year Degree Course) in Painting, Applied Art, & Sculpture later added MFA (2 year Degree Course) in Painting, Applied Art, Graphics (Printmaking) & Sculpture. The Department is equipped with A Big Art Gallery, Open Air Theatre Stage, Computer labs, Painting, Printmaking & Sculpture studio and rich Library. The department is being developed on the pattern of learning fine arts institutions in India and Abroad with dynamic Faculties. The aim to develop an artistic environment in Haryana & India. Department also hosting a lot of innovative programs (like Exhibitions, Seminars, Conferences, Lectures, Demonstrations, Workshops, Art Camps, Educational tours etc.) for the development of faculty, research scholars and budding artist. Department achieved 8th & 6th Rank in the category of Top Fine Art Institution in India according to the "Nielsen Survey" published in "India Today Magazine" in June 2013 & 2016 issue.

- For Publication Selected papers will undergo a peer-review process and will be published in an edited volume with an ISBN.
