Provided also that a Higher Educational Institution may establish a special Learner Support Centre for imparting instruction to persons referred to in the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995, the National Trust for Welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disability Act, 1999 and other persons in difficult circumstances, including jail inmates:

Provided also that a Learner Support Centre shall not be set up under a franchisee agreement in any case.

(2) A Learner Support Centre shall be the contact point or centre managed by the Higher Educational Institution for providing academic as well as administrative support to its learners and shall perform such other functions as specified in **as per Annexure Pages 24(38-44).**

- (3) The Learner Support Centre shall be headed by a Coordinator who shall be a regular teacher not below the rank of a qualified Assistant Professor of the concerned College or Higher Educational Institution and assisted by the counsellors as decided by the Higher Educational Institution.
- (4) The Higher Educational Institution shall have a Standard Operating Procedure for the smooth functioning of the Learner Support Centre which shall include functions of the Learner Support Centres and its different functionaries, monitoring mechanism of different services provided by the Centre, and it shall be mandatory for the Learner Support Centre to maintain the learner data related to conduct of counselling sessions, evaluation of assignments and grievance redressal.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The Inspection Report of all Law courses are to be got approved from the Academic Council for the purpose of granting provisional affiliation for new course(s)/increase in intake of existing course(s) and for grant of extension in provisional affiliation for continuation of existing course(s) to the Law Colleges/Institutes affiliated with the Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra.

Accordingly, the following Inspection Committee inspected 'Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Law College, Opposite New Bus Stand, Kurukshetra' on 23.12.2024 in accordance with the prescribed Inspection proforma and submitted its Inspection Report (Annexure Pages 28(1-4)):

The Inspection Committee in the said Inspection Report recommended for grant of provisional affiliation for (1) Increase of 60 seats (i.e. from 60 seats to 120 seats) each in (i) LL.B 3 year & (ii) BA LL.B 5 year for the session 2025-26 and (2) Introduction of new course i.e. BBA LL.B 5 year (Hons.) with intake of 60 seats to Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Law College, Opposite New Bus Stand, Kurukshetra for the session 2025-26.

Since the meeting of the Academic Council was not likely to be held at that time whereas the provisional affiliation for (1) Increase of 60 seats (i.e. from 60 seats to 120 seats) each in (i) LL.B 3year & (ii) BA LL.B 5 year for the session 2025-26 and (2) Introduction of new course i.e. BBA LL.B 5 year (Hons.) with intake of 60 seats for the session 2025-26 was required to be conveyed to the concerned college alongwith a copy of Inspection Report for submission of the same to the Bar Council of India, New Delhi for obtaining its approval, therefore, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor accepted/approved the Inspection Report dated 23.12.2024 (Annexure Pages 28(1-4)) in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council.

Thereafter the concerned college remitted prescribed provisional affiliation fee to University and the University granted provisional affiliation the seats (i.e. from 60 seats to **(1)** Increase of 60 120 seats) each LL.B 3 year & (ii) BA LL.B 5 year for the session 2025-26 and (2) Introduction of new course i.e. BBA LL.B 5 year (Hons.) with intake of 60 seats from the academic session 2025-26 to Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Law College, Opposite New Bus Stand, Kurukshetra for the academic session 2025-26 vide letter NO.CG-II/2024/7229 dated 31.12.2024 subject to the conditions imposed by the Inspection Committee & receipt of mandatory approval of the BCI, New Delhi (Annexure Pages 28(5-6).

However, in that letter dated 31.12.2024, the University informed to the College to obtain mandatory approval of the BCI and submit a copy of the same to the University and no admission should be made in additional sections of LL.B 3 year course and BA LL.B 5 year course and in the new course i.e. BBA LL.B 5 year (Hons.) without getting approval/provisional affiliation of the University for making admissions. A copy of the said letter endorsed to all concerned offices of the University and also to the BCI, New Delhi.

Later, the Principal, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Law College, Opposite New Bus Stand, Kurukshetra vide their letter Ref. No.ALC/2025/KUK/66 dated 17.06.2025 submitted a copy of BCI Approval vide letter Ref. No. BCI:D 832: 2025(LE/Std. 24.05.2025 dated 02.06.2025 (Annexure Pages 28(7-10)). Accordingly the University conveyed provisional affiliation/approval vide letter No. CG-II/2025/3420 dated 21.07.2025(Annexure Pages 28(11-12)).

Hence the above proposal.

The notification vide Endst. No. COE-II/AR(EE)/17/1237-47 dated 01.06.2017 (Annexure Pages 29(1-3)), implemented w.e.f. 2016-17 was issued upon the orders of the then Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor in anticipation of the approval of the Academic Council/Executive Council. In the matter, the main file pertaining to the said notification is not traceable either in the office of the Controller of Examinations or in the Examination Enquiry. Written reports of non-availability of the file have been obtained from both offices. Further, being an old case and it appears that dealing officer at that time, Sh. Gurmej Singh, Assistant Registrar (Retd.), had not handed over any related file before his demise. Due to the reason, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor placed the matter before the Examination Standing Committee.

In addition to above, the clauses for consideration of improvement examinations in the B.A./B. Sc. Ordinance (Semester/Annual) differ from those in the M. A. Ordinance. The Examination Branches have therefore, proposed minor amendments in Clause 16 and 25 of the B. A./B.Sc. Ordinance (Semester/Annual), aligning it with the provision of the M. A. The Committee has given its recommendations in is meeting held on 24.09.2025 and the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor under Section 11(5) of the University Act & Statute, 1986 in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council has approved to grant a Special Mercy Chance to the students of all UG/PG courses including Professional, Diploma and Certificates Courses (Semester/Annual Examination) who availed/exhausted all the permissible chances within prescribed period mentioned as under:

- 1. The special mercy chance be given to the students of all the UG/PG (Annual/Semester) including professional, diploma and certificate courses (wherever applicable) for appearing only in the category of Reappear/Improvement/Compartment examinations to be held in December 2025/January, 2026 and May/June, 2026.
- 2. The students enrolled during the academic session 1990-91 to 2004-2005 will appear with an additional fee of Rs. 30,000/- plus usual examination fee for each examination.
- 3. The students enrolled during the academic session 2005-2006 to 2014-2015 will appear with an additional fee of Rs. 25,000/- plus usual examination fee for each examination.
- 4. The students enrolled during the academic session 2015-16 onwards will appear an additional fee of Rs. 20,000/- plus usual examination fee for each examination.
- 5. The students, who wish to appear in improvement examinations, will have to appear with current syllabus/syllabus in force. However, when the nomenclature of the subject does not match with current syllabus or scheme. The students will have to appear in old subject/scheme.
- 6. The improvement of the professional courses will be applicable in those courses which have been notified by the Deputy Registrar (Academic) vide Endst. No. ACR-III/21/2013-21086 dated 11.11.2021.
- 7. The schedule for receiving of examination forms of supplementary/compartment candidates may be received only through online mode as per schedule notified by the examination branch.

8. The schedule for receiving of examination forms of even semester/annual examinations to be held in May/June, 2026 may be notified later on by the examination branch.

9. The students of B. A. (one sitting) are not covered under this special mercy

chance.

 In case of old students, where syllabus is not available in the concerned branch, such candidates will not be entitled to claim special mercy chance.

The examination for odd semester/annual examination (Reappear/Additional/Compartment and Improvement, wherever applicable) will be held December 2025/January, 2026 and May/June, 2026 and even semester/annual examination (Reappear/Additional/Compartment and Improvement, wherever applicable in December

2025/January, 2026 and May/June, 2026.

The students desirous of appearing in the above Special Mercy Chance examinations shall apply through Online Examination Forms with an initial fee as visible on the Examination Portal to their respective last attended Colleges/Departments/Institutes through the Online Examination Portal. After checking the eligibility of the students, the balance fee, if any, shall be displayed in the Students' login as well as in the College Login which shall be paid by the respective Colleges/Departments/Institutes only through the Online Examination Portal to the University. After realizing the complete Examination fee by the University, the Admit Cards-cum-Roll Numbers shall be issued to the eligible students. The examinations of this Special Mercy Chance will be conducted as per the current syllabus of the course.

The mode of obtaining the Examination Forms and Fee for the Annual System December 2025/January, 2026 and May/June, 2026 (Re-appear/Compartment /Additional/ Improvement, wherever applicable) as well as the schedule shall be notified

later on.
