

## NEW SCHOLARSHIPS

The addition of following Scholarship under *Ordinance XVII – Scholarships, Stipends, Medals and Prizes* in the K.U. Calendar Vol. I, 2009 at pages approved vide Executive Council Resolution No. 10 dated 31.05.2024.

### LATE SH. GURDEV SINGH PABLA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS AND MEDAL:

1. One Scholarship of the value of Rs.20,000/-p.a. will be awarded to the student pursuing study in M.A. English-3<sup>rd</sup> Sem., Deptt. of English, KUK on the basis of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Sem. exams on Merit-cum-Means basis.
2. One Scholarship of the value of Rs.20,000/- p.a. will be awarded to a student pursuing study in M.A. Education-3<sup>rd</sup> Sem., Deptt. of Education, KUK on the basis of M.A. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Sem. exams on Merit-cum-Means basis.
3. One Scholarship of the value of Rs.20,000/- p.a. will be awarded to a student pursuing study in L.L.B. (Professional 3 yr.)-5<sup>th</sup> Sem., Deptt. of Law, KUK on the basis of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sem. exams on Merit-cum-Means basis.
4. One Scholarship of the value of Rs.20,000/- p.a. will be awarded to a student pursuing study in M.Sc. Physics-3<sup>rd</sup> Sem., Deptt. of Physics on the basis of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Sem. exams on Merit-cum-Means basis.
5. The following Committee will recommend the names of awardees for award of Sr. No. 1 to 4 in the concerned Departments:
  - i. Chairperson of the Department
  - ii. One Senior most Teacher of the Department other than the Chairperson.
  - iii. Superintendent (Scholarship Section)
  - iv. Nominee of Donor (Mr. Aashu Garg, H.No. 1380 Sector-13, URBAN Estate, Kurukshetra)
6. One Scholarship of the value of Rs.20,000/- p.a. will be awarded on Merit-cum-Means basis to a Disabled student using a Wheelchair for his/her mobility, in the final year of the course in their academic program.
7. One Gold plated Silver Medal of the value of Rs.5000/- along with a cash prize of Rs.5000/- will be awarded to a regular student who obtains the highest marks in Master Degree in M.Sc. Physics of this University.
8. One Gold plated Silver Medal of the value of Rs.5000/- along with a cash prize of Rs.5000/- will be awarded to a regular student who obtains the highest marks in Master Degree in M.A. English of this University.
9. The Annual Income of the family of the students from all sources should not exceed Rs.6 Lac per annum. The applicant will have to submit an Income Certificate from the employer in case of employee and in other cases in the form of an affidavit duly attested by the 1<sup>st</sup> Class Magistrate.
10. The tenure of the scholarship will be of twelve months i.e. June to May every year.
11. The recipient of the scholarship will not avail simultaneously any other Scholarship/Stipend/ Financial Assistance/Tuition Fee Concession.
12. The Vice-Chancellor will have the right to increase/decrease the value of Scholarships/Medals/Prizes according to the interest available.

13. These Scholarships/Medals/Prizes will be awarded w.e.f. the session 2024-25.
14. Only those students who secured at least 60% marks or more without re-appear in their lower exams except Sr. No.6 will only be eligible to apply for these Scholarships.
15. If the convocation of the University could not held due to some administrative reasons or the Medals could not awarded in the Convocation due to administrative reasons, the medals will be given to the eligible students in person in the University office.

### **DR. PARAMJIT SINGH VIRK SCHOLARSHIP**

1. There shall be two Scholarships of the value of Rs.12,000/- per annum each known as “Dr. Paramjit Singh Virk Scholarship” will be awarded out of the Interest of the money remitted in KUKAA Fund of Rs. 5 Lac. by Dr. Paramjit Singh Virk for the students of M.Sc. (Statistics.) Final on the basis of I & II Semester results of the Dept. of Statistics & Operational Research, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra on merit-cum-mean basis every year.
2. The Scholarships will be awarded w.e.f. from the session 2024-25 on the recommendations of the Committee consisting of following members:
  - i) Chairperson, Deptt. of Statistics & Operational Research, KUK.
  - ii) Senior most teacher of the Department of Statistics & Operational Research, KUK other than the Chairperson.
  - iii) Director, KUKAA.
  - iv) Donor or his nominee
3. The Scholarships will be paid annually.
4. The Scholarships will be awarded out of the annual interest accrued on Rs.5,00,000/- donated by Dr. Paramjit Singh Virk to KUKAA. The amount of Rs. 24,000/- will be submitted by the Director, KUKAA every year to Accounts Branch and the Scholarship Section will be issued notice of invitation for the Scholarships.
5. 80% interest annually earned on the Endowment be used for award of Scholarships and remaining 20% interest may be used for University expenses in the Endowment.
6. Only those students, who have secured atleast aggregate 7.0 SGPA without re-appear in their First and Second Semester Examination, will be eligible to apply these Scholarships.
7. Annual total family income of the applicant from all sources should not exceed Rs.5,00,000/- The applicant will have to submit an income certificate/PPP issued by the competent authority.
8. The recipient of the Scholarships will not avail simultaneously any other Scholarships/stipend.
9. If the Scholarships is not availed by the recommended students who is at the top in the panel of selection, next student on the panel will be considered for award of these Scholarships.
10. The Vice-Chancellor will have the right to increase/decrease the value of Scholarships according to the Interest available.
