<p>2. Inter college migration for NEP based multiple entry-exit programmes will not be done w.e.f. session 2023-24. The candidate will apply to the concerned College/Institute to which he/she wants admission. The candidate will apply to the concerned College/Institute to which he/she wants admission. A student who has not taken exit from 1st/2nd/3rd / 4th year and wants to take admission in 2nd year /3rd / 4th / 5th year in another college then he/she has to obtain the “No Objection Certificate” from the Department/ college/ Institute where he/she wants to take admission in promotional class with the remarks that the seat is vacant and the name of the student is included in the list of selected candidates. The above No Objection Certificate will be submitted to his/her parent college and after that the parent college will transfer his/her data to the new college on IUMS Portal and it will be treated as No Objection from the Parent College. For this process the following processing fee will be charged from the students and will be deposited in the University.</p>
