- (3) Panipat Institute of Engg. & Tech., Vill. Pattikalyana, Teh. Samalkha, Distt. Panipat submitted their proposal to run Ph.D. Programmes in MBA and MCA and also submitted documents for processing the case related to MBA and MCA programmes to the University (Annexure Pages 40(14).
