Accordingly, the Inspection Committee inspected '**Lala Ami Chand Monga Memorial College of Law, Vill. Ugala, Distt. Ambala**' in accordance with the prescribed Inspection proforma aimed at having objective profiles of the college/institute in terms of the fulfilment of standard/norms prescribed by the BCI to assess the existing Human Resource position and physical infrastructure & other facilities/amenities on a 500 point scale and submitted its report at **Annexure Pages 11(1-5)**.

Since the meeting of the Academic Council was not likely to be held at that time and the extension in provisional affiliation to the Law College was required to be conveyed, the Vice-Chancellor accepted/approved the Inspection Report in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council for the purpose of granting extension in provisional affiliation to the concerned college to continue existing courses for the session 2026-2027 and for obtaining mandatory approval of the BCI, New Delhi of the said courses. The extension in provisional affiliation was conveyed to the college accordingly (**Annexure Pages 11(6)**).

17. To consider the recommendations dated 21.11.2025 of the Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor regarding framing of separate rules for admission of re-appear/compartement students in the programmes run by the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE), K.U.K.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

There is an urgent need to frame the new rules for reappear/compartement students at 10+2, Graduation & Postgraduate levels seeking admissions in the Centre for Distance and Online Education, K.U.K. There are different rules prevailing in Teaching Departments and colleges regarding admission of candidates having reappear/compartement in the qualifying examinations. In the present situation in the Centre for Distance and Online Education in view of large number of programmes, large number of admissions slots available, admissions in two sessions of January and July, parallelly running different schemes such as Annual, CBCS, NEP, lateral entry and mobility from regular programmes and operational complexities arising out of managing such diverse aspects. The following new uniform set of rules may be framed for CDOE:-

1. Admissions of students having compartement/reappear at 10+2 level in the first year of a programme:

A student who has been placed under compartement or is allowed to reappear in any number of subjects in Senior secondary Certificate Level (Class XII level) of the Board of School Education Haryana or equivalent examination of another University/Board may be allowed to study provisionally for the First Semester/year of UG/other programme wherein 10+2 is the qualifying/eligibility condition for admission. Such student shall pass the compartement/reappear subjects before the commencement of the First semester/year examination of concerned UG/other programme. If the student does not clear the compartement/reappear subjects in time, his/her admission to the programme concerned shall be cancelled ab-initio by the CDOE. No fee refund will be admissible in such cases of admission cancellation.

The Vice-Chancellor may relax the above conditions in exceptional cases on its own or on the recommendation of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

2. Admission of student having compartement/reappear at Undergraduate level in the first year of a programme.

A student who has been placed under compartement or is allowed to reappear in any number of subjects in Undergraduate Exams. of Kurukshetra University or equivalent examinations of another University may be allowed to study provisionally for the First semester/year of PG/other Programme wherein Undergraduate Degree is the qualifying/eligibility condition for admission. Such student shall pass the compartement/reappear subjects before the commencement of the First semester/ year examination of concerned PG/other programme. If the student does not clear the compartement/reappear subjects in time, his/her admission to the programme concerned shall be cancelled ab-initio by the CDOE. No fee refund will be admissible in such cases of admission cancellation.

The Vice-Chancellor may relax the above conditions in exceptional cases on its own or on the recommendation of the Committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor.

3. Lateral entry of students having compartment/reappear in UG/PG Programme in second/third year of a UG/PG programme.

Students with reappear/compartment in UG/PG programmes are allowed lateral admissions in the programme of CDOE, subject to the following conditions:-

- 3.1 Students from universities other than Kurukshetra University shall pass all reappear/compartment exams before the commencement of final semester/end year examinations of concerned programme.
- 3.2 However, the students of Kurukshetra University taking lateral admissions will have to clear the reappear/compartment exams as per Clause 9.1 of the Ordinance of UG Programme of CDOE wherein they can appear in lower semester examinations alongwith higher semester examinations.
- 3.3 Students shall be allowed admission to only those programmes and courses that are offered by CDOE.
- 3.4 However, students are allowed to study a new subject with the stipulation that all deficient courses of the same have to be completed as per Clause 9.1 cited above.

Since meeting of the Academic Council was not being held shortly and the above Guidelines were to be circulated to the University Teaching Departments/Institutes/Affiliated Colleges, the Vice-Chancellor took the above action.

Act & Statutes, 1986 in anticipation of approval of the Academic Council/Executive Council in approving the recommendations of the Committee dated 18.11.2025 regarding perusing Two Academic Programmes simultaneously and consequential amendments/additions in Clause 7 of General Rules for Examinations appearing in the K.U. Calendar Volume-II, 2014 **as per Annexure Pages 19(1-3)** w.e.f. the Session 2025-26.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The amendments/additions in the Guidelines perusing Two Academic Programmes simultaneously **as per Annexure Pages 19(1-3)** has been recommended by the Deans' Committee in its meeting held on 18.11.2025 (**Annexure Pages 19(1-3)**).

Since meeting of the Academic Council was not being held shortly and the above Guidelines were to be circulated to the University Teaching Departments/Institutes/Affiliated Colleges, the Vice-Chancellor took the above action.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

CDOE has a unique character where a large number of students are pursuing dual degree programmes who find it difficult to submit Migration Certificate at two Institutions simultaneously. Therefore, different rules of Migration Certificate are needed in such cases. CDOE offers admissions in two academic sessions in a year as per guidelines of the Distance Education Bureau, UGC, New Delhi and its Academic Calendar is different from the Academic Calendar of the Kurukshetra University. This poses problems in restoration of registration of ex-students of the University as the schedule of submission of Migration Certificate of University aligns with the Academic Calendar of the University. A Committee of the following was constituted by the Vice-Chancellor to examine the Migration rules of the University and recommend a new set of Migration rules for the students of Centre for Distance and Online Education:-

1. Director, CDOE
2. Controller of Examinations/Nominee - Superintendent (Registration)
3. Superintendent, Eligibility (CDOE)

The proposed new rules for submission of Migration Certificate (**as per Annexure Pages 20(1-3)**) were approved by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.

Hence, Migration Certificate rules for the students of CDOE are to be placed before the Academic Council and Executive Council for consideration and approval.

21. To consider the action taken by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor on dated 12.11.2025 approving the recommendations of the Committee dated 29.10.2025 constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to consider the request of Ms. Renu for seeking admission in B.Ed. IInd year in Dr. Ganesh Dass DAV College for Women, Karnal for the session 2025-26 after prescribed period 4 year for passing of B.Ed. examinations (previous well as final) **as per Annexure Pages 21(1-15).**

STATEMENT OF THE CASE:

Ms. Renu got admission to B.Ed. for the session 2020-21 and completed 1st year examinations successfully. Due to visit of aboard, she could not complete her B.Ed. IInd year with in period of 4 year of her admission as prescribed in the ordinance.

The Ordinance of B.Ed. Programme at clause 10.3 read as under:-

“A candidate for the B.Ed., Examination must pass the whole examinations (previous as well as final) within a period of four year of his/her admission to the B.Ed. course falling he/she will be deemed to be unfit for the course and shall not be further admitted to this University for such a course” (Annexure Pages 21(8-11))

As per orders of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor dated 3.10.2025 (**as per Annexure Pages 21(1)**), the request for admission of Ms. Renu was placed before the standing Committee of Registration.

The Committee recommends that Ms. Renu may be allowed to take admission in Dr. Ganesh Dass DAV College of Education for Women, Karnal in B.Ed. IInd year as a special case with a fine of Rs. 10,000/- alongwith usual fee, subject to approval of Academic Council of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has approved the recommendation of the standing Registration Committee dated 12.11.2025.

22. The following proposals regarding award of Degrees of examinations held in 2025 as required under Clause (1) & (2) of the Ordinance XIX (a) Admission to Degrees and Academic Costumes appearing at page 254 of the University Calendar volume-1, 2009.

- 1 “All such Graduates who have passed their UG / PG examination in May/June, 2025 for various Degrees of the University and have become qualified for admission to such Degrees, shall be admitted to these Degrees.”
- 2 The UGC has issued instruction to all the Universities to dispatch the degrees to the students within 180 days after declaration of their results. Our University has also adopted the same and also incorporated in schedule to Academic Calendar on the direction of UGC. Therefore, it is proposed that 31th October, 2025 may be printed on the degrees for above mentioned examination session. Where the result is declared after 31th October, 2025 the date of declaration of result may be printed on the degrees.
- 3 The degrees of all the candidates who have passed their various examinations in May/June, 2025 from various Colleges / Institutions recognized by the Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and Centre for Distance and Online Education, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra and have become qualified for admission to such degrees may be sent by post to their respective College/institutions.
- 4 The degrees of all the persons who have passed various examinations held in May/June, 2025 as private candidates and have become qualified for award of such degrees may be sent by post to them.
- 5 The following candidates may be called to receive their degrees on the XXXVth Convocation of the University which is to be held in the month of 4th April, 2026.
 - a) The candidate who will complete their Ph.D. before the Convocation.
 - b) Post graduate candidates & Under graduates Candidates who have passed their various examinations from the University Teaching Departments/Institutions in 2025.
 - c) Recipients of Medals for the year, 2025.

23. To authorize the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor to finalize name of persons & Honorary Degrees to be awarded during the convocation to be held on **04th April, 2026**.

As per ordinance XVIII - **Honorary Degrees**

"Where the Vice-Chancellor, and not less than two-thirds of the other members of the Academic Council, recommend that an Honorary Degree be conferred on any person on the ground that he is, in their opinion, by reason of eminent position and academic attainments a fit and proper person, to receive such a degree, and the recommendation is approved by the Chancellor, the Academic Council may confer on such person the Honorary Degree, so recommended, without requiring him to undergo any examination".
